


Christmas

At Easter, Christians remember Jesus' death and rising to life again.






Chinese New Year

The Chinese celebrate their New Year in January or February each year.









Independence Day

Celebrated on 4th July in the USA, it marks the day when America became independent from the Kingdom of Great Britain.






Hanukkah

Hanukkah is the Jewish festival that celebrates the rededicating of the Holy Temple in Jerusalem.



Celebrated in the USA, it was originally a festival to give thanks to God for a good harvest.






Guy Fawkes Night
