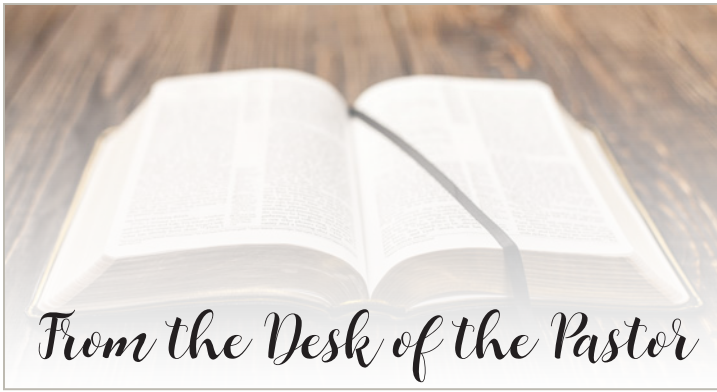

I arrived back from the Provincial Chapter on Tuesday night – thankfully, we finished on Monday afternoon, and I was able to return home earlier than expected. I’m grateful for that. While it was a great opportunity to serve the Province and experience first-hand our form of self-government, I missed St. Patrick’s so much! I’m grateful to be home, and now I can settle in for a number of summer activities.

During the Provincial Chapter, our former parochial vicar, Fr. Boniface Endorf, O.P., was named the new Socius and Vicar Provincial of the Province of St. Joseph. In this role, he succeeds our former pastor, Fr. Michael Dosch, O.P., who will be receiving a new assignment. The Socius and Vicar Provincial serves as the main advisor and assistant to the Prior Provincial, working alongside him in the Provincial Office in New York, and helping him in the governance of the Province. This is indeed a great honor for Fr. Boniface, who certainly has the administrative skills for such important work. He will remain in New York City, but will be moving from his current assignment as Pastor of St. Joseph’s in Greenwich Village, to residence at St. Vincent Ferrer Priory on the Upper East Side of Manhattan.

While I was away, I was sorry to miss the first Theology on the Homestead, held at the Platek residence. I have heard nothing but great reports, and that everything worked out despite some initial rain. This is a great opportunity to learn more about the theology of marriage and family life in a casual setting, while sharing fellowship with parishioners and friends. Consider coming to the next Theology on the Homestead on Sunday, June 28th, when Br. Innocent will be presenting.

In his recent pilgrimage to Spain, our Holy Father, Pope Leo XIV, had some encouraging words that I wanted to share. “*Do not be afraid to consider a vocation - marriage is also a vocation. Do not be afraid of marriage and of starting a family,*” says Pope Leo. I couldn’t agree with him more! First, we need this reminder more than ever in the month of June, when the culture presents us with an opposite message about marriage. We as Catholics stand firm in our belief that marriage is between one man and one woman. But secondly, it is an invitation for those who are aren’t married, and who know that the Lord is not calling them to the priesthood or the religious life. Listen to the words of the Holy Father: Don’t be afraid to embrace the vocation of marriage! The Church and society are built upon strong families. The vocation of marriage is a vocation of self-gift, in which husband and wife make a gift of

self to the other, and together, they make a gift of themselves for the sake of their children. What a beautiful treasure that God has left the Church with the vocation of marriage. I’ll repeat the Holy Father’s words, especially for our young people: “Do not be afraid of marriage and starting a family.”

Such words are appropriate for this weekend, as we celebrate Father’s Day. We will offer a special blessing for all fathers at the end of each Mass. On this Father’s Day, I offer a word of thanks and encouragement to all fathers. Thank you for living out your vocation in your homes. Through hard work, teaching, care, and protection, you provide for your families and lead them to holiness. Never forget that this is your first task, indeed the greatest role of any father – leading your family to heaven! May St. Joseph watch over you and protect you always. I also ask everyone to pray for us spiritual fathers, your priests, on this Father’s Day!

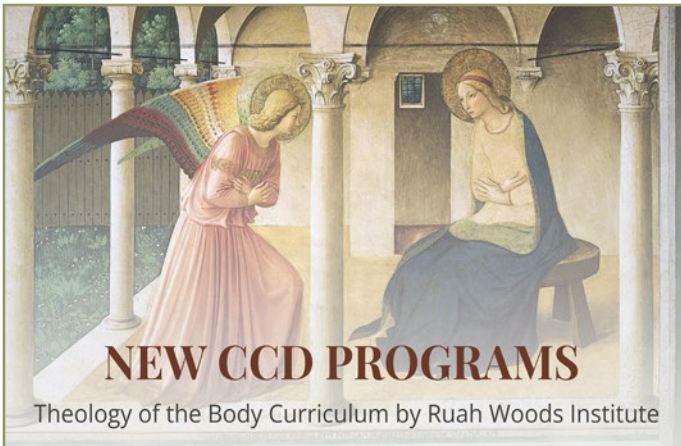
