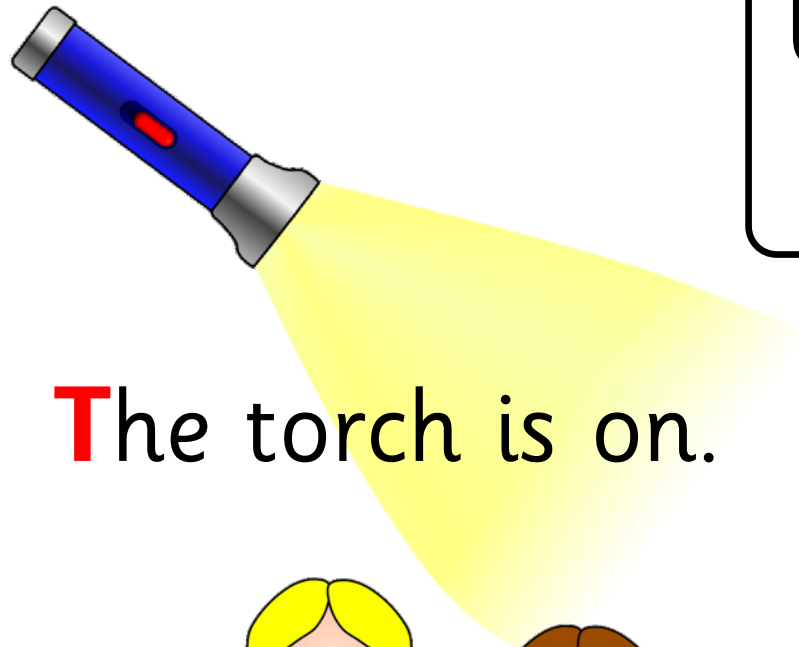

**beginning of a sentence.**

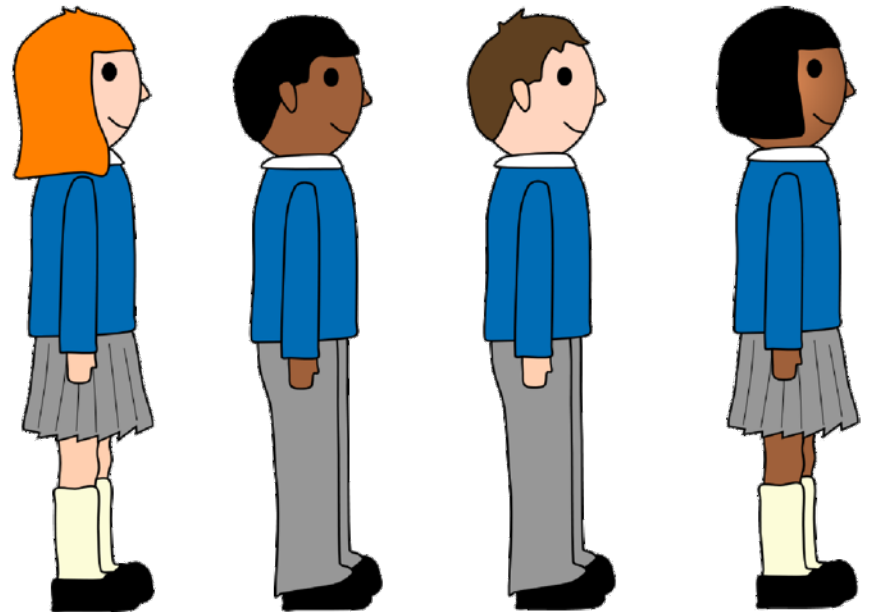


**T**he torch is on.



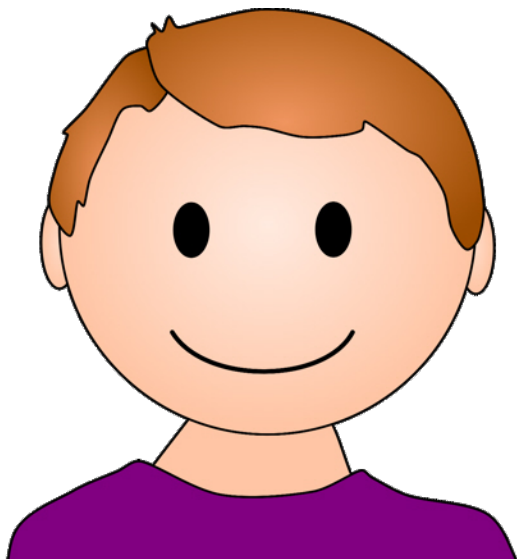
**T**hey are reading books.

