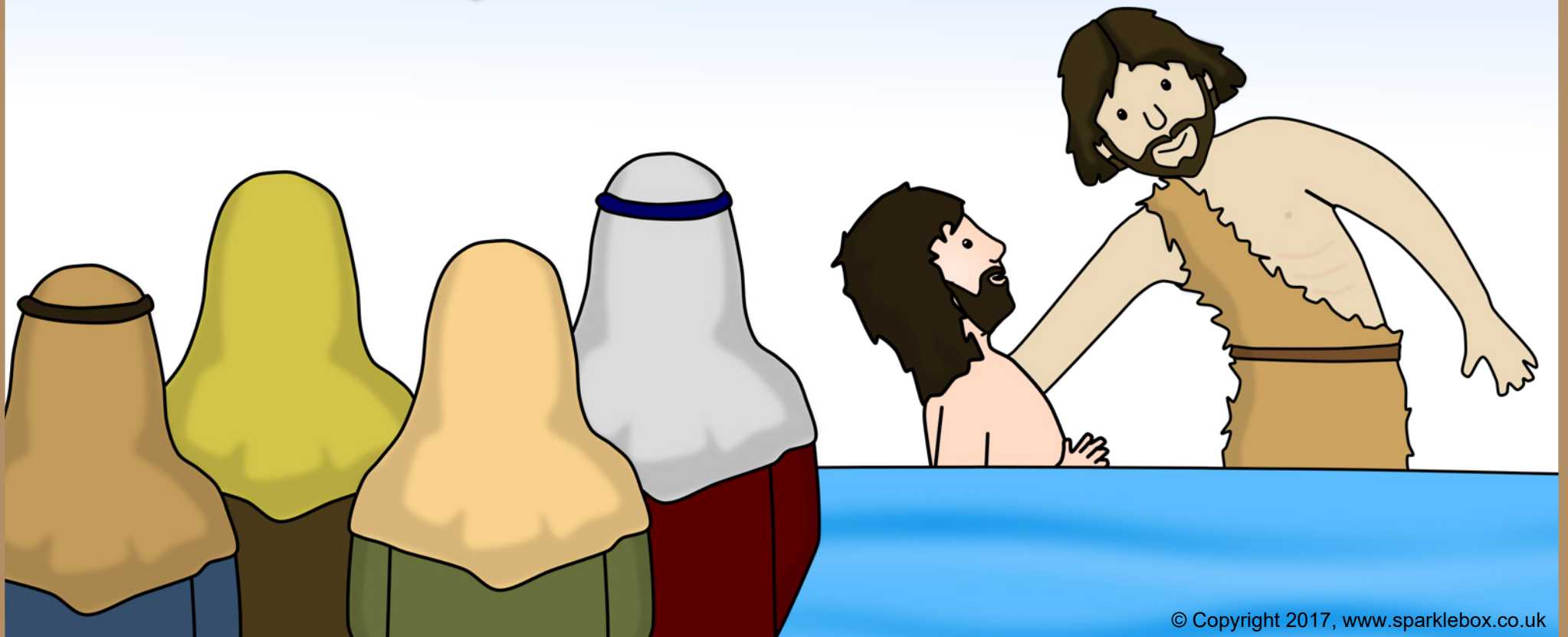
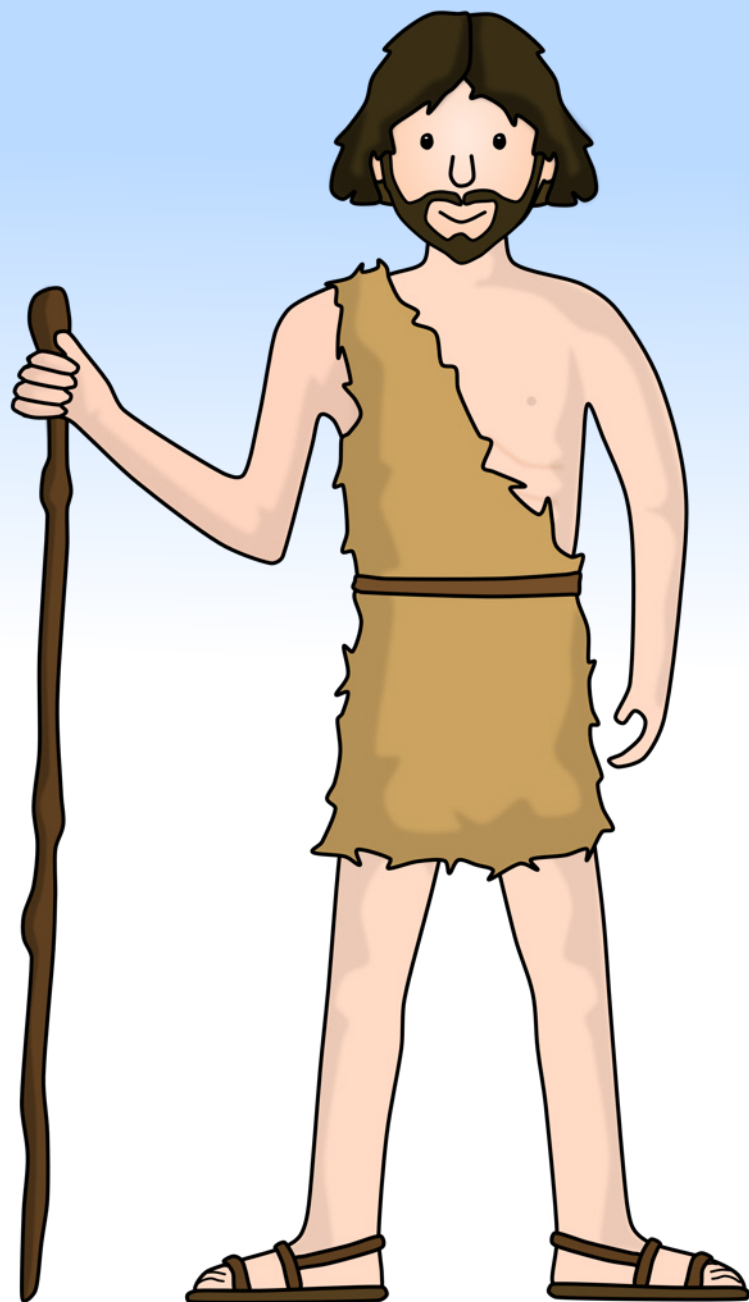
