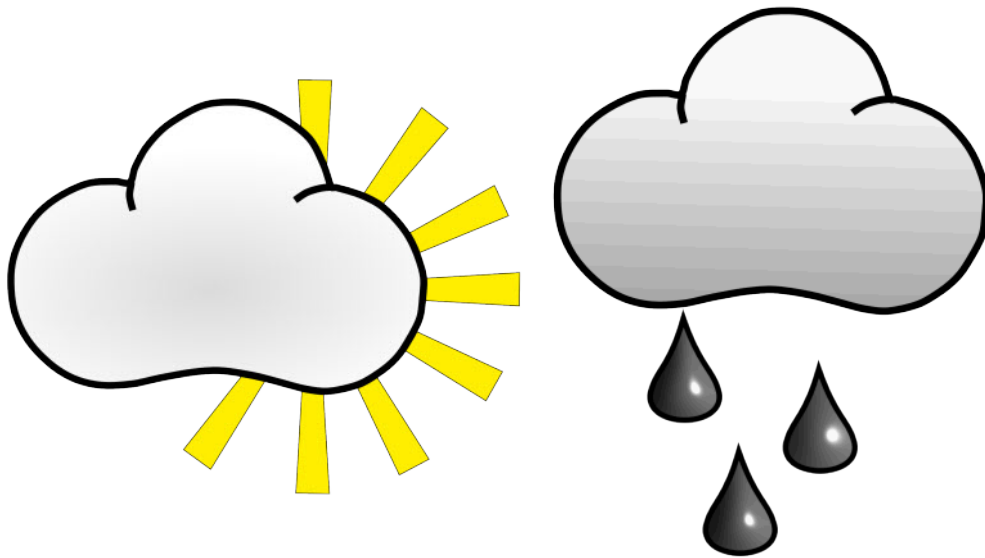


Amsterdam, Holland

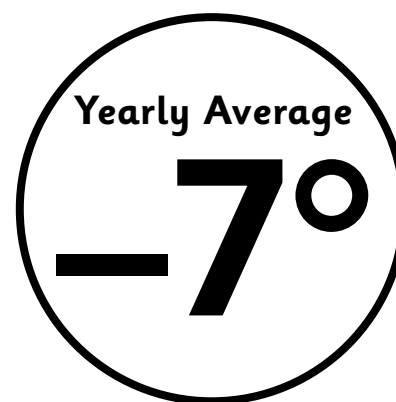
- Mostly low-lying land below sea level.
- Usually a mild and damp climate.
- Unsettled weather in Autumn and Spring.
- Rain is likely all year round.

Nuuk, Greenland

- Lies within the Arctic Circle.
- 84% of its area is covered with snow and ice.
- The northern coast is blocked by sea ice.
- Short cool summer, long severe winter.
- Temperature is rarely above freezing.



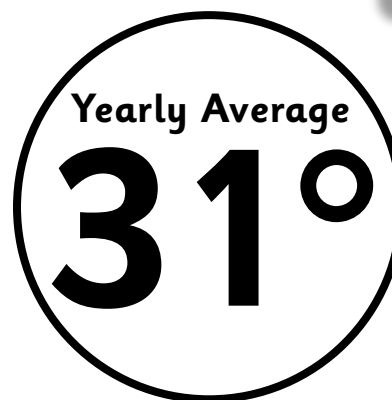
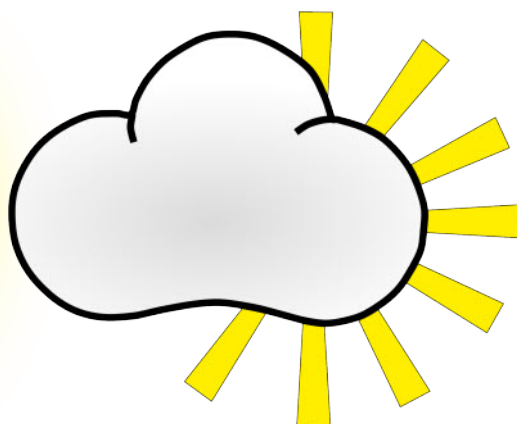
Cairo, Egypt

- Lies within the Sahara Desert.
- Always warm or hot during the day and cool at night.
- Very little rain.
- Strong winds sometimes cause sand storms.
- Morning mist can appear near the Nile river.



