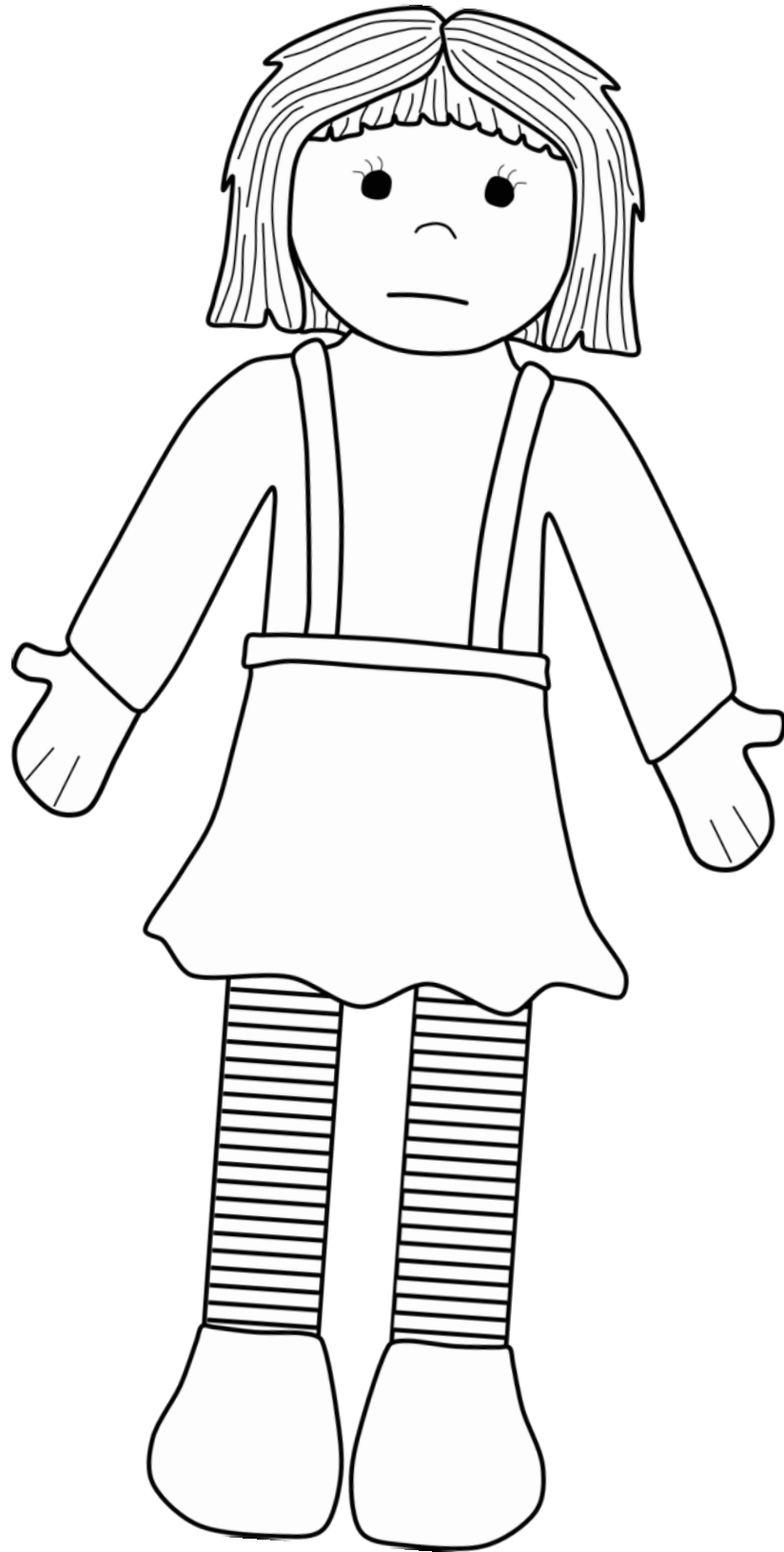




