Your toddler (born in 2020) can now go to school for the first time.

Or perhaps you want to move your child from their current school to a different one.

The information in this brochure is important for you in both of these cases.

Take the time to select a school.

If you want, you can visit the school beforehand.

On:

Wednesday 23 February 2022 from 9 am to 12 pm and on Thursday 17 March 2022 from 2 pm to (5.30 pm)

all the schools in Leuven organise Open Days.



We work with an electronic registration system for all Leuven primary schools.

This brochure gives you information about the time of registration and enrolment in a nursery or primary school in Leuven, Heverlee, Kessel-Lo, Wilsele and Wijgmaal. All schools work with the same system.

This makes it easier for you as a parent and gives everyone an equal chance of enrolling their child in their school of choice.

Via this website you can register your child not only for schools in Leuven but also for schools in Herent, Oud-Heverlee and Bierbeek. For more information about these schools, go to https://meldjeaan.leuven.be or to the schools or websites in these districts.

The Leuven schools would like to give a warm welcome to you and your child!

Would you like help going through this brochure or registering and enrolling your child? Then go to pages 16 to 19. There you will find an overview of organisations that can help you.

How should you register and enrol your child?

IMPORTANT! FIRST REGISTER THEN ENROL

There are 3 steps that you must take to register and enrol your child in a Leuven nursery or primary school:

- **STEP 1: Registration:** register your child with the schools of choice via the website **https://meldjeaan.leuven.be**
- **STEP 2: You will receive an e-mail** with the details of the school at which you can enrol your child.
- **STEP 3: Enrolment:** the school will contact you to complete your enrolment.

Your child can then start school.

For older children who are changing school, that date will be 1 September 2022.

All children born in 2020 have to register and enrol **now**, even if they are only starting on 1 September 2023.

When should you register and enrol your child?

Period 1: Priority status for children who already have a brother and/or sister in the school and children of personnel

Registration: from Tuesday 11 January 2022 (9 am) to Tuesday 1 February 2022 (5 pm)

Allocation message: on Tuesday 22 February 2022

Enrolment: from Thursday 24 February 2022 (9 am) to Thursday 31 March 2022 (5 pm)

Period 2: All children

Registration: from Tuesday 1 March 2022 (9 am) to Tuesday 29 March 2022 (5 pm)

Allocation message: on Tuesday 26 April 2022

Enrolment: from Thursday 28 April (9 am) to Tuesday 24 May 2022 (5 pm)

Period 3: Enrolment period for all children who are still looking for a school From Thursday 2 June 2022 (9 am).

Important:

- ✓ Check the dates carefully and register within this period.
- ✓ You can always change your details during the registration period.

Period I: priority status for brothers and sisters and for children of personnel

Do you already have a child in the school? Or do you work at the school? (https://data-onderwijs.vlaanderen.be/edulex/document.aspx?docid=14368#6-3-2) Then your child has priority status in the school.

STEP 1: Register your child

When? From Tuesday 11 January 2022 (9 am) to Tuesday 1 February 2022 (5 pm). Important! After this you lose your priority status.

Brothers and sisters means all children that live at the same address or have the same father and/or mother, even if they don't live at the same address.

STEP 2: You will receive an e-mail

On **Tuesday 22 February 2022** you will receive an e-mail telling you the result of the registration. This result will also be available in a message in your personal inbox at https://meldieaan.leuven.be.

What happens if you don't get a mail on Tuesday 22 February 2022? Send a mail to info@meldjeaan.leuven.be or call 016 27 26 17. It may be that a school doesn't have enough places and that your child is on a waiting list. You can then register your child in another school from Tuesday 1 March 2022 (9 am)

STEP 3: Enrol your child

The school will contact you to complete the enrolment process.

When? From Thursday 24 February 2022 (9 am) to Thursday 31 March 2022 (5 pm)

Period 2: registration and enrolment of ALL children

In advance: Get to know different schools and select a few of them.

How?

- ✓ You can find all of Leuven's nursery and primary schools in the school list in this brochure.
- ✓ Make your own list below of the schools in which you would like to enrol your child. You can find out how many free places are available in the schools from 25 February on https://meldjeaan.leuven.be (in the bar top right under 'info over scholen'). You can enter as many schools as you like.
 - It is important to choose several schools. This will give you a better chance of an enrolment. It won't affect your first choice.
- ✓ Below write down the schools in order of preference. Always put your favourite school at number 1. For the first three schools you automatically have an extra chance of a place when free places are allocated.

STEP 1: Register your child

When? From Tuesday 1 March 2022 (9 am) to Tuesday 29 March 2022 (5 pm).

STEP 2: You will receive an e-mail or letter

On Tuesday 26 April 2022 you will receive an e-mail. You can also find the results in a message in your personal inbox at https://meldjeaan.leuven.be.

