

The Department of Restorative Dentistry, Periodontics, Endodontics, Preventive Dentistry and Paediatric Dentistry at the Centre for Dentistry, Oral and Maxillofacial Medicine (ZZMK) at University Medicine Greifswald (UMG), a partially incorporated entity of the University of Greifswald with legal capacity, is seeking to fill the position of

Professor (W3) of Periodontics and Restorative Dentistry.

Job Description:

The future holder of the position shall represent the full scope of the field of periodontics/restorative dentistry in research, teaching and patient treatment at the Centre for Dentistry, Oral and Maxillofacial Medicine (ZZMK). The professorship includes the chair of the Department of Restorative Dentistry, Periodontics, Endodontics, Preventive Dentistry and Paediatric Dentistry. The department's clinical activity covers the complete range of periodontal and restorative dentistry. Management experience is therefore required. The successful candidate is expected to be a good team player. The future position holder is expected to play an active part in the ongoing development of the dental interdisciplinary curriculum.

Further independent departments at the Centre for Dentistry, Oral and Maxillofacial Medicine (ZZMK) are the Clinic and Outpatient Clinic for Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery/Plastic Surgery, the department of Orthodontics, and the department of Dental Prosthodontics, Geriatric Dentistry and Medical Materials. The department of Restorative Dentistry has a further Professorship of Preventive Dentistry and Paediatric Dentistry with corresponding area of activity. The future holder of the position will have the opportunity to play an active role in the appointment of a further W2 professorship at this department. The teaching of the curriculum in the entire field of periodontal and restorative dentistry is shared by all of the department's appointed professors.

The successful applicant should be an acclaimed expert in the research field of periodontics/restorative dentistry and if possible further areas of interest such as dental materials or endodontics, as proven by internationally recognised academic achievements. Future activities are explicitly desired in areas related to key fields of research at University Medicine Greifswald and the Centre for Dentistry, Oral and Maxillofacial Medicine (ZZMK). The position holder will be expected to participate in the existing research collaborations (community medicine, molecular medicine, individualized medicine) and UMG's key fields of research (infections and inflammations, plasma medicine). Further collaboration is possible with the local German Centres for Health Research (DZNE, DZHK), with the research project Community Medicine (SHIP, German National Cohort) and the Leibniz Institute for Plasma Science and Technology (INP Greifswald). The successful candidate is expected to play an active role in existing research collaborations but also to initiate own research projects and new partnerships with national and international institutions.

University Medicine Greifswald supports and demands family-friendly leadership.

Applicants must fulfil the **requirements** for a university professor according to § 58 of the *Landeshochschulgesetz* - LHG M-V (State Higher Education Law): in addition to general employment regulations, a successfully completed university degree, extensive teaching experience, doctorate and habilitation or other equivalent academic achievements. Applicants are expected to have clinical competencies in the field of periodontics and restorative dentistry. Candidates should be able to provide proof of excellent academic publications and the successful raising of external funding.

The position shall be appointed in accordance with § 61 LHG M-V. The successful candidate shall receive an employment contract with University Medicine Greifswald that is regulated by private law.

This vacancy is open to all persons, irrespective of gender. University Medicine Greifswald would like to increase the proportion of women in areas in which they are underrepresented and thus applications from

women are particularly welcome and will be treated with priority if they have the same qualifications and as long as there are no clear reasons which make a fellow applicant more suitable. Severely disabled applicants with the same professional and personal qualifications will also be given preference.

Application costs will not be reimbursed by University Medicine Greifswald.
