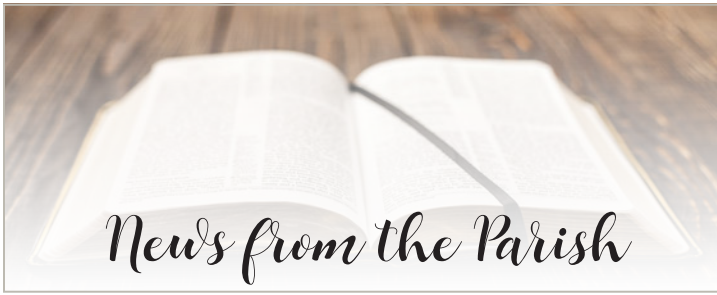

Dear Family and Friends of St. Patrick's

As we come to the end of a grace-filled Easter Season and look forward to a more relaxed summer schedule, I want to let you all know about a new and exciting venture that will happen in our parish!

This summer, we are going to launch a "Theology on the Homestead" family catechesis series. What is Theology on the Homestead, you ask? During the year, the parish offers Adult Catechesis nights on Tuesdays covering various topics in Aquinas Hall. For the summer, we're going to shift that model to the Homestead! Instead of hosting Tuesday night talks, we're going to go to the homesteads of some generous parishioners who will host a Sunday Night Theology on the Homestead event.

These Sunday nights out on the lawn will be open to the whole family. In this way, it's a family catechesis. BUT it's not just about a theology talk ... it's also about the PARTY!! At St. Patrick's we love to party, socialize and build community. It's a good thing. It makes our parish community stronger when we come together for these kinds of events. We face the unique challenge of having our parish community spread out North, South, East, and West of Columbus. These five Sundays will be evenings filled with food, drinks, lawn games, music, family time and a short dynamic presentation about the theology of family life. Br. Innocent, who is coming from DC, will give two of the talks along with other guest speakers and friars. The parish and host families will take care of the drinks and grill up the burgers, hot dogs and other meats, and we ask that you all bring a side to share for a potluck-style dinner.

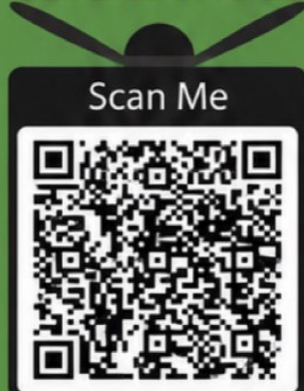

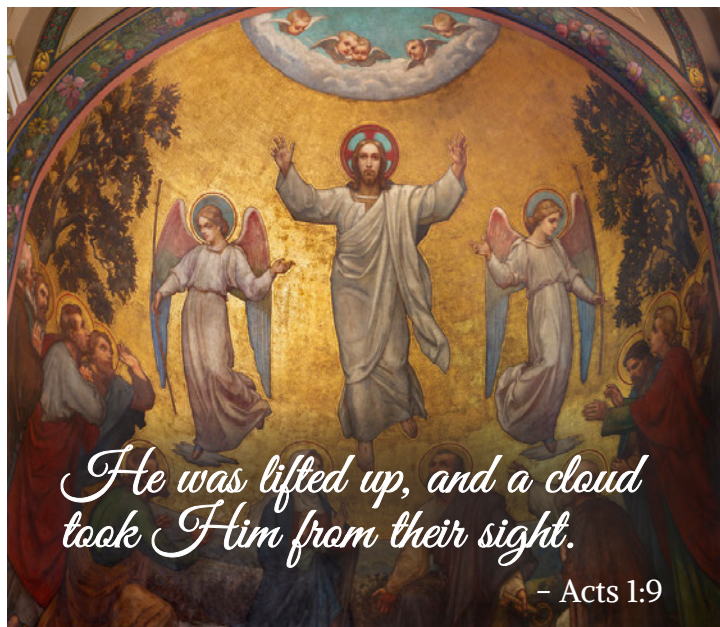

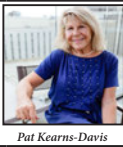