What happens if you don't get a mail on 26 April 2022?

Send a mail to info@meldjeaan.leuven.be or call 016 27 26 17.

What happens if there is no place for your child? Then your child will be put on a waiting list for all schools at which you registered. It is possible that a place will become available for your child at one of these schools. The school will contact you in this case.

STEP 3: Enrolling in the school

When you have registered your child, that doesn't yet mean that he or she is enrolled. The school will contact you to complete the enrolment process.

When? From Thursday 28 April (9 am) to Tuesday 24 May 2022 (5 pm).

Period 3: For all children who still have no place

Have you still not found a place in the previous period(s)?

On **Wednesday 1 June 2022** you will find an overview of the open places at https://meld-jeaan.leuven.be (bar top right under 'info over scholen').

The open enrolments start on Thursday 2 June 2022 (9 am).

How to register

Practical steps:

- ✓ Go to https://meldjeaan.leuven.be
- ✓ Watch the video clip to find out how the registration system works
- ✓ Choose a password and user name
 - Remember your password and user name; you will need them if you ever want to check or change your details.
- ✓ Follow the steps on the screer

What do you need?

- ✓ A list of schools (or the school in the priority period for brothers/sisters and children of personnel), and accompanying postcodes, where you want to enrol your child.
- ✓ Your child's national registration number (see ISI+ card, the back of the Kids ID or a sticker from your health insurance fund)
 - If your child has no national registration number, please contact one of the organisations listed on page 17 and 18 or mail info@meldjeaan.leuven.be or call 016 27 26 17.
- \checkmark If you do not have a computer, you can contact the organisations listed on page 20



How are the open places distributed?

Indicator and non-indicator pupils as well as the previously outlined criteria are taken into account here.

I. Indicator and non-indicator students

The school determines beforehand how many places they reserve for indicator students and how many places for non-indicator students. You can find information about this on the school's website.

The aim is to obtain a good social mix in the school: students from all kinds of families can get a place.

Your child is an indicator student if:

✓ children in your family were eligible for a school allowance in the academic year 2020-2021 and/or 2021-2022

and/or

✓ the mother has no diploma or study certificate for secondary school education

2. Distance and preference

For each school, all registered children are ranked according to 2 criteria: distance to the school and preference for a school.

Each school can decide for itself whether to prioritise children who live close to the school or the parents' choice of school.

The school chooses from 3 options for allocating the open places:

- ✓ 70% on basis of preference and 30% on basis of distance,
- ✓ 30% on basis of preference and 70% on basis of distance,
- ✓ 50% on basis of preference and 50% on basis of distance.

Preference:

For the first 3 schools at which you register your child, you get an extra chance of being allocated one of the free places.

Distance:

As far as distance is concerned, the school takes into account the home address of the child and possibly also the parent's work address.

The distance is calculated as the crow flies.

The computer allocates each student to one school. A judicial officer ensures that the allocation procedure is carried out correctly.

How to enrol

- 1) Make an appointment with the school.
- 2) Go to the school to enroll your child.
- 3) The enrolment is final as soon as you consent to the school regulations and the pedagogical aims of the school.

What should you bring?

If possible, take your child's kids ID or ISI+ card with you. If your child does not have an official document, the school will look for another solution.

If you receive a school allowance, please bring proof such as a letter or an account statement. Your child's details will be noted on a registration form.

What happens if your child cannot be enrolled in the school of choice?

If one or more of the schools higher up in your list of preferred schools has no places left, your child will automatically be placed on the waiting list of the school(s).

You will then receive a notification concerning the unsuccessful enrolment. That is an objective proof of your child's place on the school's waiting list.

The waiting list is valid until Friday 7 October 2022. For toddlers born in 2020, the waiting list is valid until 30 June 2023.

The waiting list is only based on the criterion 'distance from the home address of the child to the school'. The preference criterion is no longer relevant.


What happens if a place does then come free in one of these schools? Then the school will contact you. If you like, you can still enrol your child in this school. You can do this even if you have already enrolled your child in another school in the meantime.

What will you receive?

✓ Proof of the successful enrolment and/or enrolment form

Special needs primary education: Leuven and surrounding areas

In order to meet the specific requirements of certain children, there are also special needs schools.

For enrolment in a special needs school, you will need a **report for access to special needs education** provided by a centre for student guidance (CLB). The addresses of the CLBs are available on page 16.

A report can only be created following an investigation and advice.

It is therefore essential to contact the CLB in good time. Together you can look for the most suitable school for your child. The special needs schools have different enrolment periods. A few schools have asked to be mentioned here.

School allowance

On 1 January 2019, the 'Groeipakket' came into force: this is the new child benefit. The previous educational grants (for nursery, primary and secondary education) were replaced as of academic year 2019-2020 by the school allowance and are automatically allocated via the 'Groeipakket'. You do not have to apply for this.




