This week, we celebrate our parish feast day, and we look forward to our celebration on Monday evening in anticipation of the feast. As usual, we'll have our Solemn Mass and torchlit procession, and then head to Patrick Hall for our Irish tea and social! Father Hayes has been finding time between his travels for Lenten parish missions to make the torches, and our Pastoral Council has been preparing for the social. Music will be provided by The Kells (with our own Eddie Cotter and his friends). We'll also have a very special guest preacher for the Mass, Fr. Charles Marie Rooney, O.P., who will be visiting us from St. Dominic's in Youngstown. Father Charles Marie serves as parochial vicar alongside our well-remembered Fr. Frassati Davis, O.P., who is now the pastor there. However, Fr. Charles Marie is also novitiate classmates with Fr. Cornelius and me. He has fond memories when our class visited for the St. Patrick Vigil in 2018 (especially the singing of "St. Patrick's Breastplate" for the entrance hymn). Father Charles Marie is a gifted preacher, and his last name is not the only thing Irish about him! During his college studies at Duke University, he was able to spend a semester abroad on the Emerald Isle, studying at St. Patrick's Pontifical University in Maynooth. He will have many great insights to share with us about the Apostle of Ireland on his feast day!

As we celebrate our parish feast day, I also want to take another opportunity to reach out to our parish community on behalf of *The Appeal* 2025. We surpassed our parish goal at the beginning of the new year, which goes to benefit various ministries throughout the Diocese of Columbus. Since then, every dollar we now raise for *The Appeal* comes back to the parish as a rebate (without being charged the diocesan assessment, which is similar to a tax). We will use our rebate for 2025 toward the cost of upgrading our church lighting to LED lights (which is needed, as the current bulbs in the church are no longer manufactured, though LED lighting will better illuminate the artwork in our church). We still have a few more weeks until the launch of *The Appeal* for 2026, so it's not too late to give toward the 2025 campaign, which is really giving to the church lighting project.

When we started *The Appeal* for 2025, our parish goal from the Diocese was set at \$171,619.43. Knowing that our parishioners are generous, I set our own "enhanced goal" of \$271,619.43, with the intention of \$100,000 coming back to the parish as a rebate for the lighting. As of this writing, we are nearly \$30,000 away from that enhanced goal. We have until March 30th (for credit card donations) and April 30th (for cash donations) to give toward the 2025 campaign. Now I want to run with this "30"

theme! The generous giving to *The Appeal* has come from around 25% of parishioners. Imagine where we could be if we had 100% participation? I know that this isn't realistic, as not all families and parishioners can give. However, what if we bump that 25% parishioner participation to 30% participation? This is my "30-30-30" challenge for St. Patrick Parish as *The Appeal* 2025 wraps up: \$30,000.00, at 30% parishioner participation, by March 30th (credit cards) or April 30th (cash). Can we do it? I believe that we can! As we celebrate our parish feast day this week, I invite you to consider making a donation toward *The Appeal* to benefit our church lighting project, our church under the patronage of glorious St. Patrick.



Stay afterward for our traditional Irish Party and Ceili, featuring traditional Irish music by **The Kells!** *Irish dancers in the parish are invited to perform at the celebration in costume.*

All parishioners, family, and friends are invited to our celebration in honor of St. Patrick to ask the intercession of our heavenly patron for blessings on our parish and the blessing of peace in Ireland and throughout the world.

Plenary Indulgence: One can obtain a plenary indulgence by a visit to a parish church on the feast of its patron. The conditions for receiving the indulgence are that during the visit, one must offer prayers for the pope (the Creed and the Our Father) and within 20 days make a Sacramental Confession and receive Holy Communion.



What is Fasting and Abstinence?

Fasting is the limitation of food, allowing a person to eat one full meal and two smaller meals, with no solid food in between. The two smaller meals combined should not exceed the amount of the full meal. All Catholics ages 18-59 are obliged to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.

Abstinence prohibits the eating of meat (beast or fowl), though eggs, milk, and cheese are permitted. All Catholics from age 14 onward are obliged to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, all the Fridays of Lent, and Good Friday.

Easter Duty Obligation

Each of the faithful, after having received their first Holy Communion, is obliged to receive Holy Communion during the Easter season (Canon 920). This is traditionally linked to the requirement to confess grave sins at least once a year (Canon 989).

St. Patrick Stations of the Cross

St. Patrick's offers Stations of the Cross on Fridays of Lent at 7:00 p.m., immediately following the Knights of Columbus Fish Fries.

Eucharistic Adoration

St. Patrick's offers Eucharistic Adoration every Tuesday from 12:15-8:00 p.m., a holy hour on Fridays from 12:15-1:15 p.m., and all-night adoration on the third and fourth Fridays of the month. Please see the Holy Week Schedule for adoration times during Holy Week.

Confessions

In addition to regular confession times, each Wednesday evening of Lent St. Patrick's will offer confessions in the Gallery Confessional:

- March 18 and 25 - 7:00 p.m.
- April 1 - 7:30 p.m. (after Solemn Vespers)

Please see the Holy Week Schedule for additional confession times during Holy Week.

There will be no confessions on Palm Sunday, Holy Saturday, or Easter Sunday.






