

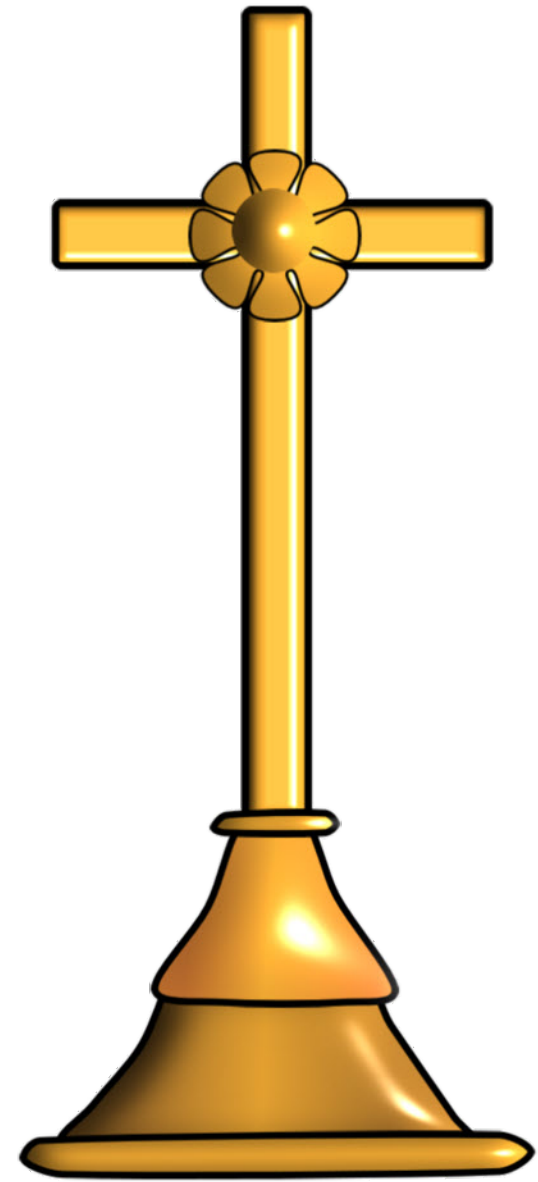
1820

1845

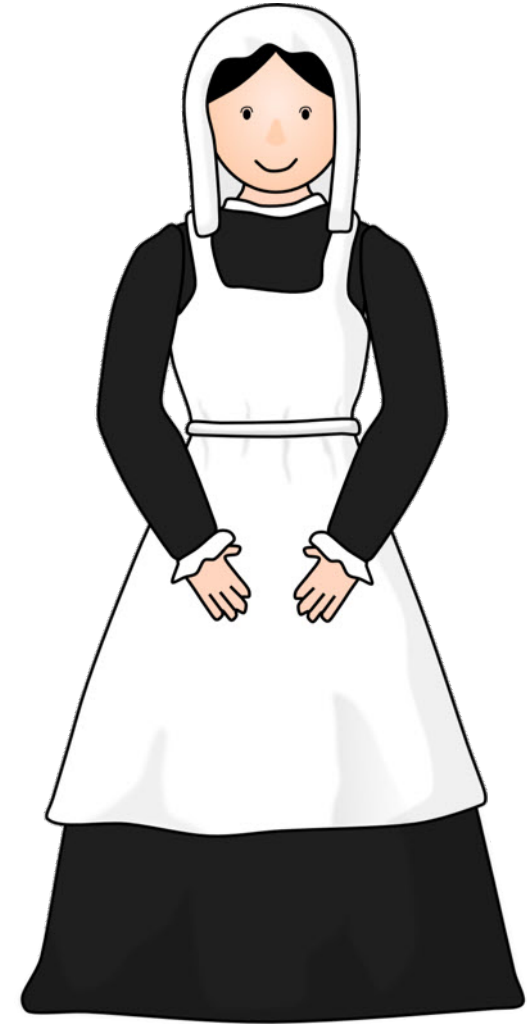
Florence decided to become a nurse.