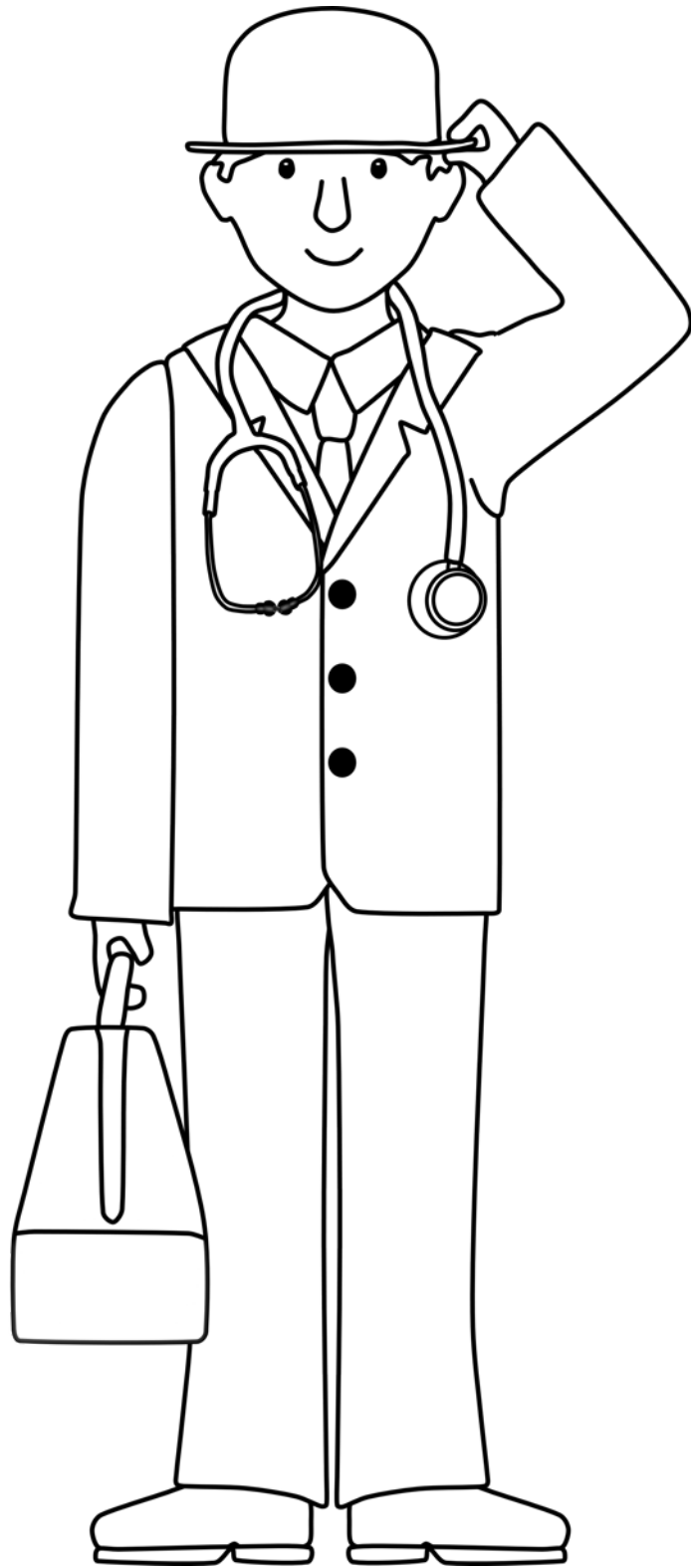
Miss Polly had a dolly...



