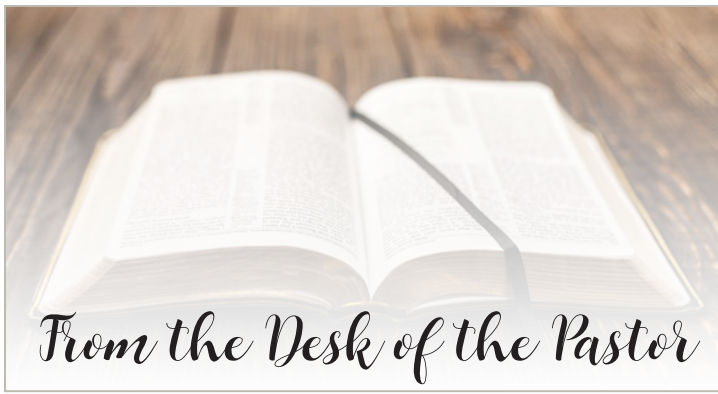

## From the Desk of the Pastor

Greetings from the Provincial Chapter in Providence, Rhode Island. I arrived here for the preliminary sessions on June 1st, and on June 5th, the Chapter re-elected our Prior Provincial, Fr. Allen Moran, O.P. Please pray for Fr. Allen as he continues to lead our Province for another four years. As I was not elected to the Diffinitorium (a group of six friars elected immediately after the Provincial, who govern the Province with him during the Chapter), I can guarantee that I will be back home later this week, while the Prior Provincial and Diffinitorium will have to remain for an extra week to finalize legislation and make important appointments and assignments for the coming four years. Our former parochial vicar, Fr. Boniface Endorf, was elected to the Diffinitorium. Please pray for all of us as we wrap up the Chapter this week, and for the Provincial and the Diffinitorium as they continue their work. Members of the Diffinitorium will serve on the Provincial Council for the next four years.

This past week marked an important milestone for me - on Wednesday, I celebrated two years as pastor of St. Patrick's! It is a true joy to serve you as your pastor, and I pray that I will continue in this role for many, many more years to come!

I am happy to share with you an exciting development in the life of our parish and in the formation of our young people. With the lowering of the age of Confirmation to grade 4, we now find a need to re-assess our parish C.C.D. curriculum. With our children confirmed at a lower age, it is important for us to look at catechesis in the years that follow Confirmation as a time to unpack the mysteries that have been received in the Sacrament, seeing it as an opportunity for the unfolding of the mystery. This is distinct from catechesis as preparation for the Sacrament, which will continue in grade 2 for First Confession and First Holy Communion and grade 4 for Confirmation.

After prayer and consultation with our new Parent Advisory Council, it has become clear that our families desire more for their youth in these years after Confirmation. There is a need for a new, engaging experience that will help them discover their identity as sons and daughters of God and equip them with solid formation in what it means to be human. They are asking, whether aloud or silently: Who am I? Why do I exist? What does it mean to be human? What does it mean to love? What should my relationship with God look like? How should I understand myself, my body, my friendships, my responsibilities, and my relationship with others?

Theology of the Body is an integral understanding of the human person developed by Pope St. John Paul II. His Scripture-based reflections about God's original design for the human person provide a needed Christian anthropology for our times. The Ruah Woods Institute (based in Cincinnati) provides Theology of the Body curriculum and resources for parishes, that will help us guide our youth to a discovery of who God is, who they are, and how they fit into this challenging world. Their curriculum follows the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (U.S.C.C.B.) framework, integrating the four pillars of the *Catechism of the Catholic Church*: Creed, Sacraments, Morality, and Prayer.

As part of this renewal, Ruah Woods' *Revealed* will become the base of our junior high curriculum, and *Called to Be More* will become the base of our high school curriculum. These programs will help us more intentionally integrate Theology of the Body, Catholic social teaching, Scripture, the *Catechism*, and the broader framework of Catholic anthropology into our C.C.D. program. The general structure will be:

**Pre-K, Kindergarten and 1st Grade:** Catechesis of the Good Shepherd

**2nd Grade:** *Faith and Life*, including First Confession and First Communion preparation

**3rd Grade:** *Faith and Life*

**4th Grade:** *Faith and Life* and Confirmation preparation

**5th Grade:** *Faith and Life*: The Creed

**6th Grade:** Ruah Woods' *Revealed* Level I, with additional catechesis on the Sacraments

**7th and 8th Grades:** Ruah Woods' *Revealed* Levels II and III on a two-year rotation, with an emphasis on Morality and Prayer

**9th through 12th Grades:** *Called to Be More*, organized into eight courses, one per semester, across the high school years.

For our older students, we are also adjusting the format of catechesis so that beginning in junior high, our students can develop a sense of community and a deeper discovery of truth as they discuss, reflect, interact, and have guided conversations.

For high school in particular, *Called to Be More* will support a model that is less like a straight academic class and more like a formation community. Students will participate in small-group discussion, catechist-facilitated conversation, peer engagement, and shared speaker sessions for three out of the four Sundays each month. Some discussions will be separated between young men and young women so that certain topics can be addressed in a more age-appropriate, pastorally sensitive, and fruitful way. At other times, students will come together for co-ed sessions with guest speakers who can address relevant topics through the mind and heart of the Church. For example, a freshman girl will be in a group with other 9th and 10th grade girls with female catechists and work through two consecutive weeks of *Called to Be More*.

The next week, all the formation groups will come together for a speaker, and the following week, the high school students will have a week off of C.C.D.