1853

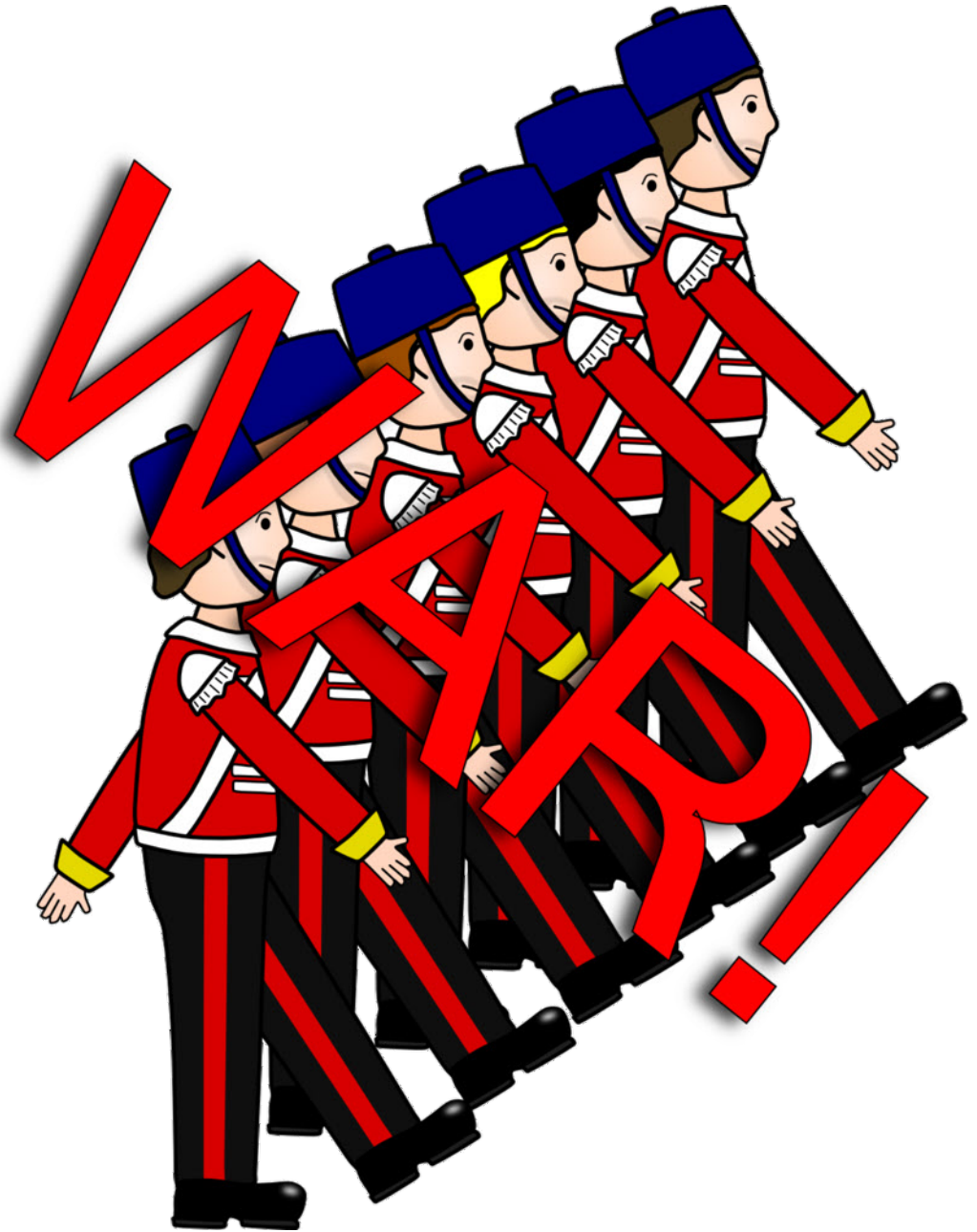
Florence became the superintendent at a women's medical centre in London.

began.