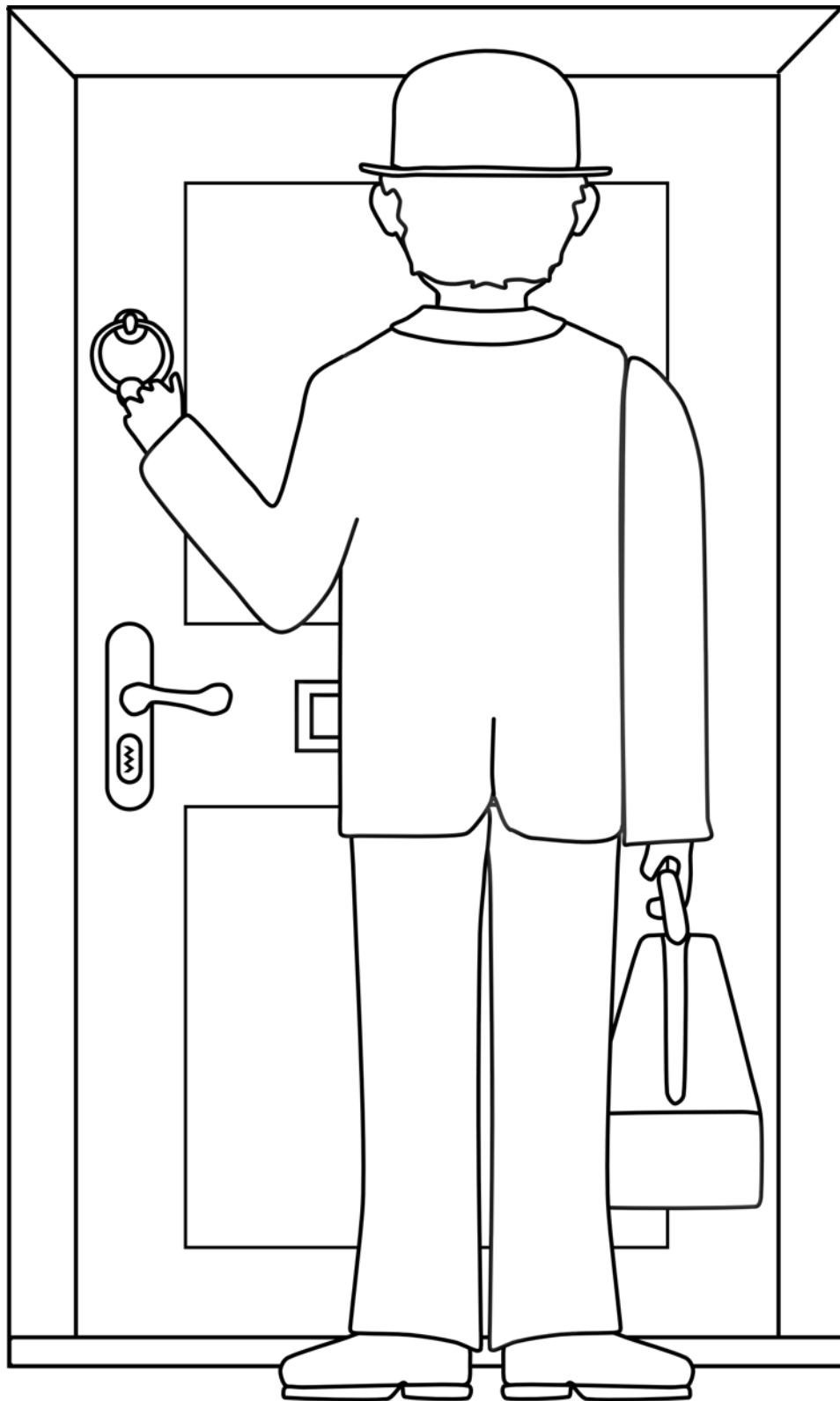

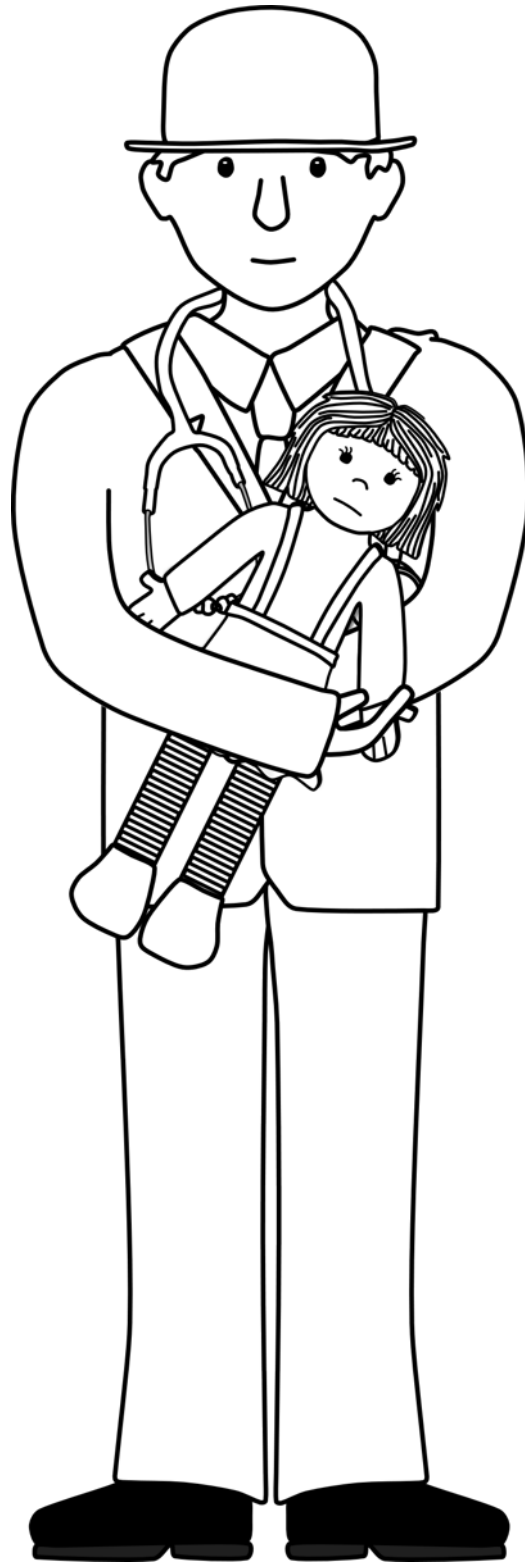
So she called for the doctor  
to be quick, quick quick.



