It was all in all a wonderful experience, we laughed heartily, worked in a concentrated manner and achieved our goal to reach a consensus about working together with District 29 concerning the Youngsters (see above).



Unfortunately, **Carola Schäfer** (Young Women in Public Affairs Awards) was excused from participating in the DBM in Hanover that is why we postponed this part of the agenda to the next DBM in **Antwerpen (14.-16.04 2023)**.

As you know I have planned that we in the District learn more about each other and our activities in the field of advocacy, this - in the best case – may result in "best practices" as well as a reporting system about what is being done and thought about these activities inside and also outside the Zonta world. This is what is called policies in the Istanbul Convention.



On our special topic of the Meeting: "Advocacy" Firstly we were told competently about the way things are going at present at the UN and CSW by **Karin Lange**.

Secondly the Advocacy Country View which gave us the strong connection regarding the international ideas of Advocacy and what this means to us as a District, and last but not least our own and personal view on Advocacy was reflected very intensively and understandably by **Christiane Lemberg**. Her talk ended with a schedule of three steps:

- 1. Structure: Build a D27 Advocacy network
- 2. Information: Becoming experts on the field of causes
- 3. Networking: Exchanging ideas in D27 to be more effective and become stronger

Unfortunately, we were not able to organize a Meeting as Kick-Off for ADs and Delegates in December 2022.

This is our task for January 2023. I hope in all the 75 Clubs there is one Zontian, who would like to be Area and/or Club officer for Advocacy.

The third part of this theme was prevention and protection in a very practical sense. This means for me to bundle all the work around ZsN that is done by the clubs on the ground. Unfortunately, Lut de Baene couldn't take part in the DBM.
