


#### 55BC

The Celtic tribes of Caledonia unite together under Calgacus to fight the Romans. But they are defeated.




Hadrian's Wall is built.




Saint Ninian introduces
Christianity to Scotland.




The Roman Empire collapses and the Romans leave Britain.

Alexander III becomes King of Scotland.




William Wallace is born.

The Scottish are defeated by Edward I of England (known as Edward Longshanks) at the Battle of Falkirk.




William Wallace is executed in London.

The Battle of Bannockburn. Robert the Bruce defeats the English and gains Scottish independence.








James IV is killed in battle.

Mary Queen of Scots is executed at Fotheringay Castle.




James VI of Scotland becomes James I of England when Queen Elizabeth I dies.

This brings about the Union of the Crowns.




The Massacre of Glencoe.