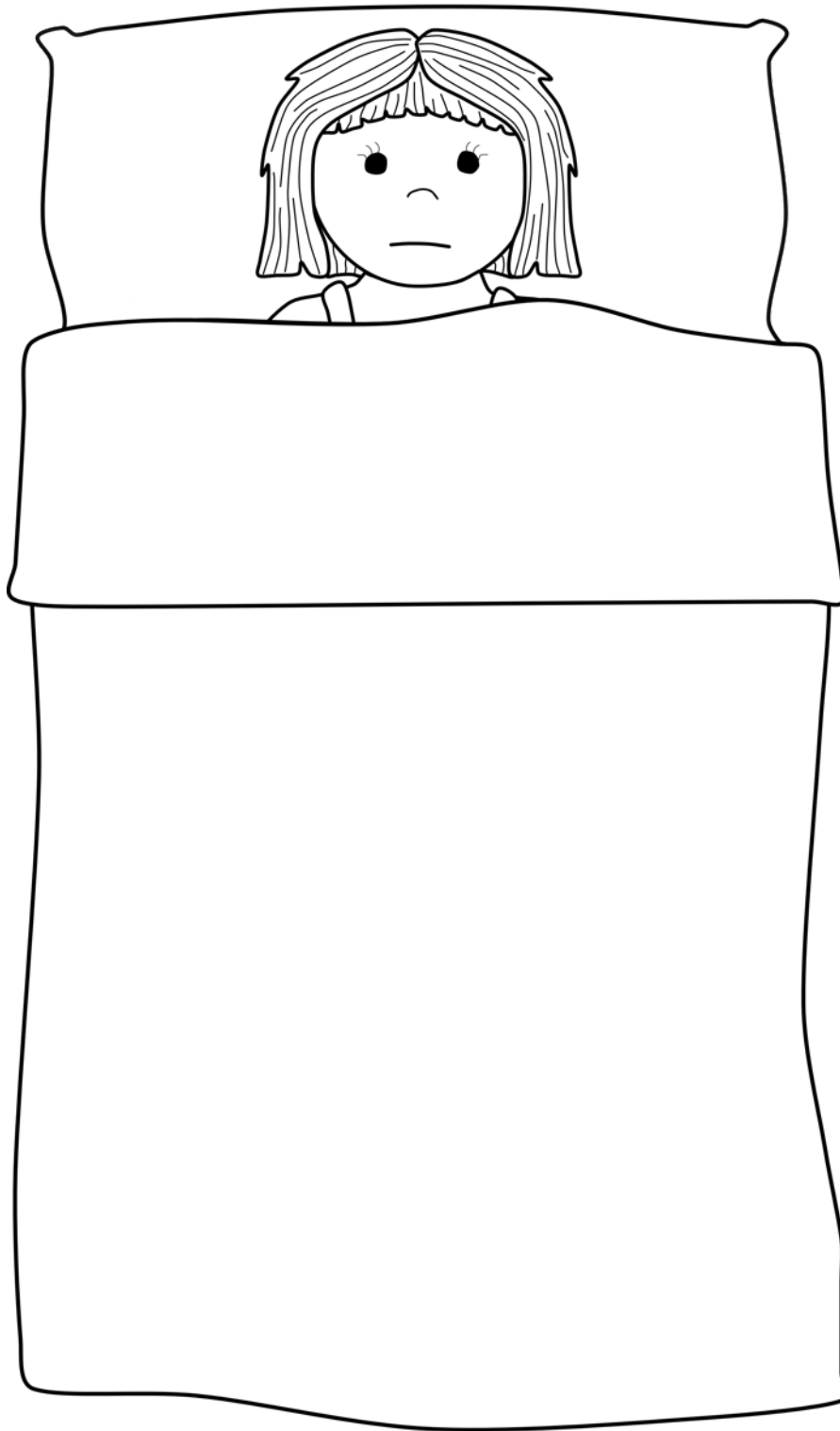
The doctor came with his

and he shook his head.

