The River Thames is full of boats carrying people's possessions to safety.



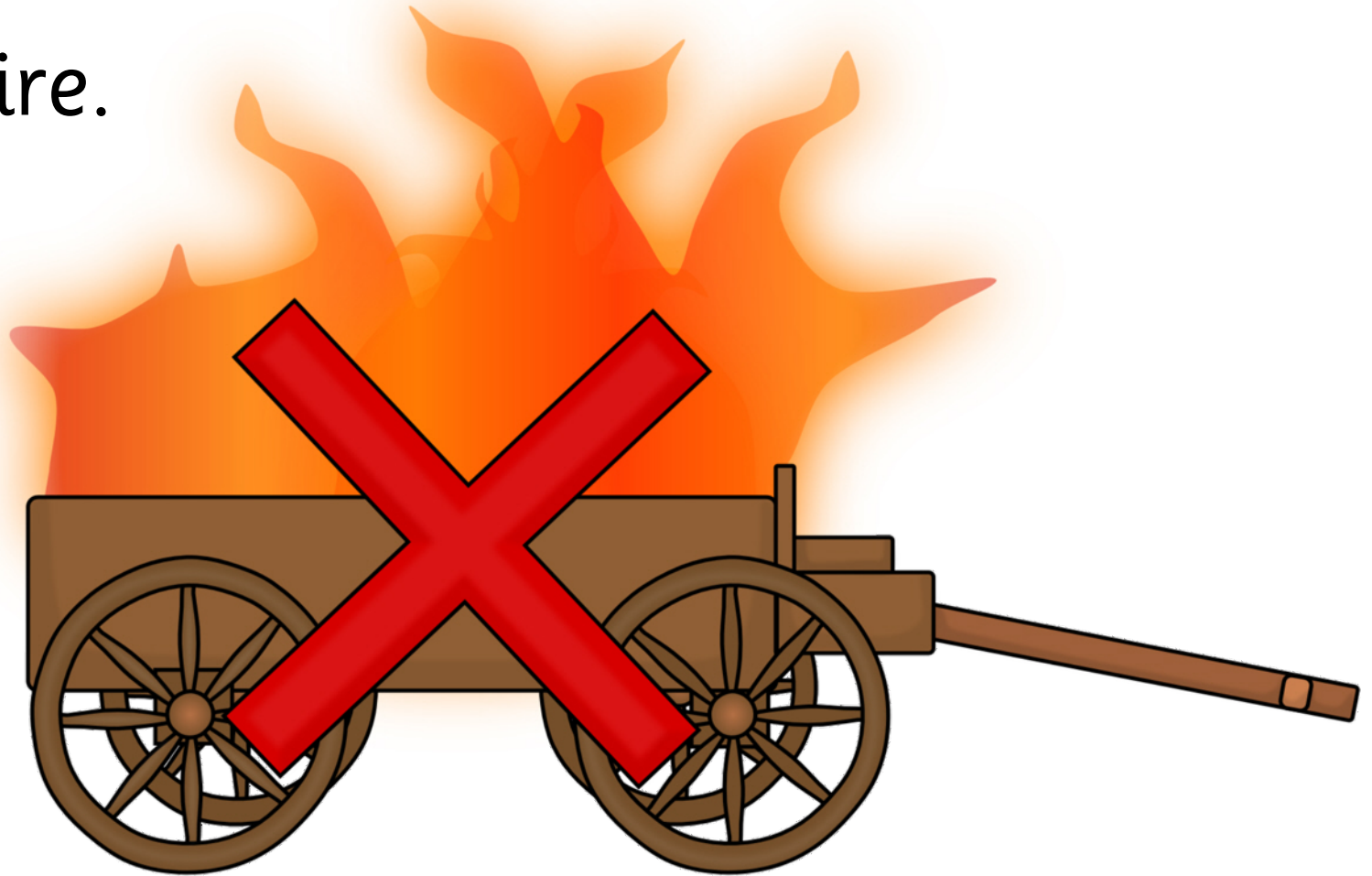


# Late Monday morning

Hot, dry and windy.

