



# DISTANCE EDUCATION FOR CITIZENS DETAINED ABROAD

#### PRISON POPULATION ACROSS EUROPE

Countries with the smallest % of foreign national prisoners

Poland (0.7%) Romania (0.9%) Moldavia (1.1%) On average: 22.1% foreign national prisoners Countries with the biggest % of foreign national prisons

San Marino (100%) Liechtenstein (87.5%) Andorra (76.9%)



Foreign national prisoners have less access to education than national prisoners

#### **Main barriers**

Only limited or totally no educational materials available

#### Most common educational couses

Courses to learn the language of the country in which they are detained

### 15 PILOT PROJECTS ACROSS EUROPE

Tested how countries can provide distance education for citizens detained abroad

14 nondigital pilots

1 digital pilot

#### 9 COUNTRIES INVOLVED



6 sent education (Germany, Greece, Lithuania, Romania, the Netherlands and UK)

#### 3 received education

(Belgium, Malta and Norway)

#### **STUDENTS**



12 students were Lithuanian, 11 Dutchmen, 10 Romanian, and 1 British, German or Greek

21 students were in prison for less than 1 year



Increased self-efficacy in reading and writing
Better perspective on reintegration
Limited the damage caused by imprisonment
95.9% would recommend the course to other prisoners

"It is a new start to build up good relationships with my home country. It is a chance to do something good. [...] More things can happen in the future, more doors can go open, more opportunities will come." (Student)

### Motives

#### Students' motives

Aquiring knowledge and skills, preparing for life upon release, spending time doing something sensible and useful

### Professionals' motives

Task to provide education, altruistic, digital opportunity

Process

## Communication between sending partner and student(s)

Directly or via an intermediary person in prison

**Time** was the **biggest investment** of professionals

Not easy to provide certified couses

Setting up digital pilot = challenging