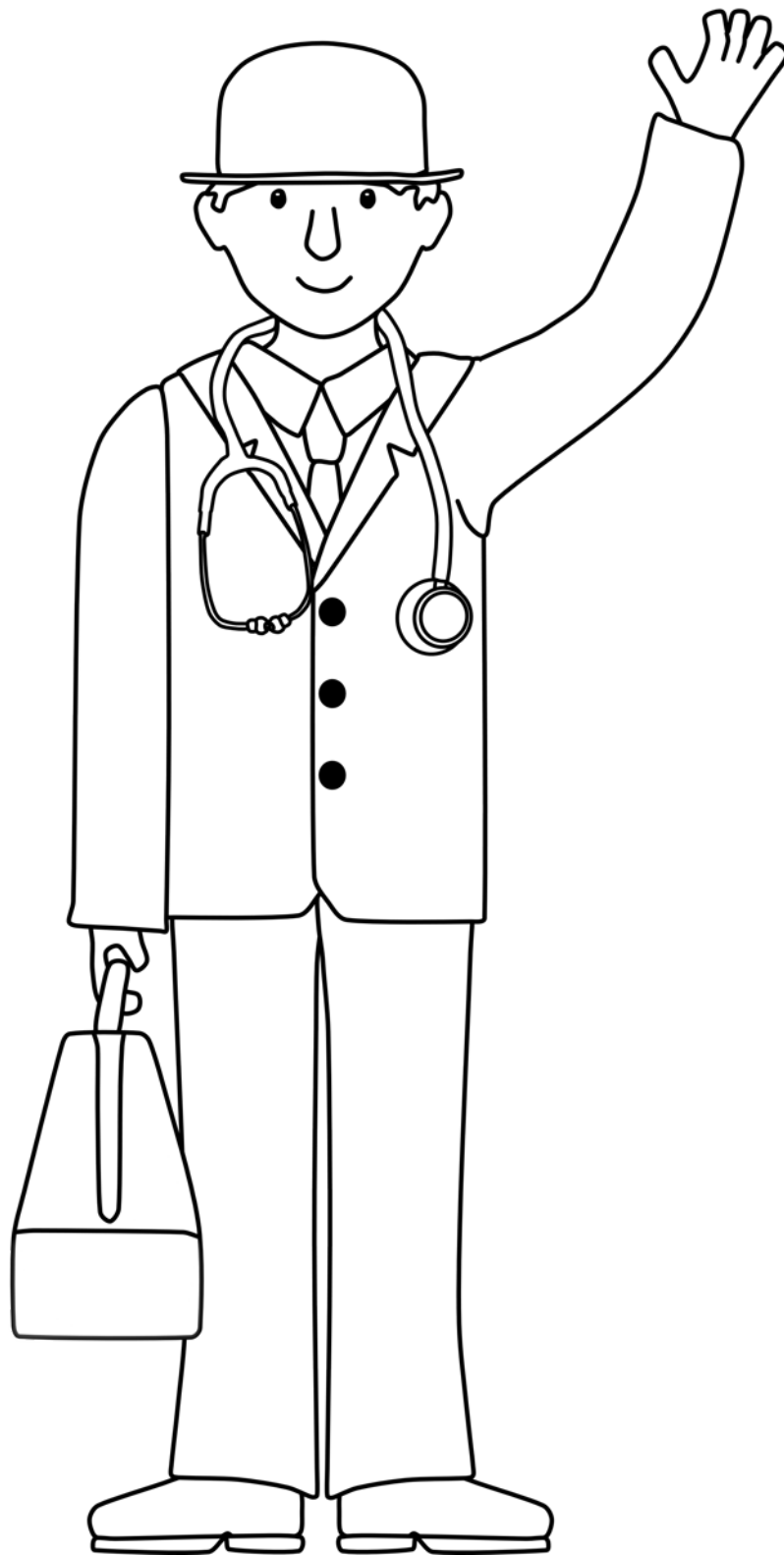


And he said, "Miss Polly,  
put her straight to bed."

