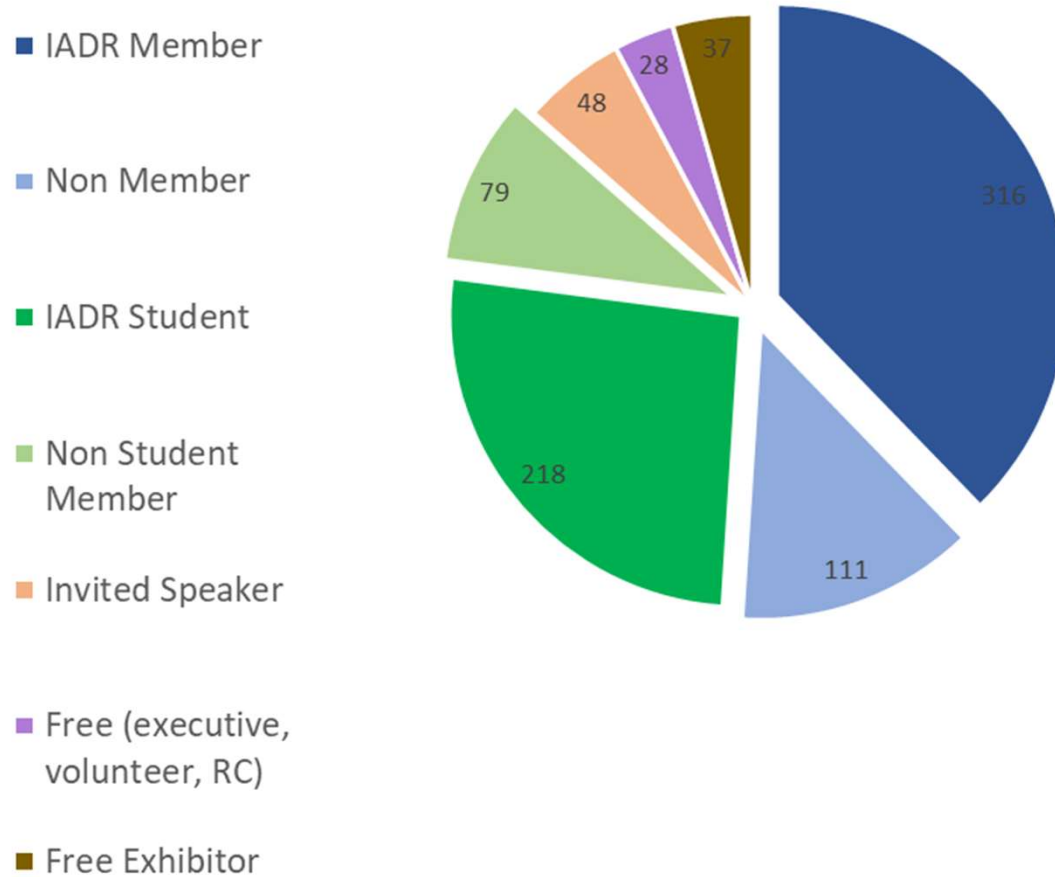

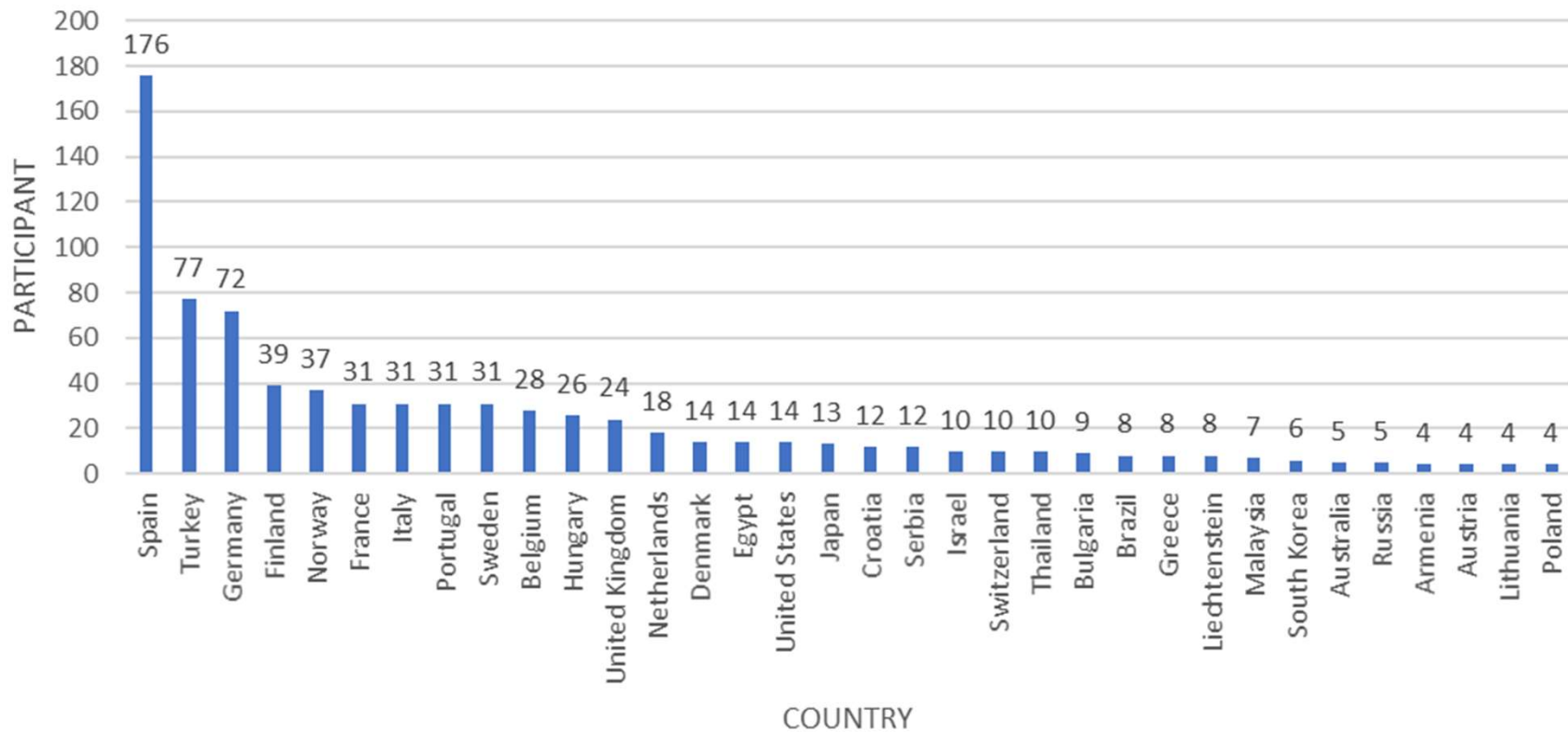

2019 Madrid - Registration (status September 10, 2019)



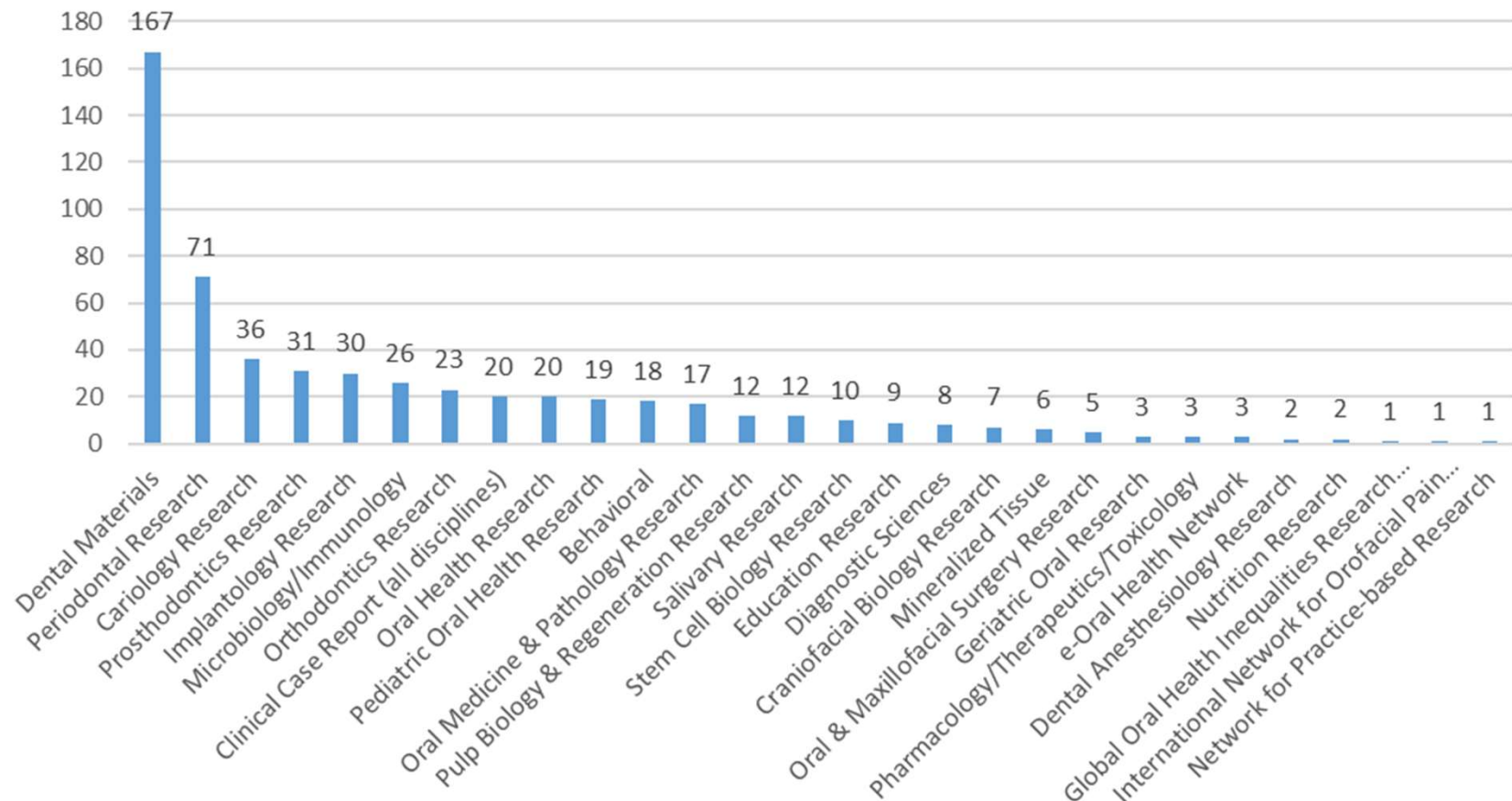

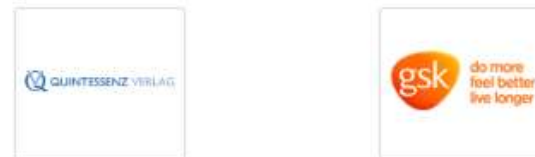

Originally, the idea of PER-IADR was to meet the years when IADR organized an international meeting outside North America, which possibly is less accessible to PER-IADR members (except of course when in Europe). This would mean to hold a PER-IADR meeting in 2021 and then every second year after.

However, PER-IADR agreed that in 2023 the following PER-IADR meeting should be held, this not to have the PER-IADR meetings following each other (2020 and then again 2021).