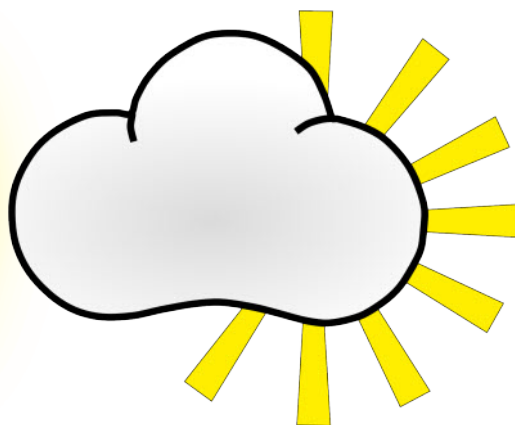
Kingston, Jamaica

- Jamaica is surrounded by the Caribbean Sea.
- Tropical climate - warm or hot all year round.
- Hurricane season is between June and November.
- Very close to the equator.
- Rainfall is rare.



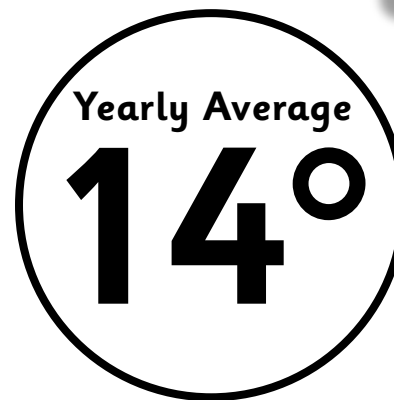
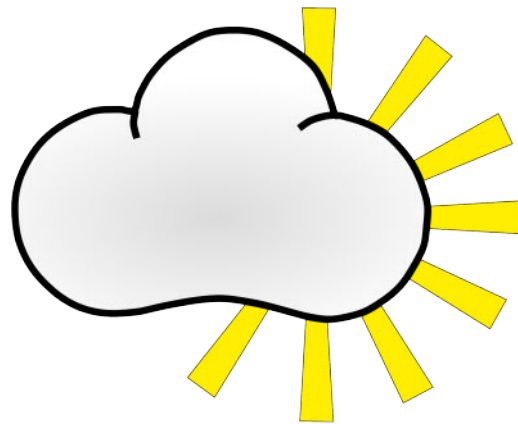
Malaga, Spain

- The coast is on the Mediterranean.
- High amounts of sunshine.
- Hot and humid summers.
- Rain is rare in the summer months.



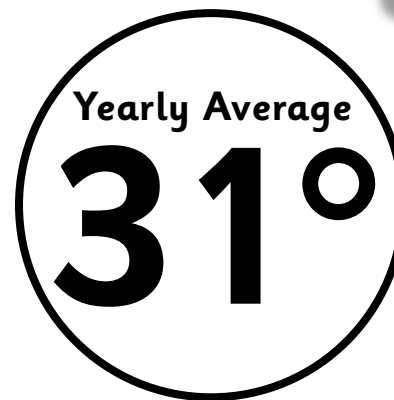
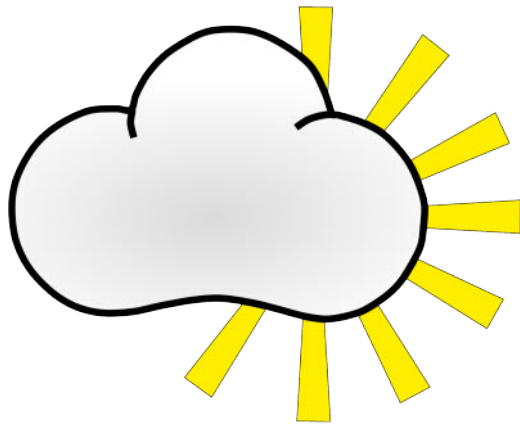
The Alps, Austria

- Winters are cold but can be sunny on the mountains. Valleys are often misty.
- Some valleys experience a warm dry wind for 20-40 days which melts the snow and can cause avalanches.
- Rain is rare in the summer months.



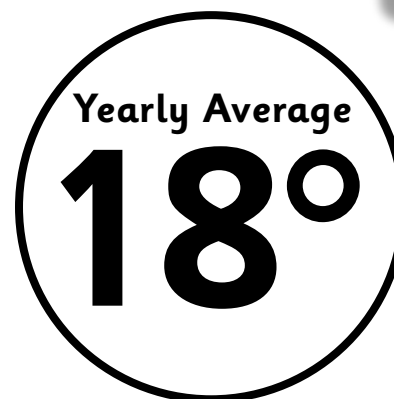
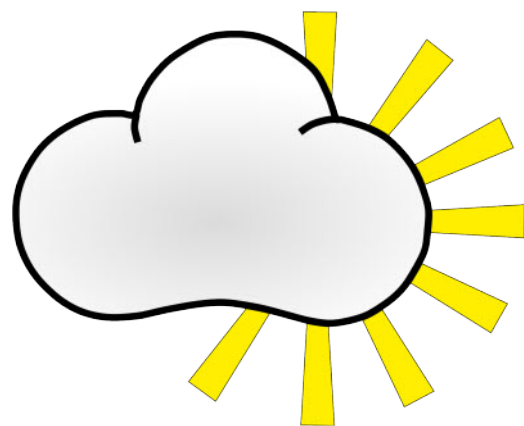
The Amazon Basin, Brazil

- The Amazon Basin has a large amount of yearly rainfall.
- Large rainforest area.
- Mainly tropical climate - warm or hot all year round.
- Fairly close to the equator.