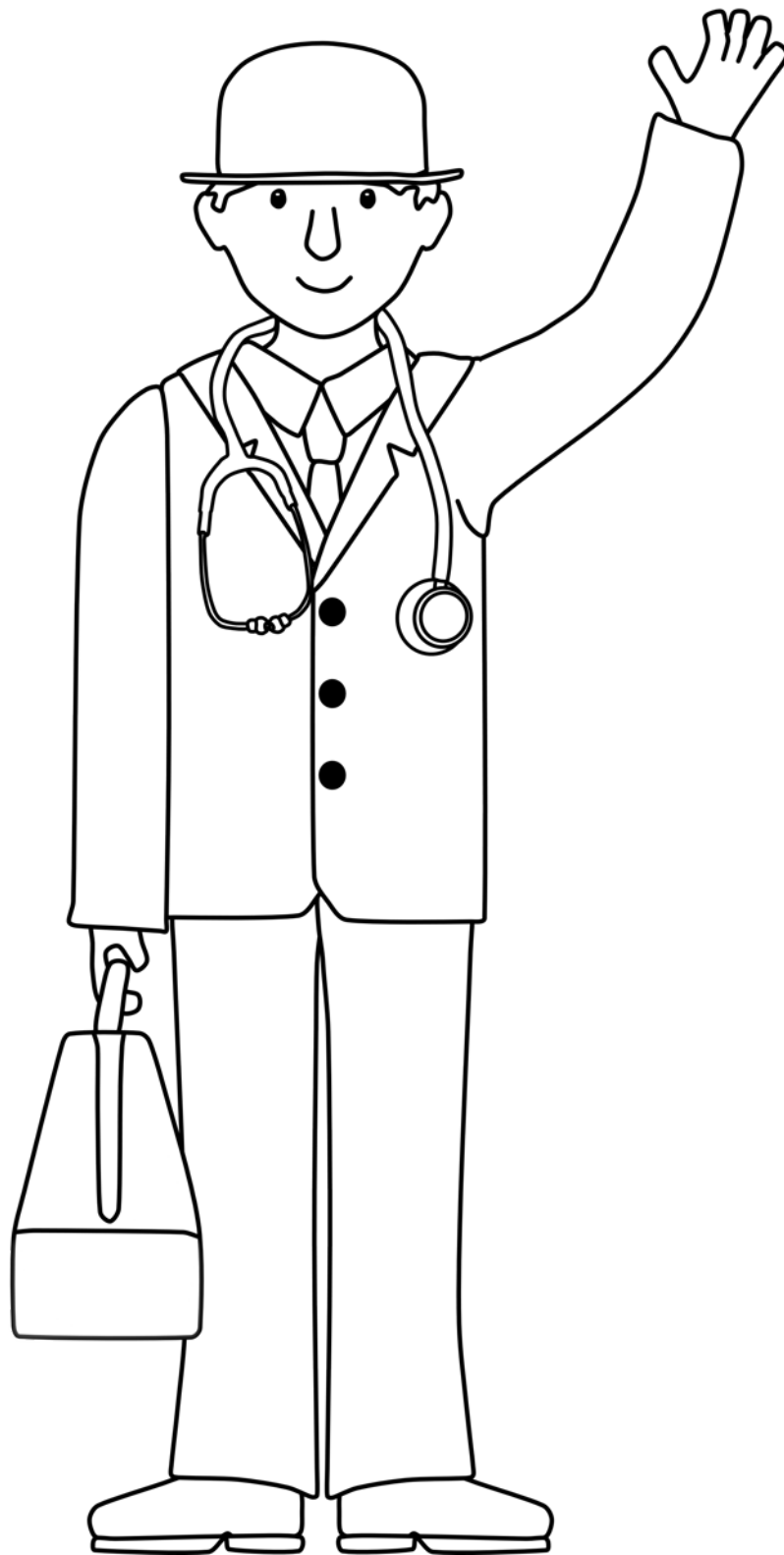

