









12 Now the Lord spoke to Moses and Aaron in the land of Egypt, saying, "This month shall be your beginning of months, it shall be the first month of the year to you. Speak to all the congregation of Israel, saying 'On the tenth of this month every man shall take for himself a lamb, according to the house of his father, a lamb for each household. And if the household is too small for the lamb, let him and his neighbour next to his house take it according to the number of persons, according to the number of persons you shall eat it. The lamb shall be without blemish, a year old, male, without any defect. And you shall keep it until the fourteenth day of the month, and on the fourteenth day at twilight you shall eat it. It shall be roasted with fire, with unleavened bread and with bitter herbs. They shall eat it in haste, as it was said, 'I will pass through the land of Egypt on that night, and I will strike all the firstborn in the land of Egypt, both man and beast. This day shall be for you a memorial day, and you shall keep it as a feast of unleavened bread. For seven days you shall eat unleavened bread, because from this time I will pass through the land of Egypt on that night. And you shall eat unleavened bread for seven days. On the first day you shall remove leaven from your house, and on the seventh day you shall remove leaven from your house. Bread of unleavened dough shall be eaten for the seven days; otherwise you shall be cut off and destroyed. On the first day there shall be a holy convocation, and on the seventh day there shall be a holy convocation. No work shall be done on these days, but you shall offer an offering of food to the Lord.
