





- Doubles will be shot in 2 25 pair sub events.
- Shooters, winning or tying for class in any singles or doubles event in this program, will be
 advanced at least one class for the next like event. There will be no class advances on
 Tuesday and Wednesday. Should you earn yardage in any Handicap event, it shall be your
 duty to report to the Handicap chairman or his designee for earned yardage punches before
 the start of the next Handicap event. Trophies for HOA and HAA shall be based on
 classification at sign up.
- PLEASE CHECK YOUR SCORE AFTER FIRING AT EACH 5 TARGETS. Any single score not clearly marked DEAD with X or /, or O for a lost target, will be considered a lost target.
- NSTA Disclaimer: By entering the competition, every person agrees to accept all official
 decisions and to abide by ATA rules. By the act of classifying and participating, each person
 has indicated they assume and accept full responsibility for themselves and their minor
 children, for bodily injury, death, or loss of personal property and expenses because of
 inherent risks and dangers.
- All shooters are invited to attend the Nevada State Shoot. Cross registration to the P.I.T.A. will be available and encouraged.
- All added money in this shoot is open to all shooter unless otherwise stated in the program.
- Reloads may be used throughout the entire Tournament, provided they conform to ATA
 regulations. All shells are subject to inspection at any time. Any shooter found using
 ammunition that does not comply with ATA rules will be disqualified and will forfeit entry
 fees, purses, and options.
- All shooters will be charged a daily NSTA fee of \$3.00 and an ATA fee of \$4.00.
- Management reserves the right to refuse any entry or to disqualify anyone who interferes with or disturbs the harmony of this shoot in any manner.

- The NSTA reserves the right to modify this shoot if necessary.
- Any shooter who wants to re-squad or misses his squad etc., will be charged a \$20.00

HANDICAPPING & CLASSIFICATION

TARGET REQUIREMENTS

To avoid penalty yardage or penalty classification the shooter will have accumulated the below minimum number of targets within the current target year and the previous 2 target years:

- Singles 1000 registered.
 - o Penalty Classification: Minimum one class move up with the minimum class being B.
- Handicap 1000 registered (or Sub-Juniors, Juniors, Lady I & II classified at least the 21-yard line)
 - Penalty Yardage: 2 yard minimum. Penalty will not exceed the 25-yard line, or the current yardage, whichever is greater.
- Doubles 500 registered.
 - o Penalty Classification: Minimum one class move up with the minimum class being B.

Exceptions – There will be no handicap penalty yardage for Sr. Veterans at the Nevada State Shoot.

Yardage & Class Advances: Should you win or tie for a class in any Singles or Doubles event, or earn yardage in any Handicap event, it shall be your responsibility to report to the Classification/Handicap counter to have your classification reviewed or yardage increased.

Shooters winning or tying for class in Event # 4,6,7 & 8 will be advanced one class. Any shooter whose class or yardage is changed for any reason will be considered notified when the new class or yardage is posted on the board. In all events that include class advances, all shooters (regardless of trophy won, i.e. Champion, Runner-up, Class or Category) with scores that equal or exceed the score of the class champion will be advanced starting with the next like event.

SHOOTOFFS & TIES

ALL TIES NOTICE

All ties in singles and doubles carry over to the next singles and doubles event unless otherwise stated in the program. All other trophy ties will be shot off at the end of each day unless otherwise stated.

If necessary, ties may be carried over to the next corresponding event, be shot off concurrently in succeeding events, or at a time designated by the NSTA Directors.

Shoot off participants must report to the classification window within 10 minutes of the call for shoot offs or forfeit. Anyone in a tie who leaves the grounds or does not answer a call will forfeit their right to a shoot-off.

If shooters are called for a shoot-off and then the shoot-off cannot be concluded (ex. time limitations, weather conditions), only those shooters who have checked in are eligible for trophies. For any shoot-off that is not concluded, winners will be determined by long run from front, and ties will be determined by a coin flip performed by a tournament official.

All ties for money will be divided unless otherwise stated by management.

CATEGORY DECLARATION NOTICE

At tournaments where All American points will be awarded in any event, shooters may declare only one category (i.e. Lady I, Lady II, Sub-Junior, Junior, Junior Gold, Sub-Veteran, Veteran, or Senior Veteran) Note: Chair shooters are exempt from this rule.

Any shooter who is tied for event Champion may shoot-off/carry-over for the Championship trophy. If a shooter fails in the championship trophy shoot-off/carry- over and has declared a special category at the time of classification, the shooter can fall back to the declared category.

Any shooter who has declared a special category at the time of classification and whose score qualifies for any trophy in his/her declared category, will compete for the category trophy and not for place, class or yardage group. Any special category shooter, whose score does not qualify for a trophy in his/her category, may compete for place, class, or yardage group trophies. Once any declarations have been made either by shooter or shoot management, the declaration is final and cannot be changed. **There is no exception to this rule.**

All Lady I, Lady II, Sub-Veteran, Veteran, Sr. Veteran, Junior Gold, Junior, Sub-Junior must declare their special category at the time of classification in any registered tournament if they wish to compete as a category shooter. If no declaration is made the contestant will not be allowed to compete for the applicable category trophy for the duration of the state tournament.

No contestant will be allowed to declare or change a special category declaration after firing their first shot. **There will be no exceptions to this rule.**

Failure to declare your special category does not constitute an A.T.A. category error. Please confirm your category before leaving the classification desk.

Shooter must comply with all ATA rules and regulations and follow all the rules and regulations to be eligible for the Prize. You must be a current member of the ATA in good standing and abide by all current ATA rules and regulations governing the 76th Annual Nevada State Shoot. No exceptions will be made. If for any reason it has been determined after the prizes have been awarded that you have not complied with all the ATA rules and regulations which govern the shoot the prize will be revoked and voided

ADDITIONAL RULES & DETAILS: All ATA, NSTA and State Shoot Rules and Regulation listed in the current ATA Rulebook and the NEVADA STATE PROGRAM will be in effect. Any violations of these rules and regulations will make a shooter ineligible for the Prize. For example, a shooter competing at an incorrect handicap yardage. If the NSTA is forced to move events to different days or across additional days for any reason, a shooter will still need to participate in all HOA events 4 – 13 to be eligible. Any disputes concerning this promotion must be brought to the NSTA and will be passed on to the proper committee to make that ruling. The ruling passed down by NSTA committee will be final. Winner is responsible for any related taxes.

Bidding will take place in the outdoor pavilion of the Shooting Complex Clubhouse on Saturday afternoon immediately following the Saturday, Event #17 – Nevada State Single Championships Shoot-offs. The format will be an open outcry style auction.

All winning bids must be paid for in cash/check prior to start of Event #19 on Sunday.

COMPLIMENTARY DINNER WILL BE SERVED DURING THE AUCTION SPONSORED BY NSTA.

WINNER DETERMINATION RULES:

Special Event winners will be determined based on their scores shot during Event # 19 - Nevada State Handicap Championships - 100 Targets on Sunday October 29^{th} , 2023.

PAYOUTS:

- 1. The top 4 scores will be paid the following percentage of the bidding purse:
 - a. 1st Place 40%
 - b. 2nd Place 30%
 - c. 3rd Place 20%
 - d. 4th Place 10%
- 2. **Ties Divide** Tie scores will divide the purse for that score.