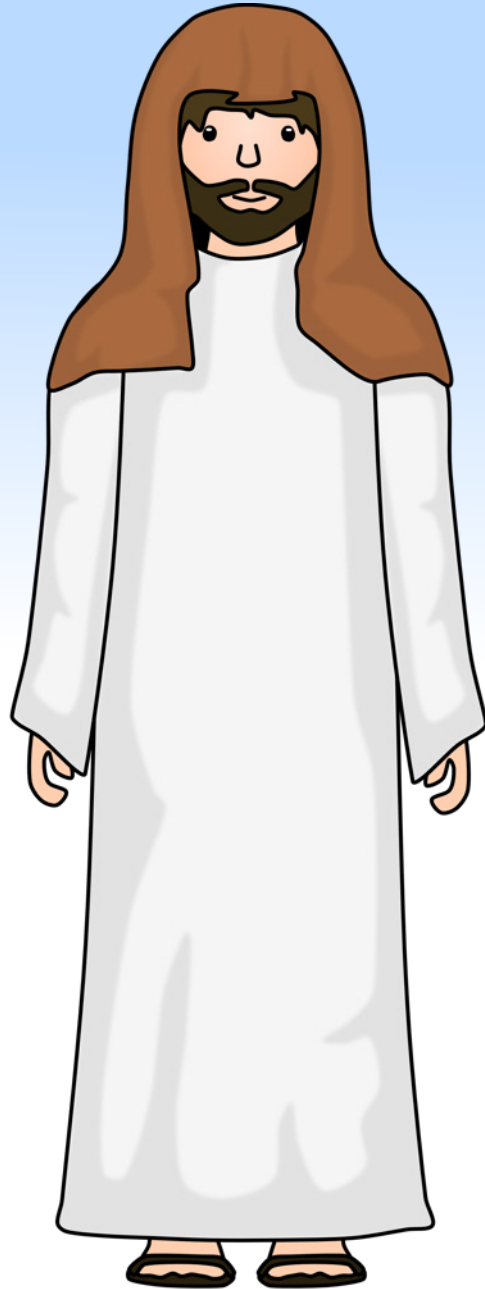


