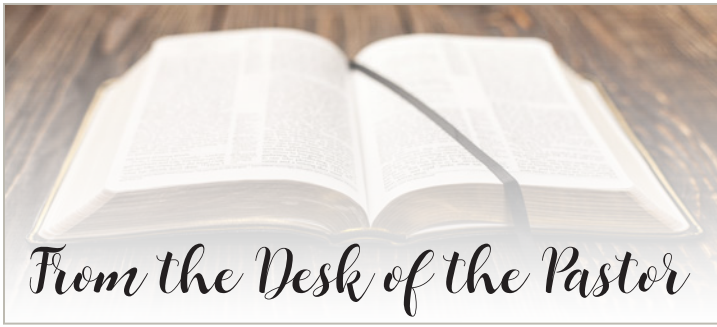

From the Desk of the Pastor

We give thanks to God for another weekend of celebrating the sacraments, with the First Holy Communion Mass on Saturday. Twenty-five of our second graders will receive Jesus for the first time in the Holy Eucharist, and on Sunday, they will be taking part in the May Crowning and Rosary Procession. Congratulations to our first communicants, and thank you to Sr. Marta, to our second grade catechists Lisa Hansen, Melissa Bair, and Jen Soccorsi, and to all the parents for preparing these children.

On Sunday, we celebrate Mother's Day, and we pray for all our mothers, and wish them many blessings on this special day. I'm grateful that after our Rosary Procession, I'll be able to drive up to Youngstown and visit my mother for the evening and take her out for a nice dinner!

As we wind down our year of parish events and ministries and look forward to the summer, I wanted to inform the parish about an adjustment we'll be making with the parish ministries of our friars. First of all, nobody is leaving for a new assignment, at least not yet (our Provincial Chapter is in June, and everything can always change after that!). However, our parochial vicars Fr. Michael Donahue and Fr. Cornelius Avaritt will be switching their parish responsibilities over the summer. Since his arrival here after his ordination in 2023, Fr. Michael Donahue has served as our Director of Youth Ministry. This was suitable for him as the newest priest on the parish staff. However, now after three years, he'll be switching over to direct our O.C.I.A. and adult catechesis programs. This will actually be a good and timely fit for Fr. Michael, since over the next year, he will be starting his application for a summer canon law program, which will begin in the summer of 2027. While Fr. Michael will be going on for further studies, the summer canon law program means that he will not have to leave St. Patrick's while he's in school. During the academic year, he will have to take a couple courses remotely, and he will be away for several weeks each summer, starting in 2027. During those summers, our Prior Provincial could arrange for a professor from the Dominican House of Studies or Providence College to help in the parish while he's on break (much like how Fr. Edmund helped out at the parish for many summers when he was a professor in Rome). However, our Prior Provincial has indicated that he plans to leave Fr. Michael assigned to St. Patrick's during his studies, so we're grateful that we won't be losing him. Being the Director of O.C.I.A. will also give him practical experience as he studies canon law: he will certainly have to work with couples in need of annulments, and there will likely be unclear baptismal statuses from other denominations

which he will have to investigate, so directing O.C.I.A. will give him opportunities for practical application of his studies.

With this switch, Fr. Cornelius Avaritt will become our Director of Youth and Young Adult Ministry, overseeing our youth group program alongside Eddie Cotter, as well as working with young adults in the parish. Father Cornelius is no stranger to the youth group: over his first year at St. Patrick's, he has helped with youth group confessions and has served as the chaplain for the C.Y.O. basketball team. Father Cornelius has overseen our O.C.I.A. program over the past year, and did a remarkable job, bringing nearly 30 people into the Church at Easter. He is also developing a special summer program called *Theology of the Homestead*. He will have more to tell you about it next week in the bulletin column, so stay tuned! In the meantime, Fr. Michael and Fr. Cornelius will make the change in their parish duties in June while I'm away at our Provincial Chapter. However, this change will not affect their ministry on Sundays, as they remain full-time parochial vicars, with their regular assignments of Masses, confessions, sick calls, and weddings.

Some exciting things will be happening at St. Patrick's this week: the Augustine Institute will be coming to film a new series for *Formed.org* beginning on Tuesday. On Wednesday, I invite everyone to join in our annual Fatima Procession from Holy Family Church. Please pray for good weather!

