




Anneliese Marie, or Anne, is born in Frankfurt, Germany to her parents Otto and Edith.


1933 30th January




The first laws against Jews are introduced. The Franks decide that they must move to the Netherlands for their safety.






The German army invades the Netherlands.


Anne receives a diary for her 13th birthday.



(Anne gave Fritz Pfeffer the pseudonym Albert Dussel in her diary).






1944 3rd September

They are transported in cattle car to Auschwitz Concentration Camp on the last transport ever to leave Westerbork.


At Auschwitz, the men are separated from the women.






Anne, Margot, and Mrs. van Pels are taken to the Bergen-Belsen concentration camp.

Edith Frank stays in the women's subcamp at Auschwitz-Birkenau.







Edith Frank dies at Auschwitz-Birkenau.




1945 27th January
