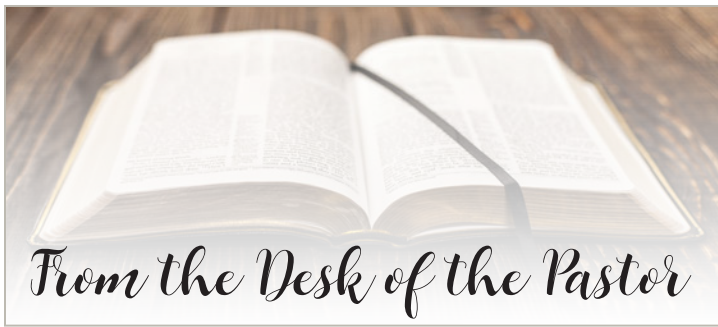

Christ is Risen! Alleluia! We give thanks to God for the graces of this Easter Sunday, and the blessings of this past Holy Week. Notably, we welcome our newly baptized into the Catholic Church: 10 adults, as well as three children of those who entered the Church at the Easter Vigil. Another 17 people, who had been baptized in other Christian denominations, were received into the Catholic Church, and another Catholic completed her initiation with Confirmation and First Holy Communion. All of the newly baptized and those received into the Catholic Church received the Sacrament of Confirmation and their First Holy Communion. I am sincerely grateful to Fr. Cornelius Avaritt, to the O.C.I.A. team, and to the sponsors for their work and support in this very successful year of O.C.I.A. We've heard reports of many people entering the Catholic Church this year, and St. Patrick's was no exception. Welcome to the Catholic Church!

The beauty of our Holy Week liturgies (and all liturgies here, for that matter) are due to the glorious music provided by our parish choir. Thank you so much to Kathleen Tully, our director of music, and our choir, for uplifting us with beautiful music all throughout Holy Week. Between Palm Sunday, Solemn Vespers, the Mass of the Lord's Supper, the Good Friday Liturgy, Tenebrae, the Easter Vigil, and our Easter Sunday Masses, many members of the choir were here for eight days straight, not to mention the hours of practice spent during the weeks of Lent. Well done, Kathleen and members of the choir. We are truly grateful!

It was a true joy to welcome Fr. Michael O'Connor, a dear Dominican brother and friend, to preach the Seven Last Words of Christ on Good Friday. It was also a treat for him to share his musical talents, notably with the singing of the Passion on Good Friday and the *Exsultet* at the Easter Vigil. Hopefully he will be back soon to visit us! Our own Fr. Michael Donahue also helped with chant and music for the Triduum, notably for the mornings when the friars prayed Morning Prayer with the people in the church. It was a Triduum with two very musical Fr. Michaels!

I also owe a debt of gratitude to Sr. Marta and the Madonna Garden Club for making our church look so beautiful with our Easter flowers and decorations. Special thanks also goes out to the Daughters of Veronica, our sacristy group of young girls and their mothers, who came in to veil all the statues before Passiontide, and then came back to unveil them after Good Friday. Our altar boys put in several hours of rehearsal for the Triduum liturgies, and as usual, they were flawless in their serving. Thank you, boys! A special word of thanks goes to Hans Zehnder, a seminarian from our parish, who came back to serve as master of ceremonies

for the Triduum. Thank you as well to our lectors and ushers, especially to the ushers who helped with our long confession lines throughout Holy Week, notably on Good Friday.

I also want to thank Matt Jivanjee and his team of dedicated workers who set up (and tore down) for the different events of Holy Week, often with a quick turnaround. Thanks as well to our parish office staff who handled many preparations leading up to Easter, from placing orders, to printing cards, to preparing materials for the Easter Novena of Masses. I am grateful to have a dedicated team, especially as we celebrate one year with our re-structured office staff. Thank you to Patti Phillips, Ana Maria Bott, Sheila Tuttle, and Keelin Johnson for their work in the office, to Frank Hartge, our business manager, and to Leslie Sparks, the financial secretary for the Dominican Friars.

A word of thanks also goes out to our sacristans, Nancy Letzelter and Phoebe Spinrad, for their work throughout the Triduum. And I can't forget our security team! Bobby Russell, Jason Bowen, and David Hall put in extra hours, often late, during the Triduum. They keep us safe, and we should all be grateful for their dedication and service.

As Lent draws to a close, I commend the Knights of Columbus for a very successful run of Lenten fish fries. On several Fridays, they sold out completely. However, these fish fries are possible because of the volunteer hours the Knights put into them. Did you enjoy the fish fries? Are you a Catholic man over 18? Join the Knights, and be a part of a dedicated team of brothers and parish volunteers. You can be serving fish to our many visitors next Lent!

Thank you, as well, to the Service Committee of our Pastoral Council, for leading our Lenten church cleaning. They were able to recruit several volunteers, who came out on the day before Palm Sunday to make the church bright and clean for Holy Week. A special word of gratitude to all the parishioners who volunteered.

May the blessings of this Easter day, this Easter Octave, and this Easter season continue to radiate in your lives. Sing with joy our Easter song: "Alleluia!"

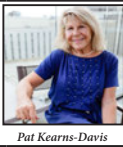
