<b>pre</b>	How do you say something is 'more heavy'?	<b>heavier</b>	A suffix that means 'not'.

<b>football</b> s	How do you say 'the most short'?	<b>shortest</b>	How do you say 'not agree'?
<b>dis</b> agree	How do you say 'order again'?	<b>re</b> order	A prefix that means 'after'.

## Prefix and suffix loop cards

post	A prefix that means 'half'.	semi	The opposite of 'believable'.
unbelievable	How do you say something is not understood?	misunderstood	To make something 'more straight'.

<p><b>straighten</b></p>	<p>A suffix that changes a word to the past tense.</p>	<p><b>ed</b></p>	<p>How do you say 'less small'?</p>
<p><b>smaller</b></p>	<p>Someone who offers help is...</p>	<p><b>helpful</b></p>	<p>How do you say 'too excited'?</p>
