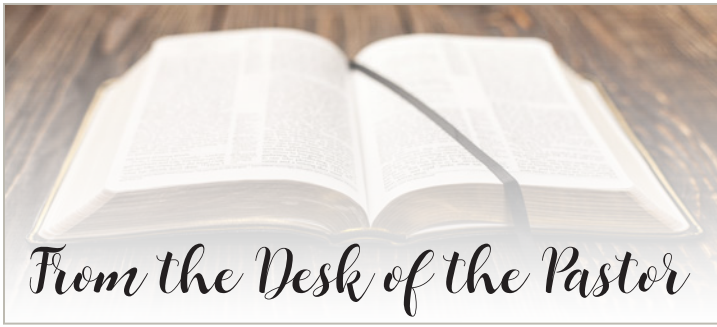

We rejoice on this Pentecost Sunday, as the Holy Spirit has been sent upon the Church! And as we celebrate this great feast, I wanted to update you on a couple ways in which the Holy Spirit has been moving in our own parish, inspiring and directing new endeavors.

Since February, the 175th anniversary committee has hosted two meetings, as we look forward to the 175th anniversary of our parish in 2027-2028. The first meeting in February was a chance to brainstorm about ideas, and in April, we started to make some concrete plans. Our plans are to have a “soft launch” of the anniversary festivities in February 2027, around the time of our parish mission (which will commemorate the date on which the parish was formally established). Then, our anniversary celebrations will officially commence on Saturday, September 25, 2027 (the anniversary of the dedication of the church building in 1853) with a Solemn Mass at 5:00 p.m., followed by a dinner reception (the location of the dinner is to be determined). I have invited Bishop Fernandes to celebrate the Mass, and I’ve also invited our former pastors who are still living to join us (Fr. Michael Dosch already said that he’s coming!). We are also looking to make a parish pilgrimage to Ireland in May 2028. Parishioner and committee member Patrick Whitney has been helping me with the pilgrimage, and we hope to have more information in the coming weeks. The anniversary celebrations will go for a full year, and will conclude on Monday, September 25, 2028, the 175th anniversary of the dedication of the church building. If you’re interested in helping out or joining the planning committee, please come to our next meeting on July 9th.

As our parochial vicars prepare to switch roles, and as we have implemented the lowered age of confirmation in the Diocese of Columbus (ages 9-10/fourth grade), I’ve seen the need to seek input from our parents on all of our youth-related activities in the parish. This not only includes youth ministry and C.C.D, but also Catechesis of the Good Shepherd, the Altar Boy Program, the Daughters of Veronica, American Heritage Girls, C.Y.O. Basketball, and Vacation Bible School. With this in mind, I have assembled a group of parents to assist me as a Parent Advisory Council on all of these youth-related activities. My hope is that this Council will provide the necessary feedback, helping us better integrate our youth-related ministries in the parish. We will meet quarterly, starting this Wednesday.

A number of months ago, parishioner Deb Newman approached me about possible opportunities for visiting the elderly, especially the elderly of the parish. The priests have a list of homebound

parishioners, who receive regular visits for confession, anointing of the sick, and Holy Communion, and a number of our extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion visit the homebound with the Eucharist each week. However, the vision of this new ministry looked at making visits with the elderly or helping them with certain errands, in order to keep them connected to St. Patrick’s. Deb started to get other interested volunteers, and in March, we went to Mother Angeline McCrory Manor and the Villas of St. Therese to visit parishioners who are in residence there. At these facilities, priest-chaplains are available to provide the sacraments on a regular basis. However, having parishioners visit is a great way to show the love of Christ to those who are lonely and in need. This new ministry will be called the SS. Simeon and Anna Homebound Ministry. The volunteers are starting at Mother Angeline and the Villas, but the hope is to expand visits to other healthcare facilities or private homes. The patronage of SS. Simeon and Anna is quite fitting, since they are pivotal players in the story of the Presentation of the Lord, celebrated each year on February 2nd. Since this feast day is an important day for our parish community, with our annual blessing of candles and procession, there is a great connection here: from our prayer and worship, we go forth to serve those in need. If you are interested in being part of this new ministry, please contact Deb.

Finally, parishioner Christopher Zehnder approached me about a discussion group on topics related to Catholic social teaching. This will begin as a summer gathering, and will hopefully continue in the fall. Christopher is a published author and holds an M.A. in theology, and he is well-versed in the social doctrine of the Church. This group will allow parishioners to gather for a time of intellectual pursuit and discussion, something quite fitting for a Dominican parish. If you are interested in learning more about the Church’s social teaching, please contact Christopher. The timing couldn’t be more perfect, as Pope Leo’s first encyclical letter, *Magnifica Humanitas*, will be released on Monday, examining the dangers and concerns of artificial intelligence (A.I.) in our present society.

COMMUNION RAIL KNEE PADS OUT FOR REPAIR

The knee pads for our altar rail are currently out for repair. Unfortunately, the new upholstery work, done locally two years ago, led to stretches in the stitching, which was handmade by members of the Women's Club in the 1980s. Henninger's in Cleveland will be repairing the stitching and reupholstering the knee pads. They will be out until early June. We do not have a sufficient amount of temporary knee pads for the entire length of the communion rail, so if you don't mind kneeling on the hard wood, please defer the use of the knee pads to those who need them.

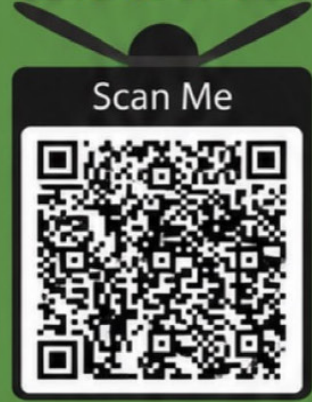

Some background:

Inspired by Saint Margaret of Castello, O.P., the ministry known as **Little Margaret's Charity** has served as St. Patrick's charitable arm for more than fifteen years.

Fifth Sunday Collections: Four times a year, during the months which include a fifth Sunday, the 2nd Collection at all Masses benefits Little Margaret's Charity.

Poor Box: Funds dropped in the poor boxes in the church also support the various causes of Little Margaret's Charity.

Donations to Little Margaret's Charity through the 5th Sunday Collection and the Poor Box support parishioners in need, as well as a number of pro-life organizations, including Ohio Right to Life, Greater Columbus Right to Life, Women's Care Center, PDHC, and Bethesda Healing Ministry. The poor and homeless of the downtown area are also aided by contributions to the Holy Family Soup Kitchen, Faith Mission, J.O.I.N., and the Community Kitchen.

Little Margaret's Charity also sponsors the annual **Giving Tree** at Christmas.

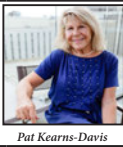