# John the Baptist Baptises Jesus

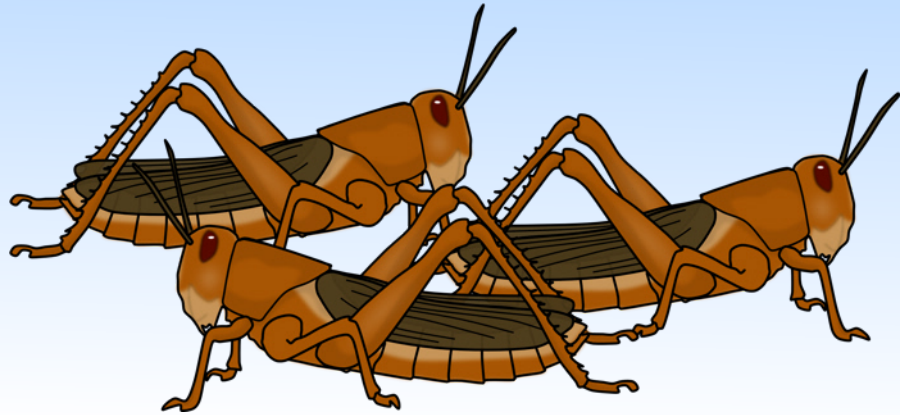




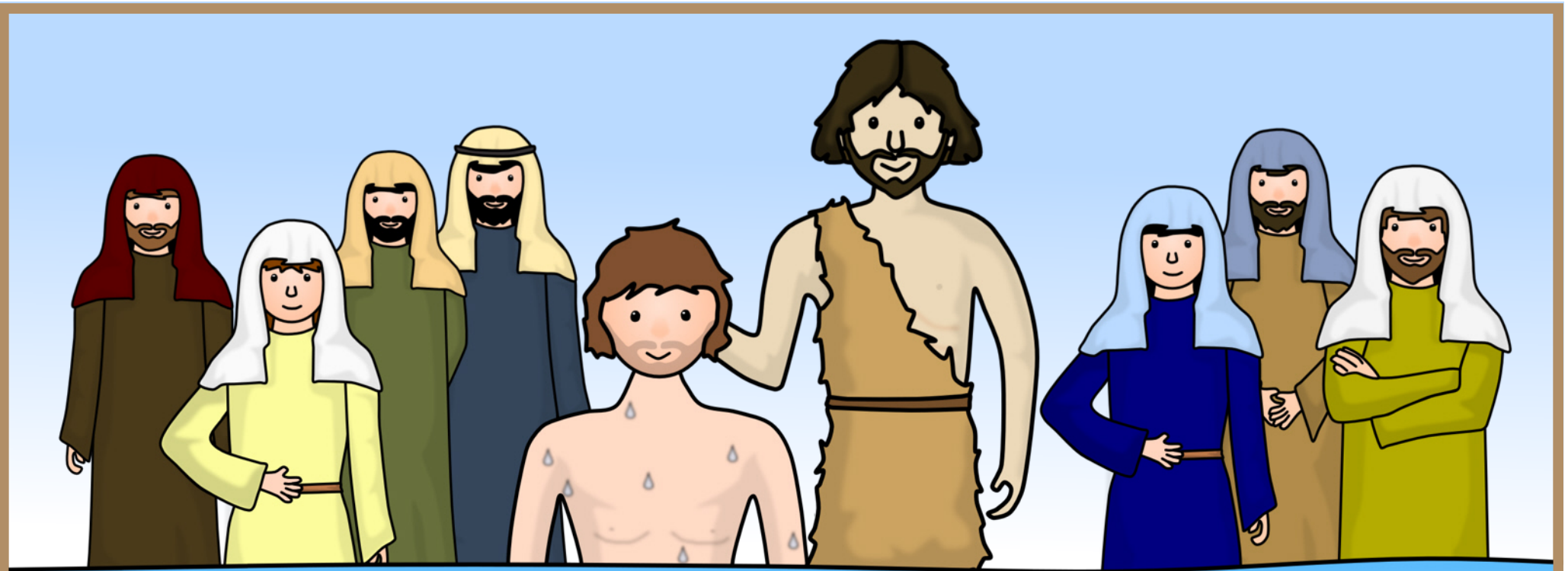

