I kick off this newsletter with a recap of our recent District 27 Conference, which took place at a historic place and an exceptional venue, located in the District Grund of the City of Luxembourg.



This capital city is complex and cosmopolitan like its inhabitants of round about 170 nations. Zonta is cosmopolitan as well. This Abbay, from my point of view, the history and the current use of the locality also fits Zonta (getting out of old thinking spaces but preserving what is tried and tested, describing new contexts).

The District Conference - besides its business as usual - like the elections of the next district leadership, the discussions and reports of the different fields of Zonta business is an important Zonta event during the biennium.

I was really happy to have Anne-Marie French Cudjoe our Liaison of Zonta International by my side at the conference.

A really special event at this Conference was the handing over of the Zonta International Honorary Member certificate to H.R.H. the Grand Duchess of Luxembourg by Zonta International President Ute Scholz at the Opening Ceremony.





**The Grand Duchess of Luxembourg** has engaged in Women's issues and has supported the Luxembourgish Zontians in their ZSN actions, for a long time.





Another special event at this Opening Ceremony was the handing over of a cheque of 5.000 € for the Zonta International Foundation for Women by the Cycling Team of Area 05. This team of several Lady Cyclists generated this money only by muscle power (Chapeau!!).





The motto of this biennium conference: **"Zonta and its public** *health approach in the widest sense"* has developed from a coming together of older, experienced and younger, committed Zontians to the Zonta vision: Build a better world for women and girls.

I was so excited to see that the ideas of the youngsters and their plans matched with my ideas and considerations.

We had a special program designed from a special working group of Zonta Luxembourgish Clubs (Prof. Skerdilajda Zanaj and Dr. Kerstin Wagner) for the Alumnis and young Zonta members at this District Conference with very interesting and enlightening speeches and workshops from extraordinary speakers:

Dr. Amal Tawakuli (Gender bias, in Artificial Intelligence); Prof. Marie Friedel (Gender Bias in Health Care), this co-event was also very interesting for the elderly too.

And the speech of Prof. Catherine Van de Heyning (The Mental Health Crisis of our Youngsters through a social Media lens) was interesting for the Youngsters too.

Moreover, we had 4 engaging workshops, about Membership challenges and Opportunities (Ria Matthijssens, Area 06); How to keep new members (Sandra Renaud, Area 02);

Zonta and the Power of Advocacy: A beginner's guide to making an impact (Christiane Lemberg, Area 07) and one about ZAC: Zonta Awardees Connected (an international network within Zonta connecting all awardees) (Inge van Schelstraete, Area 05).

Dr. Bianca Schuchardt (Area 07) moderated the wonderful,

lively Business lunch with many Awardees and Zontians ("Great Girls Meet Great Women") a highlight.

We really enjoyed that some Zonta Friends of the Ukraine could join us in these very difficult times.



## Key decisions at District Conference

Several important decisions were taken at the 15<sup>th</sup> D27 Conference in Luxembourg:

## ZI Bylaws Amendments and Resolution – Voting -

The Resolution regarding the "Zonta says NO to violence against women"- Campaign

The Resolution to extend Women in STEM Scholarship (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics) for another biennium.



The Women in STEM Scholarship is to be continued as a fourth pilot cycle on club, district, and international level for women in all STEM fields.

A final evaluation shall be presented at the 2026 Convention.

The resolutions are adopted unanimously.
