FACTS	WHAT DOES Solve Finance Corp. DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?	
Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.	
What?	<p>The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Social Security number and income; ● account balances and bank account information; ● transaction history; ● credit history and credit scores; ● current and past loan and credit card information; and ● current and past loan offers. 	
How?	All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons Solve Finance Corp. chooses to share and whether you can limit this sharing.

Who is providing this notice?	Solve Finance Corp.
What we do	
How does Solve Finance Corp. protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards, secured files and buildings and encryption at rest of stored information.
How does Solve Finance Corp. collect my personal information?	<p>We collect your personal information, for example, when you</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● sign up for a Solve.Finance account; ● connect your bank or other financial accounts; or ● authorize us to pull your credit report; ● apply for a loan; <p>We also collect your personal information from others, such as banks, credit agencies and other third-party data aggregators.</p>
Why can't I limit all sharing?	<p>Federal law gives you the right to limit only:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes - information about your credit worthiness ● affiliates from using your information to market to you ● sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you <p>State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.</p>
What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else?	Your choices will apply to everyone on your account.
Definitions	
Affiliates	<p>Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Franklin Credit Management Corporation (FCMC) is the loan servicing partner of Solve Finance.
Nonaffiliates	<p>Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Solve Finance Corp. does not share nonpublic personal information with nonaffiliates.
Joint marketing	<p>A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Solve Finance Corp. is not a party to any joint marketing agreements.