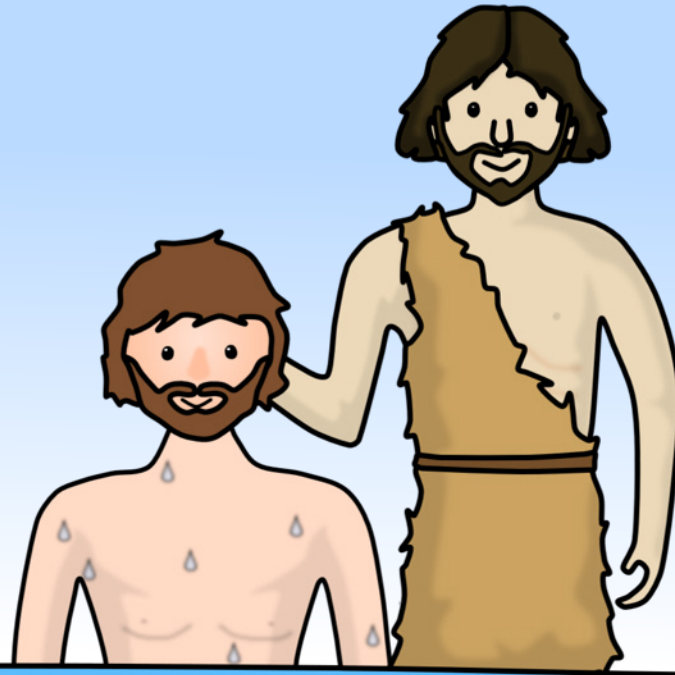

were waiting for.



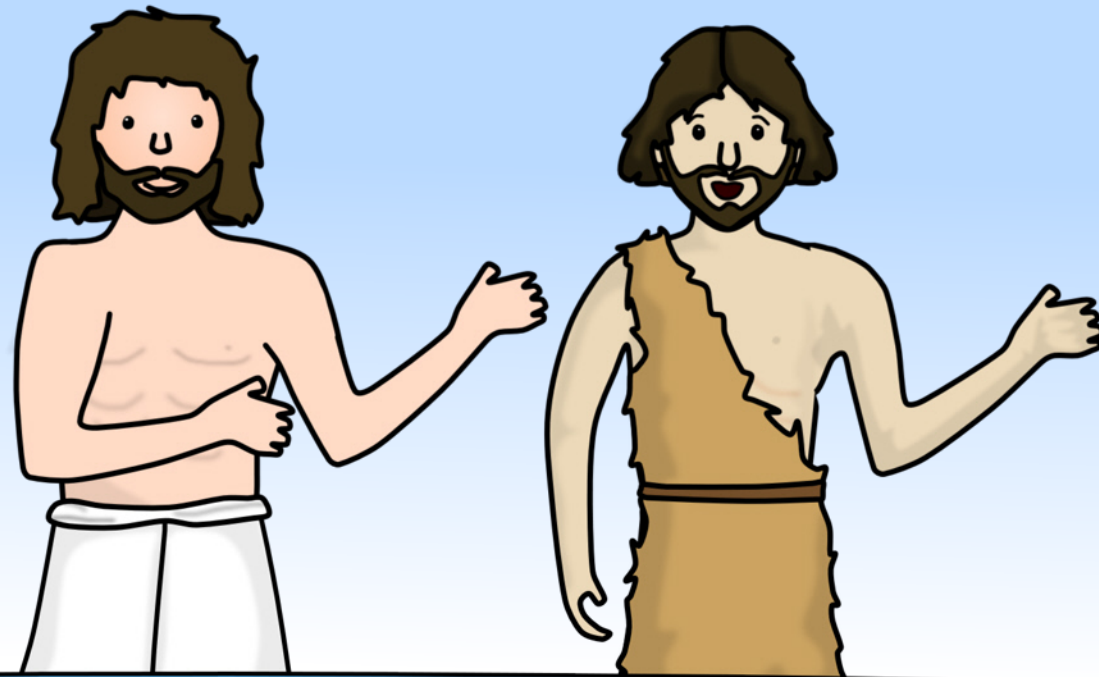


“I am baptizing you with water.