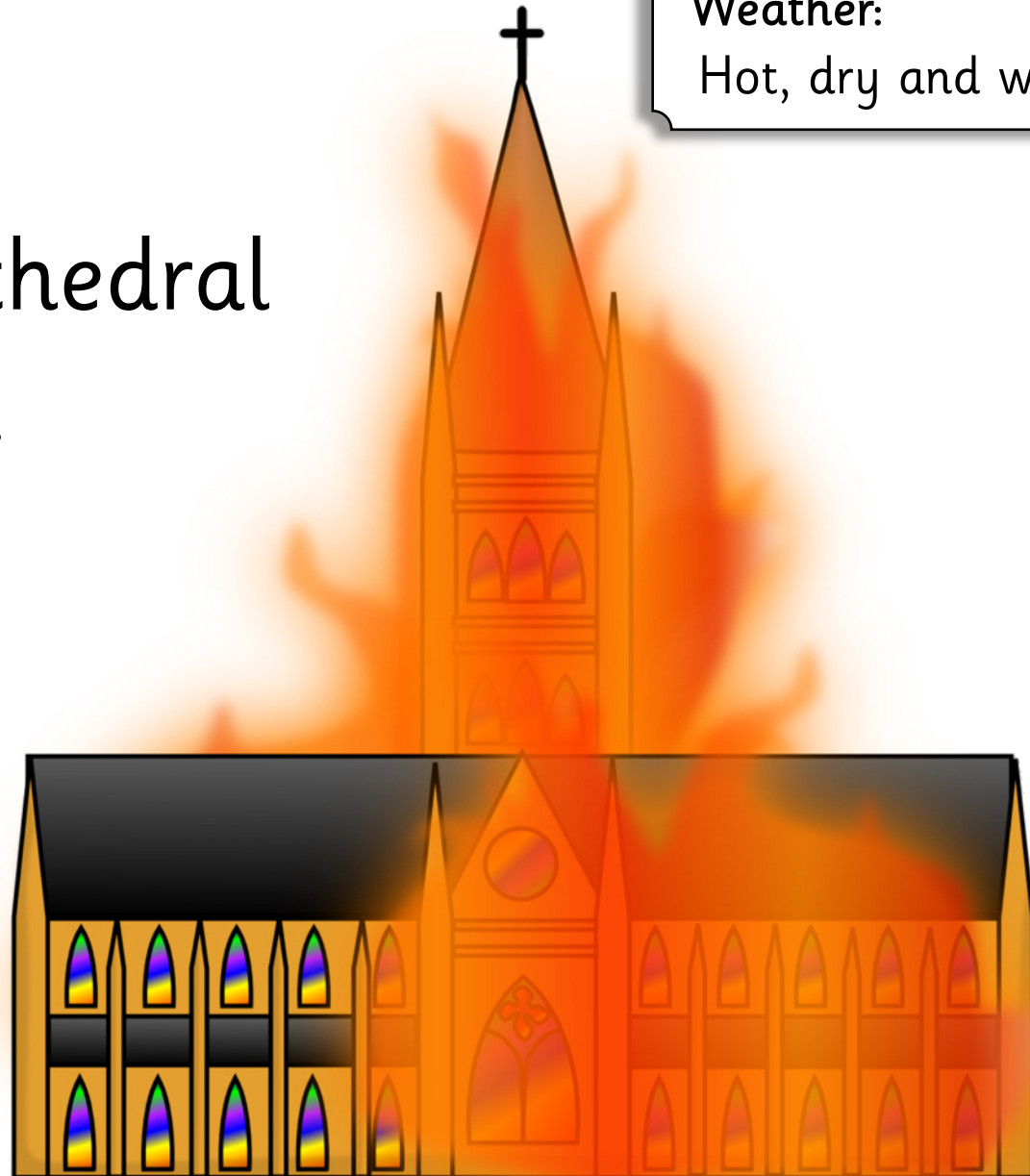
The fire is just 300 yards from the Tower of London.
