WE ARE LOOKING FOR ENTHUSIASTIC BOARD MEMBERS

CED-IADR is pleased to announce the implementation of a new procedure of a transparent selection of future CED-IADR Board Members. We are looking for enthusiastic oral health research colleagues to join our CED-IADR Board in Summer 2021.



The Association is administrated by the CED-IADR Board. The CED-IADR Board has at least four (4) Members and a maximum of thirteen (13) Members. One Board Member position is vacant with the following criteria:

- Candidates must be a regular CED-IADR member and actively involved in oral and/or craniofacial research.
- Candidates must have a permanent university position at a university in Turkey.
- Females are strongly encouraged to apply.

BOARD MEMBER TERM: three years

HONORARIUM & EXPENSES: The mandate of CED-IADR Board Member is not remunerated, however, CED-IADR reimburses the expenses of Board Members who attend the CED-IADR Board Meetings.

EXPECTATIONS: Every Board Member is expected to ACTIVELY support the objectives of the CED-IADR, which are:

- promote all aspects of oral and cranio-facial health research by the dissemination of relevant knowledge and scientific information;
- serve as a platform for networking, exchange of information and experiences for all oral and cranio-facial health researchers in Europe;
- advocate for the support and financing of appropriate research funding in oral health;
- encourage oral and cranio-facial health research through grants, awards, etc.;
- provide research training to young researchers;
- collect funding (membership fee, congress registration fees, company sponsoring, etc.) to be used for the direct implementation of the objectives of the association;
- participate at the organisation of CED-IADR Oral Health Research congresses (CED-IADR congresses);
- to contribute to the Pan-European-Region of IADR (PER-IADR) and IADR-at-large.

ROLES: As a Board Member, you will be required to:

- attend the Board Meetings (at least twice a year);
- participate fully and openly in meetings, sharing insights, ideas and suggestions;
- actively serve in CED-IADR committees and take on duties, such as award competition jury member, abstract reviewer, scientific committee member at a CED-IADR congress, etc.;
- stimulate the visibility of CED-IADR activities and attract new members
- support CED-IADR for seeking potential sponsorship.
- exercise your power and duty in good faith in the best interests of CED-IADR and for a proper purpose, with reasonable care and diligence.

All members of the CED-IADR Board are elected by the General Assembly by a simple majority of votes. The CED-IADR Board will pre-select the most suitable candidates and will propose them at the 2021 General Assembly.