This approach is intended to create a stronger community, better engagement, and deeper formation. We want students to experience C.C.D. not simply as a class they attend, but as a place where they are known, challenged, encouraged, and accompanied.

This is an exciting opportunity for our parish to deepen the formation of our young people and to help them build the spiritual and intellectual tools they need to live as Catholics in the world today. 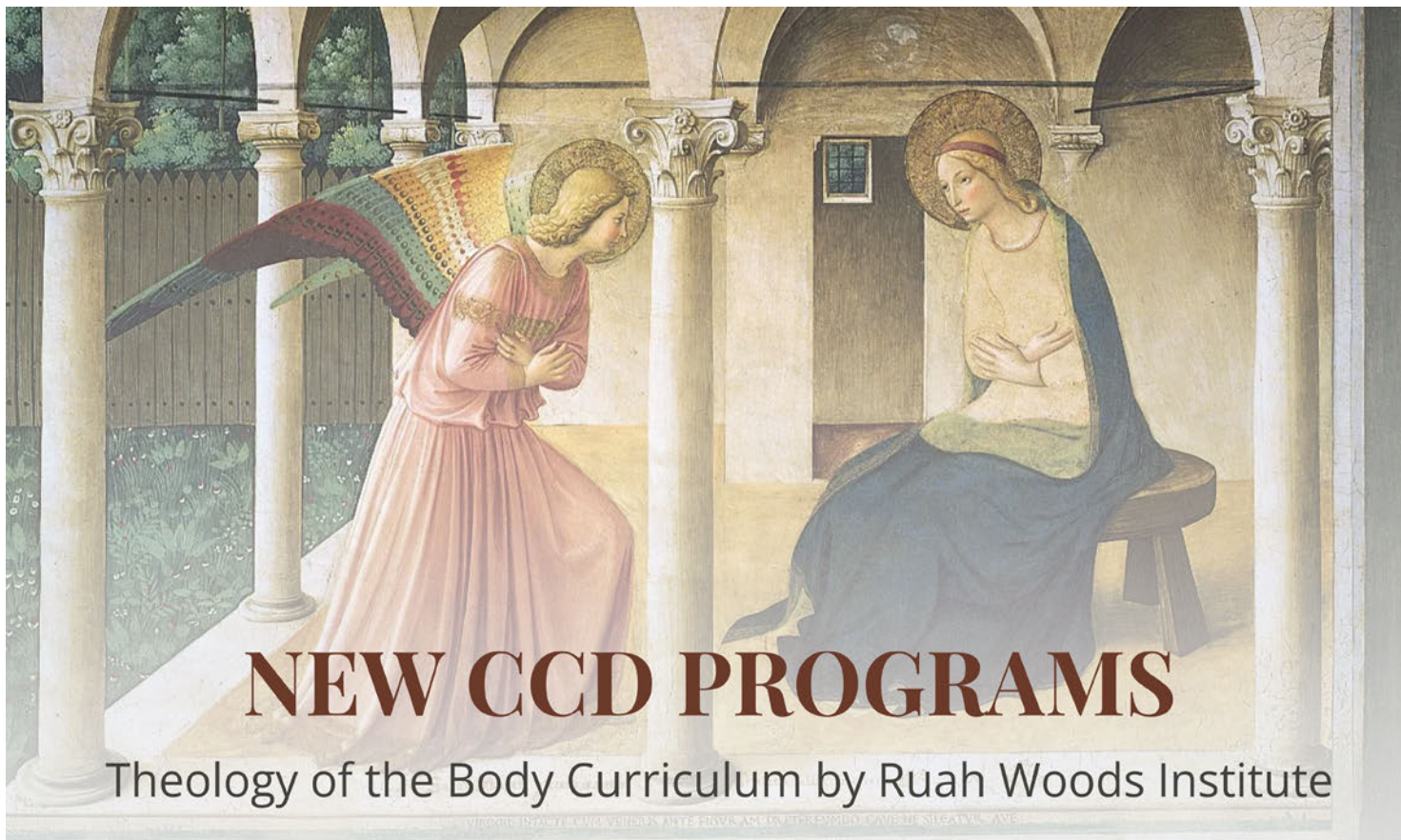

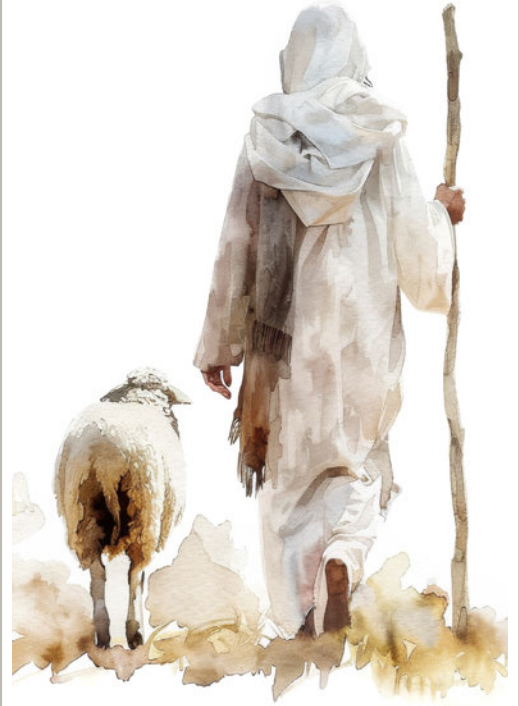
