




Neil Armstrong is born in Ohio, USA.




At the age of just 16 he obtains his first pilot's licence.




Neil studies aeronautical engineering at college.





A year after the World War ends, Armstrong joins the organisation that would later be called 'NASA'.


Ten years later he joins NASA's astronaut programme.

Neil drives the lunar module on the surface of the moon.


Neil and his crew mates are given medals for their achievements.




Armstrong leaves NASA to become a professor at the University of Ohio.
