
The life of Christopher Columbus

Christopher works as a sailor.


On one occasion his ship is sunk by pirates near Portugal.

He sailed between Portugal and Iceland. ' • Portugal



Christopher moves to Spain.






The king and queen of Spain agree to give Columbus money for his biggest voyage yet.




In August Columbus sets sail with three ships; the Pinta, the Niña and the Santa Maria.

Columbus sails along the coasts of the Bahamas and then returns home to Spain.








Columbus returns to America looking for treasure. But he comes home empty-handed. His brothers stay behind with a few others.
