Zonta District 27 now has again 76 Clubs and a new Z-Club, the club Sakura of ZC Uzhhorod, Ukraine.

At the end of April we chartered **ZC Schleswig** the northernmost **ZC** in Germany.

It is club number 2050, the 76th Zonta Club in District 27 and the 18th Club in Area 03.

Building this club took time, but they started with the largest membership I have ever heard about. Thirty-three members participated in the Charter ceremony. Look at the picture - there were so many members that it was difficult for the photographer to fit them all into one photo.

The Charter event was truly wonderful, beginning with a boat trip on the Schlei, followed by a guided tour of the old town of Schleswig, the Charter ceremony in Schleswig's town hall, in the presence of our ZIP Ute Scholz and concluding with a long-lasting "Come together" at a hotel in the evening.







The new Z-Club Sakura of ZC Uzhhorod started around the same time in Area 04, in the presence of our D27 Refugee Aid Coordinator in Ukraine, Régine Deguelle.



I am truly impressed by the energy and the active role the Zontians in the Ukraine play with their help and support. May your strength be endless!

Over the past three months, I have participated in various Area Events:

In March Area 07 held its last Area Meeting in Göttingen, where the Area Director Vicky Pulvermacher, ZC Potsdam took over for the Biennium 2024 -2026.

Topics discussed included practical applications of advocacy in the clubs, reducing expenses for upcoming Area Meetings and the history and the future direction of Zonta.

The Meeting was well organized and took place in a warm and friendly atmosphere.

From March 11th to 22nd Zontians worldwide attended the CSW68,

the annual Commission on the Status of Women (CSW68) held in person in NYC with hundreds of workshops available online.

I was able to attend online.

The 68th session focused on the priority theme:

"Accelerating the achievement of gender equality and the empowerment of all women and girls by addressing poverty and strengthening institutions and financing with a gender perspective".

Currently 10.3% of women globally live in extreme poverty and they are poorer than men. To achieve the Sustainable Development Goals by 2030, Progress towards ending poverty needs to be 26 times faster.

Solutions to end women's poverty are widely recognized: investing in policies and programs that address gender inequalities and boosting women's agency and leadership.

From April 12th to 14th, the 5th DB Meeting of District 27 took place in Beaune (France).

Our last DBM of this Biennium was held in Beaune, a wonderful picturesque place in **Burgundy of France.**





First of all, at the Business meeting the minutes of DBM IV in Osnabrück were unanimously adopted.

On behalf of the District 27 Finance 2022-2024, our treasurer Géraldine Welvet announced that the financial problems of the District 27 which we inherited from previous Biennia and started with at the beginning of this Biennium, have been resolved. We can now pass the District 27 finances over to the next board in good standing.

Ria, the incoming governor of D27, reported on the meeting of all incoming Zonta governors from around the world held at Zonta Headquarter in Chicago. It was a warm-hearted encounter.

One main topic discussed was the Strategic Plan 2023-2030, which we had previously discussed at our last DBM in Osnabrück, as well as Sustainability, Climate justice – Climate change effecting women and how to engage districts and clubs.

I provided some information about the Convention in Brisbane. This included the solution we found for the Proxy Problems that some Areas of our district faced.



The District 27 Meeting at the International Convention will be on Friday June 28 at 8:00 in the KiKi's, and I also mentioned the Memorial Service and the training for Delegates of Area 03 and 07 in Hamburg.

I am pleased to report that all Proxy problems in our District are resolved and the voices of District 27 will be heard in Brisbane.

We also considered ideas for the future of the Areas and the District 27.

Christina Bremer led a discussion on this topic, focusing on our plans for the Strategic Plan and our contribution to the 10th European Inter-District Seminar 'Standing up for Diversity, Equity and Inclusion' in Copenhagen (May 2-4, 2025) - District 13.

One highlight of this wonderful stay in Beaune was the presentation "Insight Unesco" by

Ursula Bouchard (Chair of the Zonta Unesco team in Paris and delegate since 2014).

She also guided our tour of the Hotel-Dieu, Hospices de Beaune.

"A unique place where the spirit of the ducal Burgundy radiates!"

This hospital, "a palace of the poor" was established in 1443 by Nicolas Rolin, chancellor to the duke of Burgundy and his wife, Guigone de Salins. In this wonderful construction, in which the finest materials were used, ensuring its continued existence for centuries.





After this impressive and informative visit, we had a very hospitable gathering in a beautiful private garden!



The next day we had our final Zoom Meeting with the Committee Chairs of District 27 for this Biennium.

All committee members and the incoming Area Directors (2024-2026) were invited.





After my report on the Biennium 2022-2024, they shared their experiences with committee work, wishes for the future and suggestions for improvements.

We concluded this DBM with farewells and the presentation of some gifts in the true Zonta Spirit.



In early May Area 06 organized its second biennial Area Meeting in Brussels:

It took place in the Erasmus room of the Federal Parliament.

The theme was: "How do we envision the future of Zonta?" and "How can we foster stronger partnerships with esteemed organizations such as UN Women, UNFPA, Guberna, all of whom work with great engagement for gender equality?"

The perspectives of the panel members - the director of the UN Population Fund (UNFPA), the Executive Director of Guberna, the Deputy Director of UN Women Brussels office and our District Committee chair for Advocacy Country View - offered valuable insights.

This official part of the meeting was closed by a wonderful gospel choir performance.

The meeting also honored those responsible for the Area Board and the Club Presidents of the ending Biennium.



I participated and was impressed by the well-organized meeting and the warm atmosphere.

This inspiring meeting ended up with an exclusive guided tour of the "behind-the-scenes" areas of the Belgian Federal Parliament and Senate.

In early June 2024 Area 05 organized its second biennial Area Meeting in Ledegem:

"The FESTIVE AREA DAY of Zonta Area 05!" with around 80 people.

Before this meeting, some Zontians invited me to Ghent, where we explored the interesting city by foot on a



wonderful evening without rain!!

The next day we had a really busy Agenda with several speeches and a great thank you to many members of Area 05.

It was a wonderful retrospective of the past two years of this Area in the true Zonta Spirit, with the exchange of club presidents, area board and area committees, followed by the opening of the new biennium 2024-2026.
