


Daniel








Governors





Darius became king of Babylon.




He appointed governors to rule over his kingdom, and put Daniel in charge.

The king was so impressed he decided to put Daniel in charge of the whole kingdom.




The governors were jealous and tried to find fault with Daniel.

So they came up with a devious plan.







We think you should make a decree saying that no-one should pray to any god or man except you, because you are the greatest!

It cannot be revoked.





Daniel was arrested.




Daniel was thrown into the lions den.