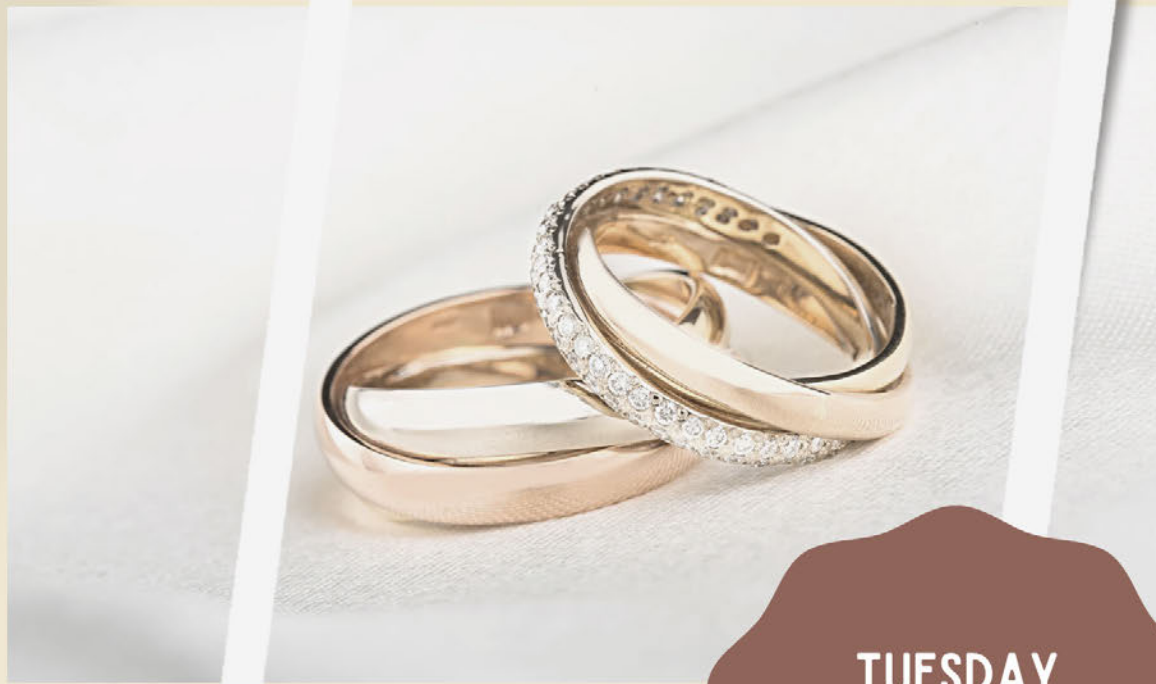

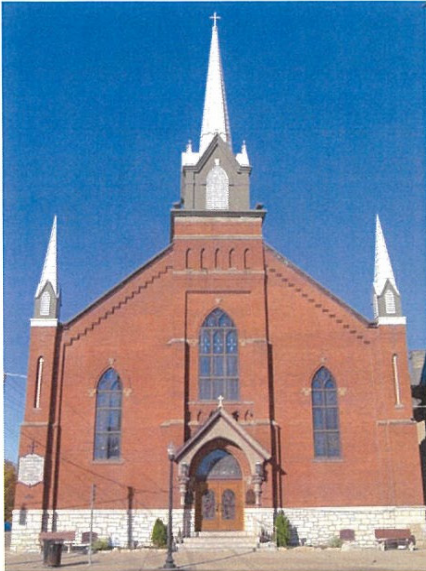

6 PM Begin boarding Shuttle Buses at St. Patrick Church to Holy Family Church for those who park at St. Patrick and wish to be in the procession.

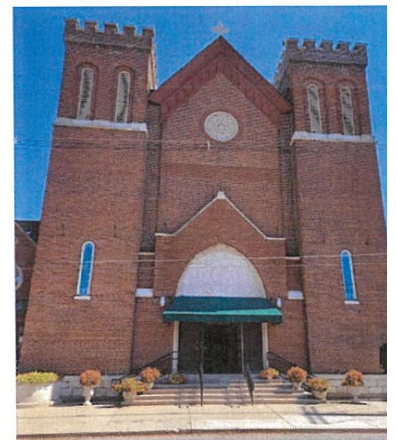

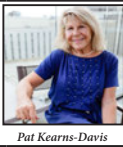
