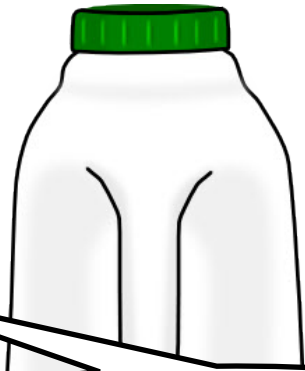

The sun gives us **much** light.

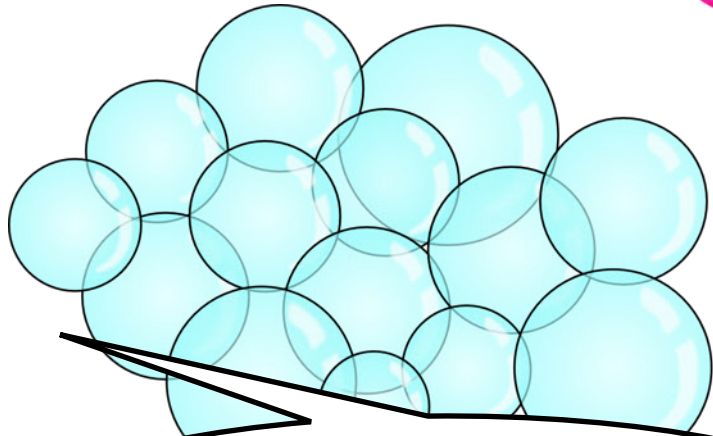


There isn't **much** on TV.

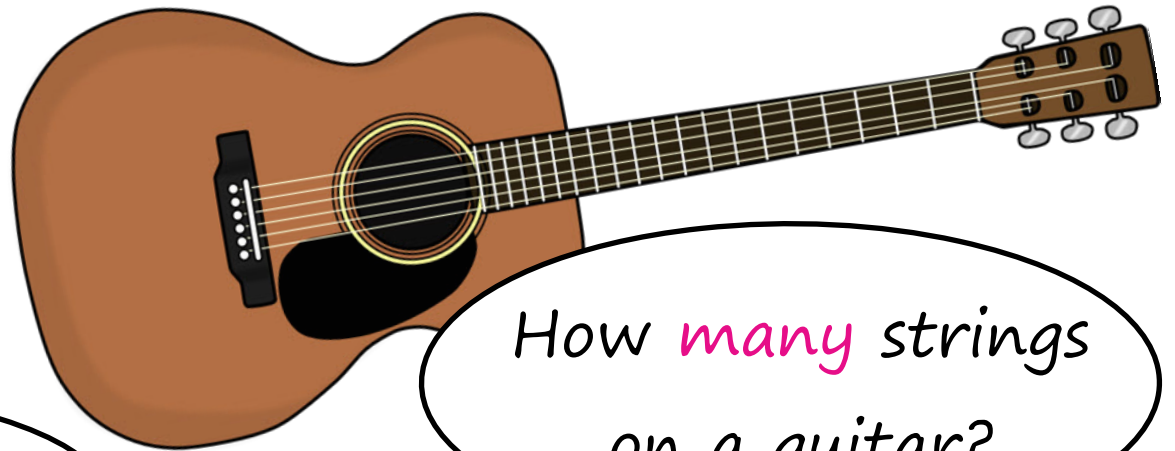


many

Used to describe an amount of something **countable**.

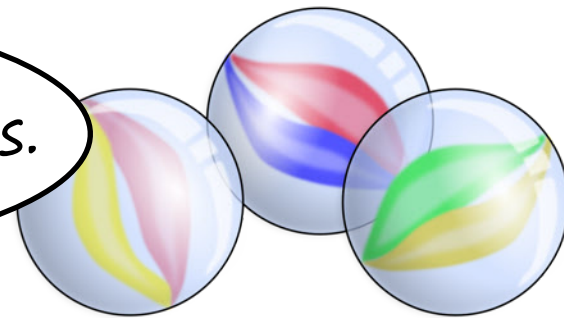


There are **many** bubbles.



How **many** strings on a guitar?

I don't have **many** marbles.




a lot

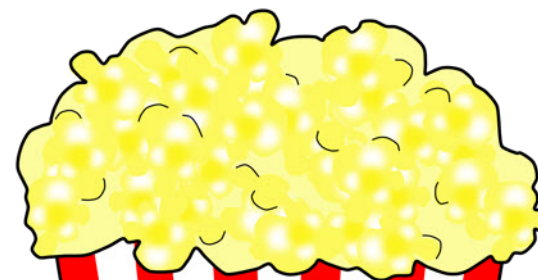
Used to describe the amount of *countable* and *uncountable* things.



The zebra has *a lot* of stripes.



There is *a lot* of grass to mow.



That's *a lot* of popcorn!

You can also use '*lots of*' to mean 'a lot'.

much, many, lots of



There is *much* rain and *many* raindrops.

There will be *a lot* of puddles!
