Global

CEDAW and CSW

CEDAW (The Convention on the Elimination of All Forms of Discrimination against Women) was adopted by the United Nations General Assembly on December 18, 1979 is the most important human rights instrument for women under international law.

In this context and in the global view we have to see the participation of Zonta International on the women's rights. Zonta collaborates with UN agencies.

The Commission on the Status of Women (CSW), a functional commission of the United Nations Economic and Social Council (ECOSOC), is a global policy-making body dedicated exclusively to promoting gender equality and the empowerment of women.



The Commission was established by ECOSOC resolution 11 (II) of 21 June 1946 with a mandate to prepare recommendations on promoting women's rights in political, economic, civil, social and educational fields.

You know, since 1969, Zonta has held consultative status with the United Nations Economic and Social Council (ECOSOC).

This year the 67th session of the Commission on the Status of Women (CSW) take place from 06-17 March in New York.

The focus for this year is:

- Priority theme: Innovation and technological change, and education in the digital age for achieving gender equality and the empowerment of all women and girls
- Review theme: Challenges and opportunities in achieving gender equality and the empowerment of rural women and girls (agreed conclusions of the sixty-second session)
- Many Side Events outside the formal program of the session

Cause of the Covid Pandemic in the last three years it was impossible to take part in person in this session.

This year it is possible to join the event whether in person or virtually.
