Advisory Action read by Francine during workshop:

1989 It was recommended that: The 1979 Conference Action be reaffirmed: “Conference Committee selection continue to be by lot with the widest possible geographical distribution.” It was the sense of the meeting that any other method could erode the confidence of the Conference in the committee system. (Policy/Admissions) The 1987 Conference Action from the Policy/Admissions Committee be modified to read: “Each Conference Committee carefully consider their agenda items and strive to make their recommendations for Advisory Actions to the Conference at the policy level. To be more financially responsible, when a Conference committee recommendation involves a substantial expenditure of money, an estimate of cost and its impact on the budget be part of that recommendation. (Policy/Admissions)
