News from the Parish

Today, we rejoice in the mystery *par excellence* of our Catholic faith: The Most Holy Trinity. Unlike so many other feast days in the liturgical calendar, it is the day that we rejoice in who God *is* over and above what He has *done* – though we do also commemorate the fact that God has revealed Himself to us!

In addition to this greatest of mysteries, we have another reason to rejoice today: graduations! In a special way, we are commemorating all graduating high school seniors of St. Patrick Church this weekend at the 9:00 a.m. Mass. These teens have accomplished much in reaching this point, and now they are turning the corner into adulthood. It can be a big step! But of course, as big as this transition might be for some, it is by that same token an opportunity for new beginnings and continued growth. Please pray for our graduating high school seniors as they take this next step in their lives. Pray especially that they may be guided by the indwelling of the Trinity and the light of God's grace.

Admittedly, this is also a point of transition for me. As Fr. Paul explained in his bulletin column three weeks ago, I will be switching roles with Fr. Cornelius beginning this summer: I will take over the OCIA program while he will take over as Director of Youth Ministry. This weekend celebration thus marks the final event of our youth program before the two of us begin that process of swapping positions.

I have thoroughly enjoyed working with the youth of our parish for these past three years. There have been many fun and exciting moments, as well as many moments of a quieter beauty and providential grace. The recent high school youth group road trip to New York state and the Shrine of Our Lady of Martyrs is a good example of many such moments!

However, in reflecting on my time as the Director of Youth Ministry, I was reminded of something from my own time in high school. The Catholic high school that I attended in Fargo had (at the time) a motto that everyone was expected to memorize and know: *"To teach the total person and foster the following of Christ."* In fact, we were liable to be quizzed on the motto in the hallways by one teacher in particular! As such, that motto has remained drilled in my memory for nearly two decades now. Perhaps unwittingly, it also became the standard that I tried to follow for the youth ministry program these past three years.

While I will miss working with the youth of our parish, I am looking forward to directing the OCIA and adult catechesis

programs (where I will continue using my high school's motto as my standard!). Please also pray for me and for Fr. Cornelius as we soon begin the process of switching our roles.

COMMUNION RAIL KNEE PADS OUT FOR REPAIR

The knee pads for our altar rail are currently out for repair. Unfortunately, the new upholstery work, done locally two years ago, led to stretches in the stitching, which was handmade by members of the Women's Club in the 1980's. Henninger's in Cleveland will be repairing the stitching and re-upholstering the knee pads. They will be out until early June. We do not have a sufficient amount of temporary knee pads for the entire length of the communion rail, so if you don't mind kneeling on the hard wood, please defer the use of the knee pads to those who need them.

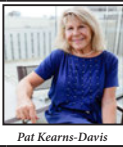
