





## ANDREW PIEDILATO






Andrew Piedilato Submarine, 2024 Oil, alkyd, acrylic on canvas 95 3/4 x 94 in 243 x 239 cm











Andrew Piedilato Leopard, 2023 Oil, alkyd, acrylic on canvas 96 x 109 1/2 in 244 x 278 cm













Andrew Piedilato No Mast, 2023 Oil, alkyd, acrylic on canvas 84 x 74 in 213.4 x 188 cm





Andrew Piedilato Periscope, 2023 Oil, alkyd, acrylic on canvas 84 x 74 in 213.5 x 188 cm