**W**e line up sensibly.

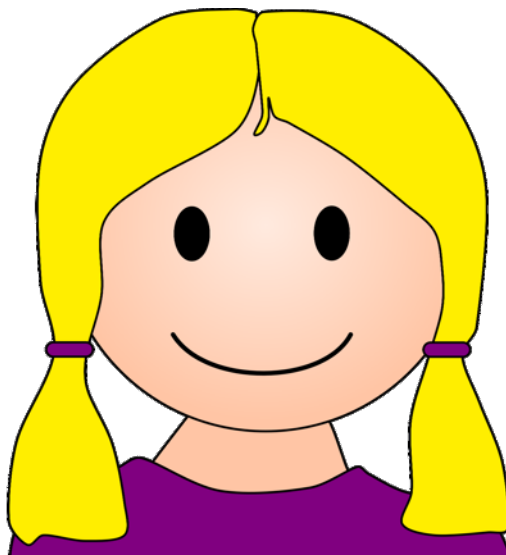

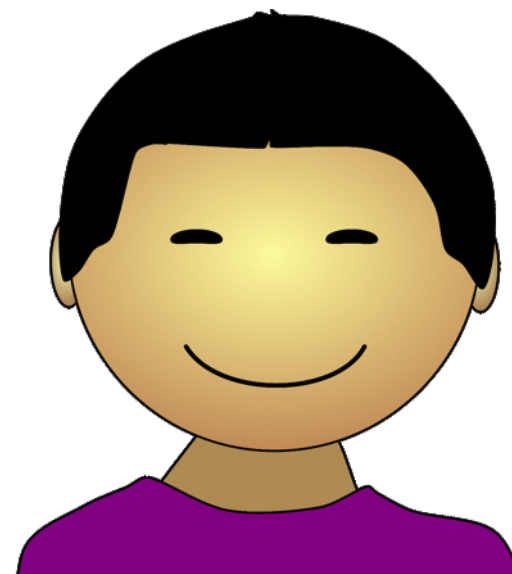
Use a capital letter at the

**C**hloe

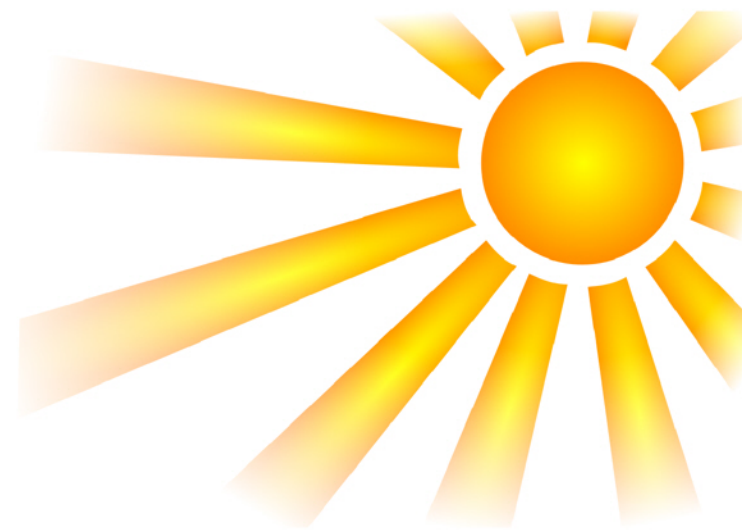


Here is **J**oshua.

The sunniest month was **A**ugust.

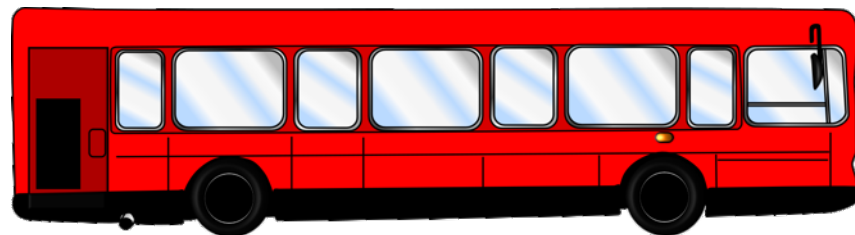
# Using Capital Letters
