Buchman sailed for America on August 19th, 1936, immediately following the Olympic Games in Germany. Arriving in New York, he held a press conference at Calvary House, from which a number of journalists sent off routine stories. The reporter of the afternoon paper, the New York World-Telegram, arrived late and asked for a special interview.

August 26 1936

William H Birnie from "N.Y. World Telegram" Magazine quoted Frank Buchman as saying,

"I thank heaven for a man like Adolph Hitler, who built a front-line of defense against the anti-Christ of Communism."
