FROM DOWNTOWN LAS VEGAS

The Clark County Shooting Range is located approximately 15 miles NW of downtown Las Vegas. From the downtown area, take I-15 north eight miles to the County 215 Beltway. Go west on the Beltway eight miles until you come to Decatur Blvd. Turn north on Decatur and follow to the end (about four miles). It will bring you right to the facility.

FROM AIRPORT (Mccarran International)

Leaving airport or Car Rental Center, get on 215 (Bruce Woodbury Beltway) and travel west to I-15 North. Exit onto I-15 North and continue eight miles past downtown and you will come to the Northern loop of the 215 Beltway. Go west on the 215 Beltway another eight miles until you come to Decatur Blvd. Turn north on Decatur and follow four miles to the facility.

FROM UTAH OR NORTHERN NEVADA (Ely, Elko are Rt. 93) (Interstate 15 heading south)

Heading south on I-15, take the 215 West Beltway, (Exit 52) (RH lane exit). This will be after you pass Las Vegas Motor Speedway. Continue on 215 west until you come to Decatur Blvd. Take a right at Decatur Blvd. Exit (will be heading north). Decatur runs right into the facility at the foot of the mountain and follow directional signs. Once at the facility follow signs to the shotgun venue.

FROM CALIFORNIA (Interstate 15 heading north)

Coming into Las Vegas on I-15, continue past downtown another eight miles until you come to the 215 Beltway West. Go west on the Beltway eight miles until you come to Decatur Blvd. Turn north on Decatur and follow to the end (about four miles). It will bring you right to the facility.

FROM ARIZONA

Coming from Kingman stay on 95, or coming from Laughlin area, take 95 towards Las Vegas. Once you hit 95, it turns into 515/95 and continues toward and through downtown Las Vegas. Once you are in the downtown area, take I-15 North (Salt Lake City) and continue north on I-15 eight miles until you see the sign that says 215 West (only way it goes). Go west on the 215 Beltway eight miles until you come to Decatur blvd. Turn north on Decatur and follow to the end (about four miles). It will bring you right to the facility.

FROM RENO (Tonopah, Fallon area)

Coming into Las Vegas on 95, exit Durango, turn right. Follow Durango to 215. Turn left (East) on 215 to Decatur Blvd. Then left (North) on Decatur four miles to Clark County Shooting Complex.

General Information for All Shooters

- 1. Solid Orange White Flyer targets will be thrown on all fields.
- 2. Doubles will be shot in two 25 pair sub events.
- 3. Shooters, winning or tying for class in any singles or doubles event in this program, will be advanced at least one class for the next like event. There will be no class advances on Tuesday and Wednesday. Should you earn yardage in any Handicap event, it shall be your duty to report to the Handicap chairman or his designee for earned yardage punches before the start of the next Handicap event. Trophies for HOA and HAA shall be based on classification at sign up.
- 4. PLEASE CHECK YOUR SCORE AFTER FIRING AT EACH 5 TARGETS. Any single score not clearly marked DEAD with X or /, or O for a lost target, will be considered a lost target. If a target is marked dead or lost, when in fact it was not marked correctly, then dead needs to be clearly written, or the target will be considered lost.

5. NSTA Disclaimer

By entering the competition, every person agrees to accept all official decisions and to abide by ATA rules. By the act of classifying and participating, each person has indicated they assume and accept full responsibility for themselves and their minor children, for bodily injury, death, or loss of personal property and expenses as a result of inherent risks and dangers.

- All shooters are invited to attend the Nevada State Shoot. Cross registration of targets will be available at this tournament. All added money in this shoot is open to all shooters.
- 7. Shells will be available at the gun club. No other shells may be sold on the club grounds. Reloads may be used throughout the entire Tournament, provided they conform to ATA regulations. All shells are subject to inspection at any time. Any shooter found using ammunition exceeding standard trap loads will be disqualified and will forfeit entry fees, purses and options.
- 8. All shooters will be charged a daily NSTA fee of \$3.00 and an ATA fee of \$3.00
- 9. Management reserves the right to refuse any entry or to disqualify anyone who interferes with or disturbs the harmony of this shoot in any manner. The NSTA reserves the right to modify this shoot if necessary.
- 10. Any shooter who wants to re-squad or misses his squad etc., will be charged a \$20.00 resquading fee provided such instances are not managements fault. If you resquad, you will be placed on the same bank as your original squad would have shot.
- 11. ALL SHOOTERS MAKE SURE YOUR ADDRESS IS CORRECT ON YOUR PLAS-TIC CARD. THE CORRECT ADDRESS IS REQUIRED IN ORDER THAT MONEY YOU WIN CAN BE MAILED TO YOU.
- 12. IMPORTANT NOTE: PLEASE PICK UP ALL TROPHIES BY SUNDAY
- 13. Trophies will be available in the Shotgun Center, Fri., Sat., and Sun. 12:00 to 5:00. Trophies will not be mailed.

Minimum Target Requirements For All

To avoid penalty yardage, the number of targets required to be shot in the previous two years (September 1, 2017 - August 31, 2019) and the present year (September 1, 2019 to State Shoot) combined totals are:

Singles – 1,000 targets or classified at least Class B
Doubles – 500 targets or classified at least Class B
Handicap -1,000 targets or classified at least at the 21 yard line
for Sub-Juniors, Juniors, and Lady I&II and 23 yard line for all others

The 2020 State Team Requirements

1000 SINGLES, 1000 HANDICAP, and 500 DOUBLES targets. Eligibility for the State Team also requires that the shooter must shoot the three Championship Events at the State Shoot along with shooting three different gun clubs within the current target year.

SHOOT OFF PARTICIPANTS MUST REPORT TO THE CLASSIFICATION WINDOW WITIN 10 MINUTES OF THE CALL FOR SHOOT OFFS OR FORFEIT.


