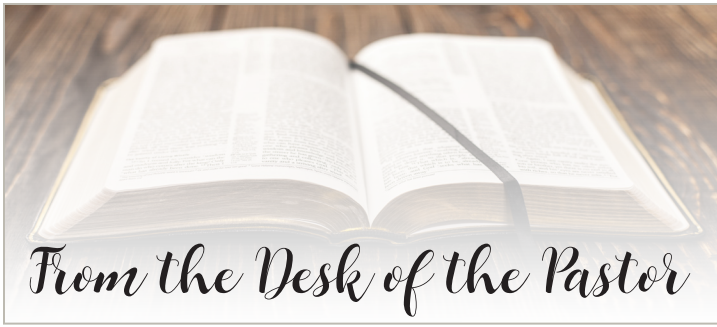

From the Desk of the Pastor

I hope that you and your families had a wonderful celebration of Easter! We were truly blessed here at St. Patrick's with the Baptism of ten adults and three children at the Easter Vigil, and the Confirmation of 28 adults. It was truly an amazing outpouring of grace on our parish! We also saw over 2,500 people come through our doors for our Easter Masses, with many visitors attending. People are finding St. Patrick's, so hopefully, our parish registrations will increase, and our OCIA numbers will be even greater next year!

After the busy events of Holy Week and Easter, I'll be taking the next week off for some rest and renewal in Texas. I'll be leaving on Monday for a priests' conference in Austin, sponsored by the St. Paul Center for Biblical Studies. I attended this conference last year, and it is a great opportunity for priests to gather and take a deeper exploration of the Scriptures. The conference is led by renowned biblical scholars Scott Hahn and John Bergsma, who both teach at Franciscan University. Following the three-day conference, I'll head to San Antonio to visit my father for a few days. Hopefully, after returning from the warm weather of Texas, the temperatures in Ohio will stay consistently warm (no more of this "back-and-forth" that we were having in the days before and after Easter!).

This weekend, we celebrate the great Feast of Divine Mercy. Established by St. John Paul II in the Jubilee Year of 2000 (following upon Jesus' request in His appearances to St. Faustina), Divine Mercy Sunday allows us to look at the penances of Lent and the mysteries of Holy Week and Easter in a fuller context. Jesus suffers and goes to the Cross for us, and rises in glory, in order to pour out His mercy and grace upon His Church. The red and white rays that come from His heart, signifying blood and water, point to the Eucharist and Baptism, the Easter sacraments which give us new life and revive us. The hand of Jesus is raised in absolution, which He offers in Confession. I have heard it said that "every day is Divine Mercy at St. Patrick's" because of the many Confessions we hear at the parish. The friars certainly take this to heart, and we are blessed to minister as vessels of the Lord's mercy when we hear Confessions. Whether today or another day, remember that the doors of mercy are open for you in the Sacrament of Penance!

This year, we are blessed with a rare opportunity: the celebration of the Feast of St. Margaret of Castello on her actual feast day, April 13th. This is rare since April 13th usually falls during Holy Week or the Easter Octave, and her feast day has to be transferred to another day (since these two weeks take

precedence on the liturgical calendar). However, for this year and next year, Easter is early enough that her feast will fall on its proper day. If you're able to make it to either of our weekday Masses on Monday, I encourage you to come and celebrate "Little Margaret."

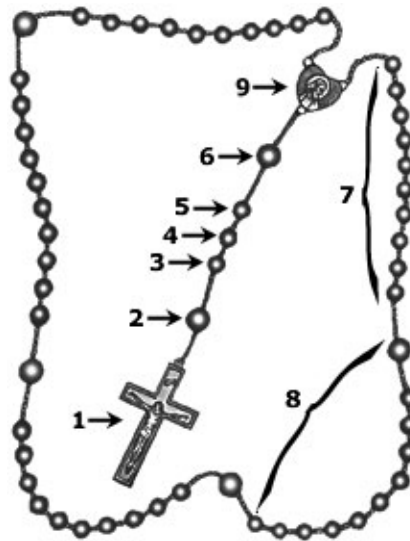

HOW TO RECITE THE CHAPLET

The Chaplet of Divine Mercy is recited using ordinary Rosary beads of five decades. The Chaplet is preceded by two opening prayers from the *Diary of Saint Maria Faustina Kowalska* and followed by a closing prayer.



1. Make the Sign of the Cross

2. Optional Opening Prayers

St. Faustina's Prayer for Sinners: *O Jesus, eternal Truth, our Life, I call upon You and I beg Your mercy for poor sinners. O sweetest Heart of my Lord, full of pity and unfathomable mercy, I plead with You for poor sinners. O Most Sacred Heart, Fount of Mercy from which gush forth rays of inconceivable graces upon the entire human race, I beg of You light for poor sinners. O Jesus, be mindful of Your own bitter Passion and do not permit the loss of souls redeemed at so dear a price of Your most precious Blood. O Jesus, when I consider the great price of Your Blood, I rejoice at its immensity, for one drop alone would have been enough for the salvation of all sinners. Although sin is an abyss of wickedness and ingratitude, the price paid for us can never be equaled. Therefore, let every soul trust in the Passion of the Lord, and place its hope in His mercy. God will not deny His mercy to anyone. Heaven and earth may change, but God's mercy will never be exhausted. Oh, what immense joy burns in my heart when I contemplate Your incomprehensible goodness, O Jesus! I desire to bring all sinners to Your feet that they may glorify Your mercy throughout endless ages (Diary of Saint Maria Faustina Kowalska, 72). You expired, Jesus, but the source of life gushed forth for souls, and the ocean of mercy opened up for the whole world. O Fount of Life, unfathomable Divine Mercy, envelop the whole world and empty Yourself out upon us.*

(Repeat three times)

O Blood and Water, which gushed forth from the Heart of Jesus as a fount of mercy for us, I trust in You!

3. Our Father

4. Hail Mary

5. The Apostles' Creed:

I believe in God, the Father almighty, Creator of heaven and earth, and in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died and was buried; He descended into hell; on the third day He rose again from the dead; He ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of God the Father almighty; from there He will come to judge the living and the dead. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting. Amen.

6. The Eternal Father:

Eternal Father, I offer you the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your Dearly Beloved Son, Our Lord, Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world.

7. On the 10 Small Beads of Each Decade:

For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

8. Repeat for the remaining decades:

Saying the "Eternal Father" (6) on the "Our Father" bead and then 10 "For the sake of His sorrowful Passion" (7) on the following "Hail Mary" beads.

9. Conclude with Holy God (Repeat three times):

Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world.
