# BEYOND TEXT

In this workshop we introduce one example of an arts-research approach 'Beyond Text'. Through this example we aim to open a dialogue about the challenges and opportunities researchers face and deal with when doing arts-based research. The workshop is a forum of collective reflection rather than that of a traditional scholarly presentation of a study. We will focus on ways of organising artful inquiries and organise discussion around one specific form- Found Poetry. In this way we aim to learn from each others experiences, in particular about the emotions, tensions and subjectivities that often surface in this approach. We are more interested in creating an atmosphere in which we can make sense together about arts based research than explaining it away.

We purposefully aim to keep this 90 minutes workshop intimate as though we are sat around the same kitchen table (approximately 12 participants). We welcome experienced, early career researchers and all inbetween. Please bring paper and pen or pencil with you to this online session.
