## **YARO PRESCRIBED BURN**

*San Luis Obispo County* - Tentatively, Monday, May 20, 2024, through Wednesday, May 22, 2024, burning of vegetation will occur on private land East of Santa Margarita Ca. In cooperation with SLO County APCD, San Luis Obispo Fire Safe Council & local landowners. Firefighters from CAL FIRE will conduct a 23 acre burn of brush. Burning is expected to begin at 9:45 a.m. and conclude by 6:00 p.m. Smoke may be visible from the communities of Park Hill, Santa Margarita, Atascadero, and Creston Ca.

**Prescribed burning is an important tool used to minimize fire hazards and the likelihood of uncontrolled future wildfires that would have the potential to induce significant air quality impacts on the local community. Should conditions not be suitable for good consumption and optimal smoke dispersal, the burn will be rescheduled.