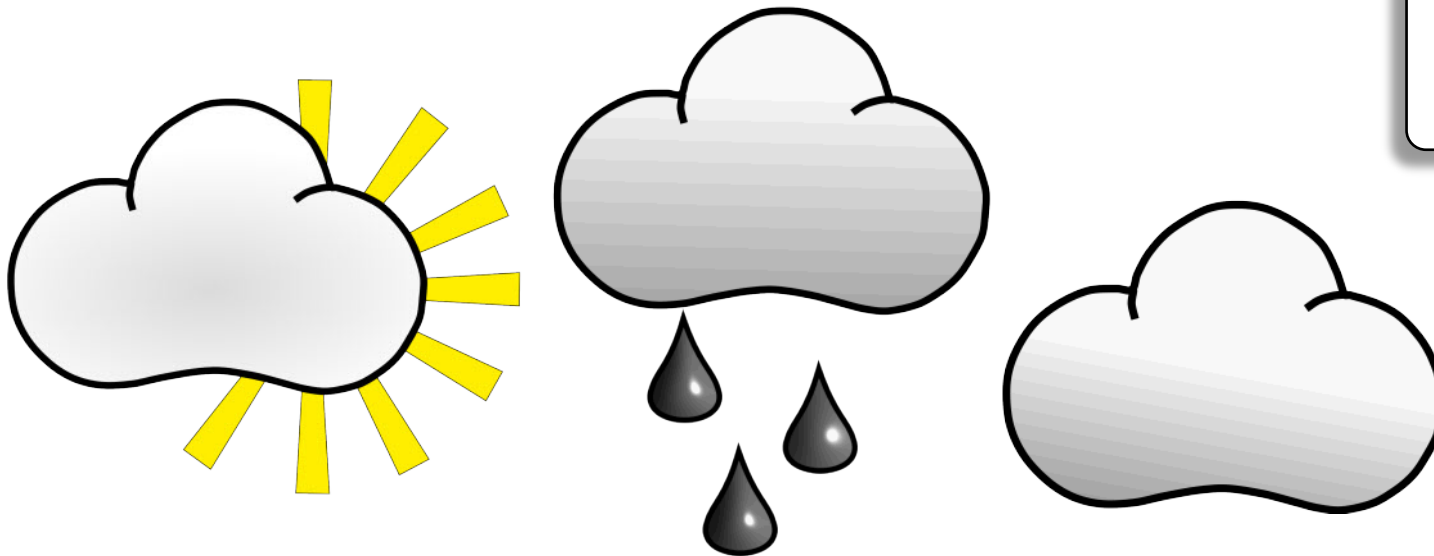
New York, USA

- 4 seasons: Spring, Summer, Autumn, Winter.
- Generally mild summers. Can get hot and muggy.
- Cold winters with snow. Sometimes severe and stormy.



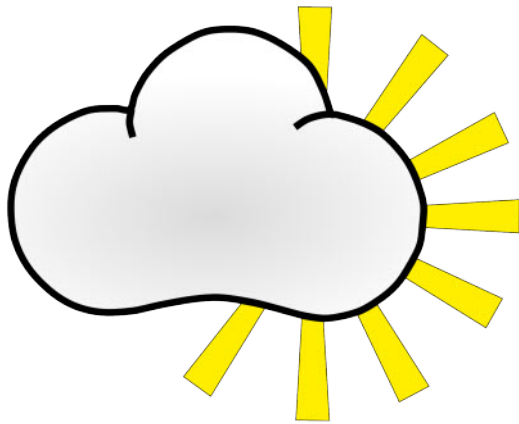
London, England

- Mostly cool to mild weather.
- 4 seasons: Spring, Summer, Autumn, Winter.
- Very changeable climate day to day.
- Frequent cloud and rain.
- Summer days are long.



Sydney, Australia

- Mostly warm or hot all year - mild winters.
- Changeable weather all year.
- Summers can have long heat waves and droughts.
- Can rain in all seasons, more in the summer.



Copenhagen, Denmark

- Mild climate through all the seasons.
- It can rain all year round.
- Grey, cloudy skies are frequent.