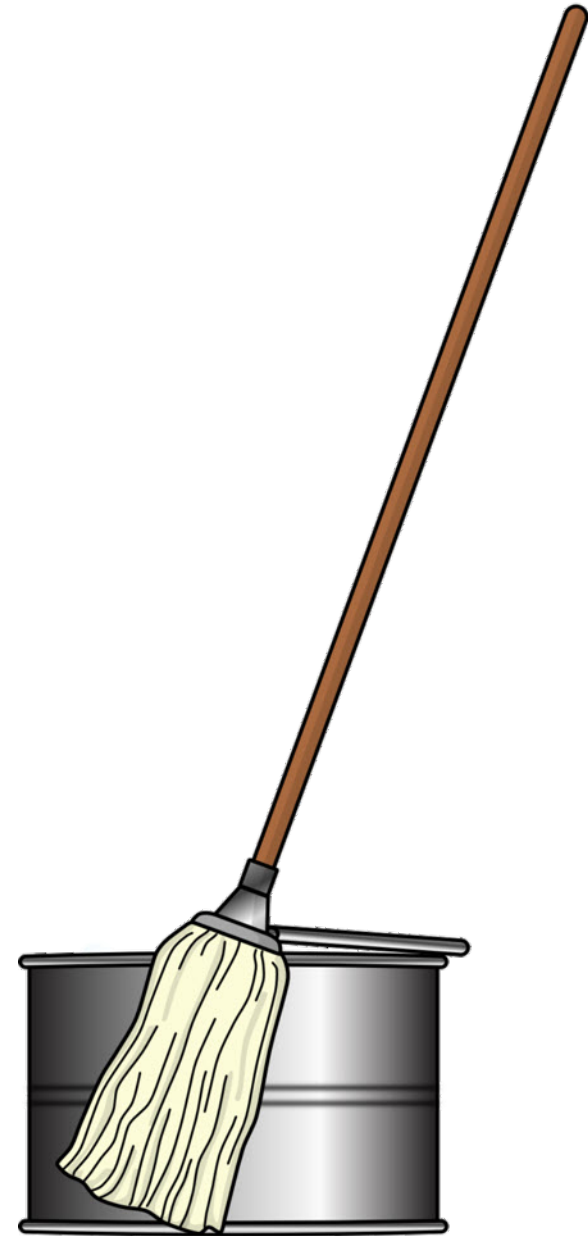
1854

was built.



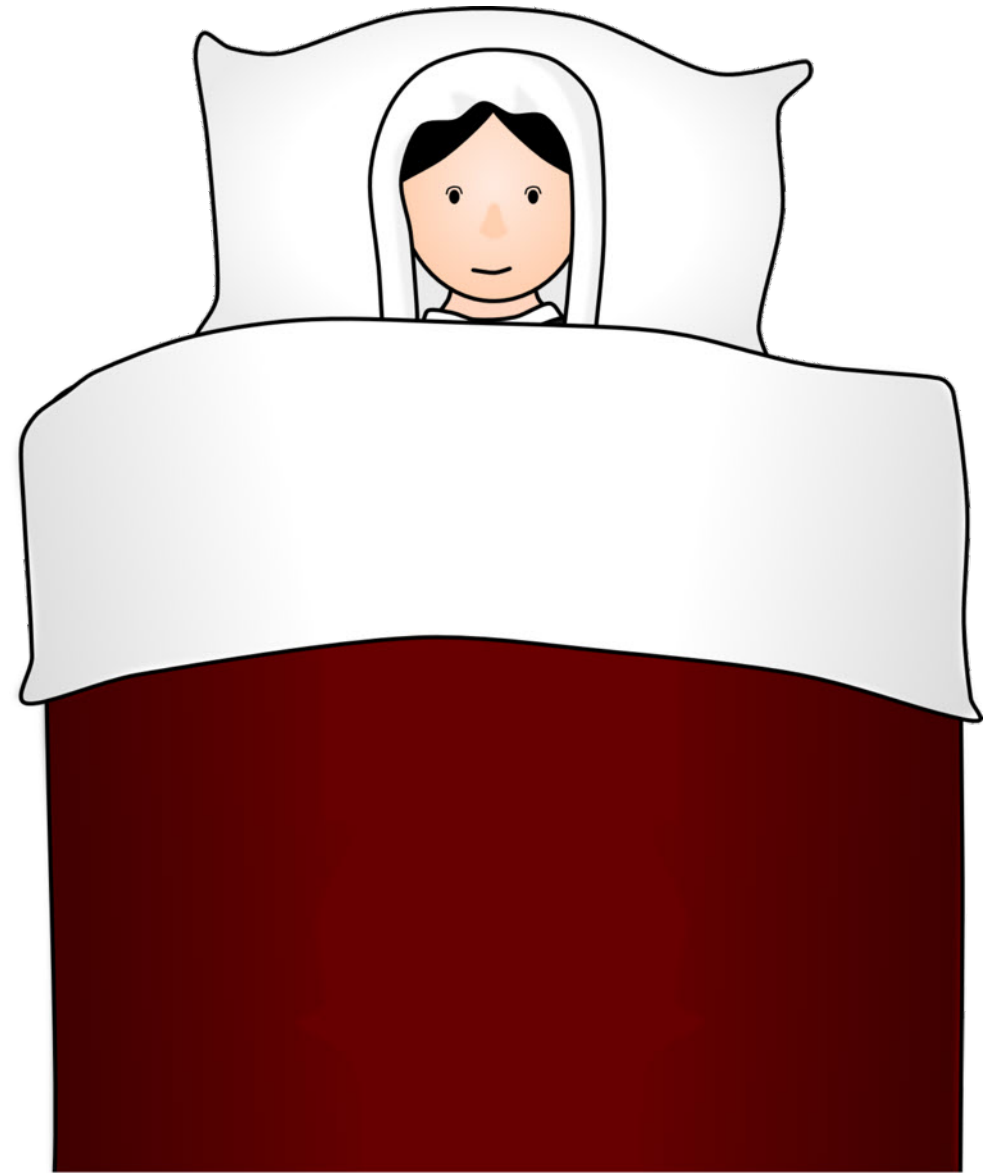
1883
