'Shocking' care home outbreaks at levels not seen since first peak

Cases have more than trebled in a month as vaccine rollout hits unexpected delays

Healthcare workers in care homes have more than trebled in a month, with the latest figures showing the highest weekly total since records began, and the numbers were 'shocking' to health bosses.

It comes as the Government last night announced a new tier system for England's care sector, with nearly 100 new cases of a new strain of Covid-19 identified in care homes over the previous two weeks.

But while the new figures came after the latest figures for the number of people testing positive in care homes were published, it was still the highest daily figure in the first month of the new strain.

Ministers have pledged that all care homes will be given a vaccine by the end of this month. But the Telegraph can reveal that the rollout was taking longer than they had anticipated, with care homes that could only vaccinate 100 residents last week now having to wait until next Friday.

It follows a 24-hour period of uncertainty as the Health Secretary, Matt Hancock, was forced to postpone his visit to a care home in south London after it emerged he had been tested as negative for six days earlier.

He has now been told to give his go-ahead to the vaccine roll-out, which has been delayed over the previous four days.

Concerns about the new variant are fueling a fall in visitors to residential care homes, experts have reported.

The new PHE data shows that most new cases of the new strain are in care homes, and that the week up to Jan 10 saw a sharp rise in the number of new infections in care homes in four of the five English regions.

It marks a stark rise since the beginning of the year, with new infections in care homes up 227% compared to the same period last April, where 1,230 care homes reported
