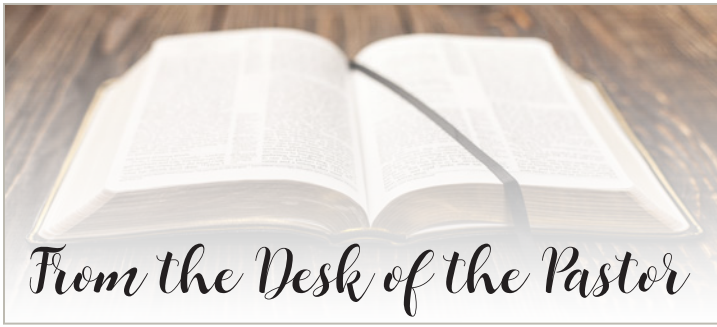

## From the Desk of the Pastor

Today, we celebrate Good Shepherd Sunday, as the readings for the Fourth Sunday of Easter always draw upon the theme of Jesus as the Good Shepherd. Today is a day to pray for your shepherds – Pope Leo, Bishop Fernandes, and all of us priests here at St. Patrick's. I'm coming up on four years since my priesthood ordination, and each day is a new gift of ministering to you, the people of God! I may have had a long journey to the priesthood, but now having been a priest for four years, I can say with all sincerity and love – I wouldn't want to be anything else but a priest!

Good Shepherd Sunday is also a day to pray for an increase in vocations to the priesthood and the religious life. We have been blessed with several parishioners ordained to the diocesan priesthood over the last several years. Two parishioners, Deacon Shane Gerrity and Hans Zehnder, are currently in the seminary (and Deacon Gerrity is scheduled to be ordained to the priesthood, God-willing, in 2027). A number of young women from our parish have answered the call to religious life. Vocations have come out of St. Patrick's, and I know that there are more to come!

Since coming to St. Patrick's, it's been a personal mission of mine to encourage vocations. As Director of the Altar Boy Program over the last five years, I see how the Lord is working in our young men, and how several of these boys have started to think about the priesthood because they have served at the altar. For the last three years, our parish has had a Melchizedek Project group, which meets monthly for prayer, fellowship, and a book discussion on the priesthood.

Lately, the Lord has been instilling something on my heart – that a great abundance of vocations awaits, coming from the families of St. Patrick's! I may never realize the end result of this during my time as pastor, but it's for the Lord to carry out in His time. However, families can encourage their sons to consider the priesthood, and their daughters to consider the consecrated life, even at a young age. We are always happy when the Lord calls men to serve as priests for the Diocese of Columbus – but I hope we'll also get plenty of Dominican vocations from our Dominican parish! With all of this in mind, I want to invite our parishioners to start encouraging and praying for vocations in a very tangible way, starting next weekend.

You may have noticed that we got a new altar crucifix at Easter. It's a little bigger, and matches the new altar candlesticks that we started to use last Easter. So, I've been thinking about what we should do with the older altar crucifix. And that's when I got

an idea – the Vocations Crucifix! I've seen this at other parishes, but the idea is quite simple: a crucifix is taken home each week by a different family or parishioner, along with a prayer for vocations, and the family or parishioner commits to praying that prayer for vocations before the Vocations Crucifix every day of that week. The presence of the crucifix in the home, usually in a prominent place, serves as a reminder to pray for vocations, while also standing as a sign of encouragement for young children in the home. The family will pick up the Vocations Crucifix when they come to St. Patrick's for weekend Mass and bring it back the following weekend. They can either leave the Vocations Crucifix at the parish office for the next family or parishioner to pick up, or exchange it when they see them at Mass. There is no limit to how many times you take home the Vocations Crucifix, but the idea is for it to rotate throughout the parish. How fitting it will be that this altar crucifix, which sat on the altar for thousands of Masses at St. Patrick's, will now be taken into homes of our parishioners as an encouragement for vocations! It shows how the graces of the Eucharist flow from the altar into our daily lives, and God-willing, will draw many young people to approach the altar, either as priests, or by laying down their lives in religious life. A sign-up sheet is available at the Welcome Center in the Gallery if you want to sign up for the first weekend, and it has also been sent online through Flocknote.

Next Sunday will actually be a fitting time to start rotating the Vocations Crucifix, since we will have a special homilist at our Masses: Fr. Michael Haemmerle. Father Haemmerle is a son of the parish, one of those men who responded to the Lord's call to be a diocesan priest. He now serves as the Director of Vocations for the Diocese of Columbus, and he will be here to preach about vocations at all the Masses, and will also be the sponsor for our May Donut Sunday.

This weekend, I'll be preaching at all the Masses, while also talking about *The Appeal*. We are now entering into the 2026 campaign for this annual appeal for diocesan ministries. Supporting vocations is just one of the things that *The Appeal* supports, and I'll have more to say to you this weekend. You, the parishioners of St. Patrick's, have been incredibly generous to *The Appeal* in the past, especially over the last two years. By exceeding our goal each year, we receive a rebate from the Diocese, which helps to cover expenses for various projects in the parish. The rebates from the last two years have gone toward funding for the new parish center roof and new lighting for the church. Thank you in advance for your generosity as we launch *The Appeal* for 2026.

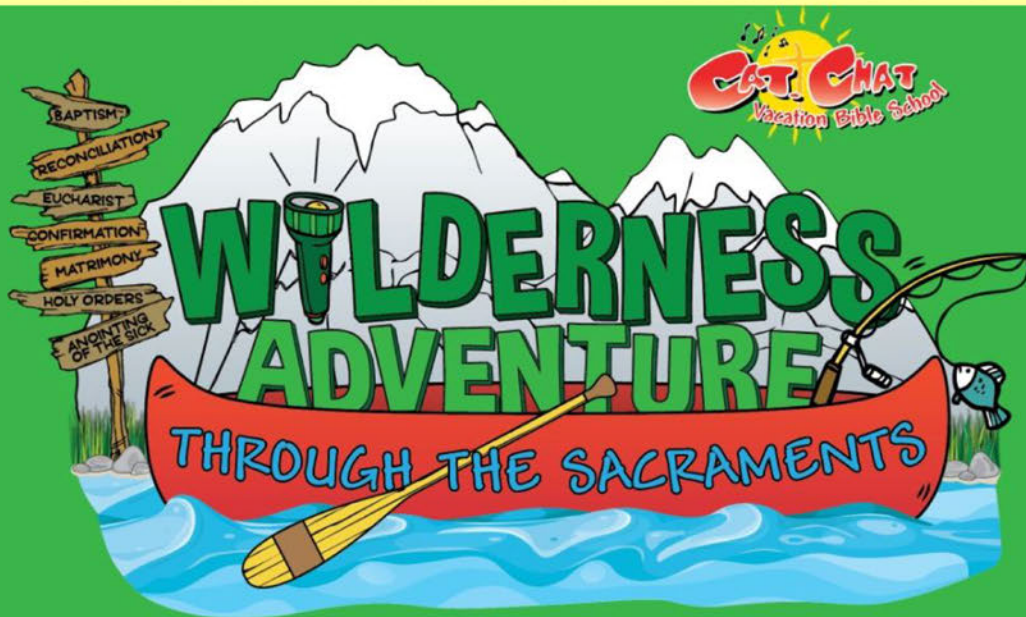
