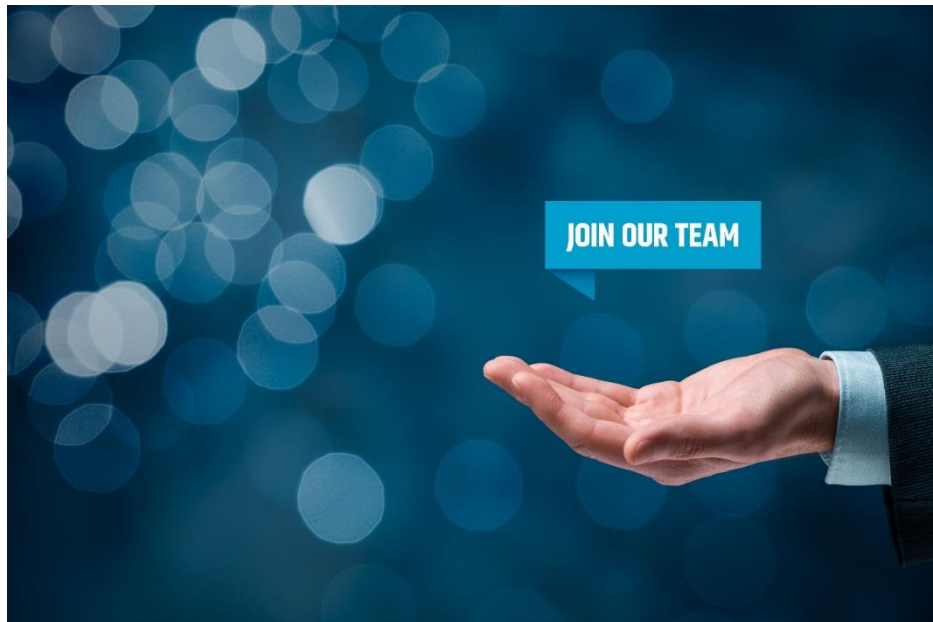




PROMOTING HIGH-QUALITY ORAL HEALTH RESEARCH IN EUROPE

3 ENTHUSIASTIC NEW BOARD MEMBERS
to represent Germany, the Netherlands and
Austria/Switzerland



We are pleased to announce the opening of 3 positions in the CED-IADR Board. Our Association is administrated by the CED-IADR Board which is composed of at least 4 and a maximum of 13 members.

One position is open for a candidate affiliated in **Germany**.

A second position is open for a candidate affiliated in the **Netherlands**.

A third board member candidate should be affiliated in **Austria or Switzerland**.

All candidates should fulfil the following **REQUIREMENTS**:

- Be a regular CED-IADR member and actively involved in oral and/or craniofacial research.
- Be engaged on a permanent university position.

Females are strongly encouraged to apply.

TERM: three years, starting July 1, 2025 till September 30, 2028.

HONORARIUM & EXPENSES: The mandate of CED-IADR Board Member is not remunerated. However, CED-IADR reimburses the expenses of Board Members who attend the CED-IADR Board Meetings.

EXPECTATIONS: Every Board Member is expected to ACTIVELY support the objectives of the CED-IADR, which are:

- promote all aspects of oral and cranio-facial health research by the dissemination of relevant knowledge and scientific information;
- serve as a platform for networking, exchange of information and experiences for all oral and cranio-facial health researchers in Europe;
- advocate for the support and financing of appropriate research funding in oral health;
- encourage oral and cranio-facial health research through grants, awards, etc.;
- organise research training to young researchers;
- collect funding (membership fee, congress registration fees, company sponsoring, etc.) to be used for the direct implementation of the objectives of the association;
- participate at the organisation of CED-IADR Oral Health Research congresses (CED-IADR congresses);
- to contribute to the Pan-European-Region of IADR (PER-IADR) and IADR-at-large.

ROLES: As a Board Member, you are required to:

- attend the Board Meetings (at least twice a year);
- participate fully and openly in meetings, sharing insights, ideas and suggestions;
- actively serve in CED-IADR committees and take on duties, such as award competition jury member, abstract reviewer, scientific committee member at a CED-IADR congress, etc.;
- actively stimulate the visibility of CED-IADR activities and attract new members;
- support CED-IADR in seeking potential sponsorship;
- exercise your position and associated responsibilities with reasonable care and diligence in the best interests of CED-IADR.

INTERESTED?

Interested applicants must submit their CV and motivation letter to ced.iadr@uzleuven.be before April 1, 2024. The CED-IADR Board will pre-select 2 candidates per country by May 15, 2025, and will propose them to all members before the 2025 General Assembly in Barcelona on June 26, 2025, when the election will take place.
