



#### Important aspects from Survey Unmet needs in Germany

- Faster diagnosis
- Awareness for our rare disease: faster referral to a Center of Expertise through the outpatient health care
- Better communication among the different care teams: hospital / outpatient partners
- Research: ways for a prediction and prevention of a possible aggressive outcome (for example pNETS). Therefore the inclusion of patients in a database – EuRRECa – is neccessary und needs improvement.



- aimed at maximising the opportunity for patients, health care professionals and researchers to participate and use high-quality registries.
- includes an e-reporting programme (e-REC) and a core registry, that collects a common dataset and clinician and patient reported outcome.

The MEN module - similiar to the parathyroid module - will be added.


We didn't manage to involve some more European groups. We are still in contact with families in Spain and Greek.