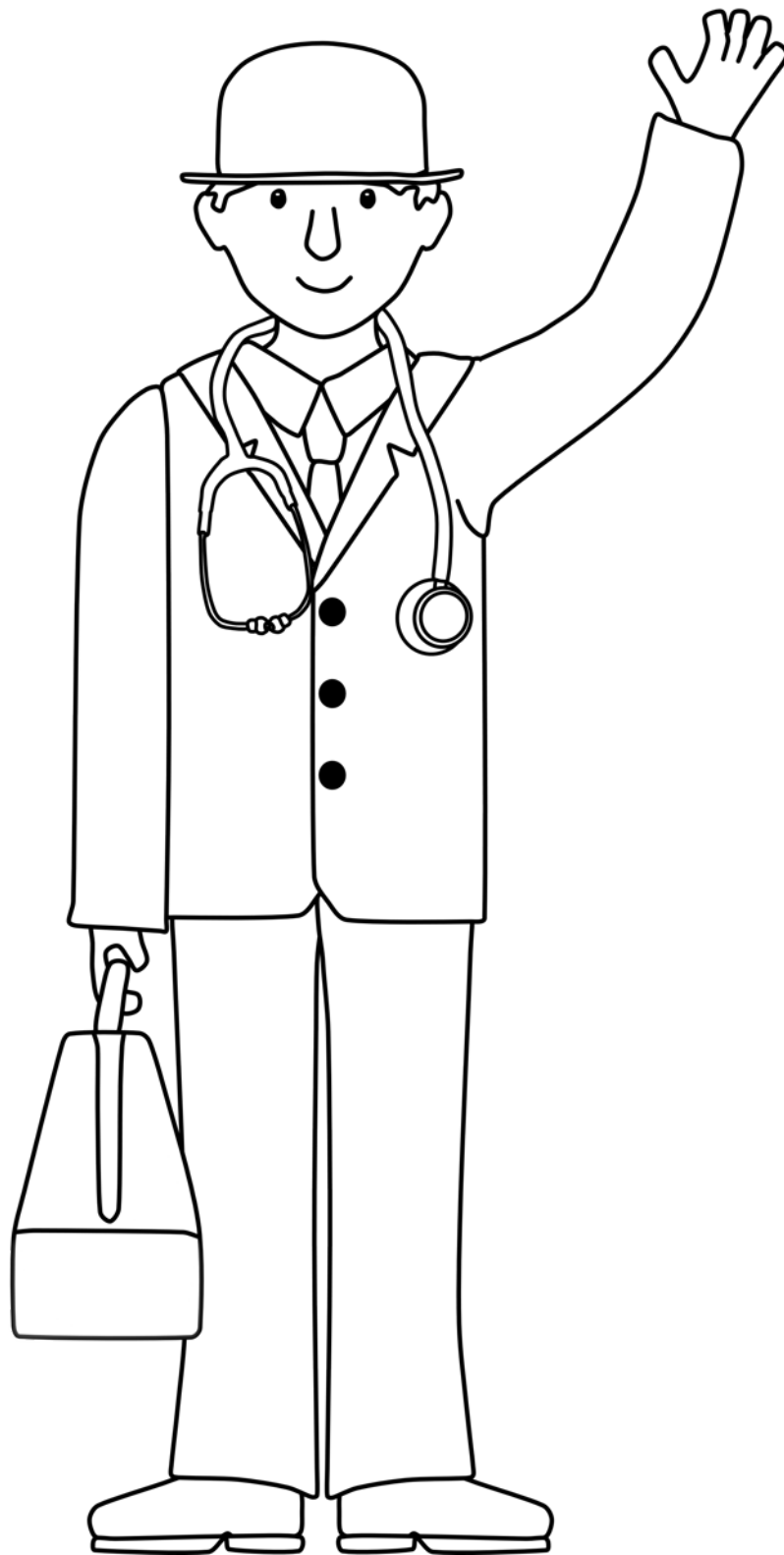
