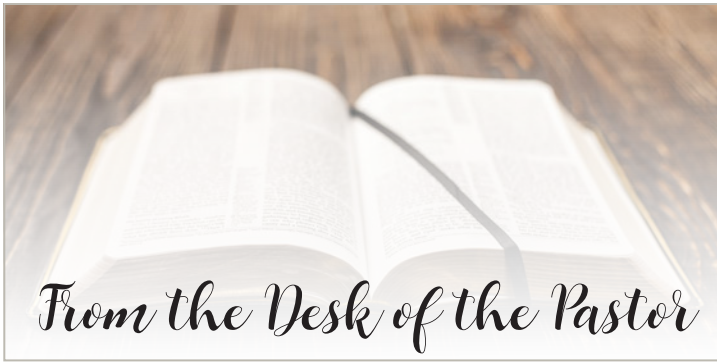

## From the Desk of the Pastor

During a Provincial Chapter, there are a number of new assignments made, and I need to share with you some news that will impact our local Dominican community at St. Patrick's. Father Stephen Dominic Hayes has received a new assignment, and will be moving up to Youngstown to join Fr. Frassati Davis at St. Dominic Parish and Priory.

Father Hayes served as parochial vicar at St. Patrick's from 1993-2003, and has been back at St. Patrick's since 2017. During his second assignment in Columbus, he has served as an itinerant preacher, traveling the country to preach missions and retreats. He was on the parish staff as a parochial vicar for six months in 2021, and from 2022-2025, he served as Prior of St. Patrick Priory. Besides his two assignments at St. Patrick's, he also had two assignments at St. Thomas Aquinas Parish in Zanesville (from 1988-1993, and again from 2010-2017) when the friars were there. When you add that all up, Father Hayes has served for 31 of his 38 years of priesthood in the Diocese of Columbus! We also can't forget his work with the cultural exhibit at the Dublin Irish Festival, and his knowledge for making torches for our parish feast day celebration. Father Hayes is certainly a legend here, and his presence will be greatly missed! Yet the Lord calls him to a new ministry, to help Fr. Frassati as he expands the work of the friars in Youngstown. Father Hayes speaks Spanish, so his presence in Youngstown will be a great asset to the friars' ministry at St. Dominic's. But you can rest assured - he'll be back down every year for the Dublin Irish Festival (and I hope he comes down for St. Patrick's Day, too!). Father Hayes will still be with us until after this year's Dublin Irish Festival, and we will have a send-off for him in late August. With Fr. Frassati and Fr. Hayes both in Youngstown, I think we should take a parish bus trip up at some point to visit them (and I can also show you where I grew up!).

On Friday, June 26th, a former parishioner, Fr. Luke Maria Lee, O.P. (formerly Dr. Eric Lee) was ordained a priest for the Dominican Province of the Most Holy Name (Western Province). Father Luke was a member of our parish between 2013-2015, and sang in our parish choir and was a member of the Knights of Columbus Council 11207. He joined the novitiate for the Western Province in 2018, and we are grateful that God has called him to the holy priesthood. I've been in touch with Fr. Luke about returning to St. Patrick's for a Mass of Thanksgiving; unfortunately, his schedule and the start date of his first assignment won't make it possible this summer, but we are looking at having him visit in the spring. Congratulations to Fr. Luke and his four classmates!

This week is a momentous week for our country, as Saturday will mark the 250th anniversary of the signing of the Declaration of Independence and the founding of our country. It is indeed a day of great celebration, but also an opportunity to pray for our nation. In a letter to his wife Abigail, Founding Father John Adams (who would later become the 2nd President of the United States) remarked that American independence would be observed "by succeeding Generations...with Pomp and Parade, with Shows, Games, Sports, Guns, Bells, Bonfires and Illuminations from one End of this Continent to the other from this Time forward forever more." He was quite right, as parades, sporting events, and fireworks are a staple of our Fourth of July celebrations. But we mustn't forget the first thing that Adams writes in this letter: "solemn Acts of Devotion to God Almighty." The Founding Fathers knew that the freedom they had attained was only possible because of God, in whom we find our true freedom. Though only one signer of the Declaration of Independence was a Catholic (Charles Carroll of Carrollton), we can be grateful that our Catholic faith has been able to grow in our country, and that we can practice our faith freely. May we never take this for granted! In the midst of our July 4th celebrations, I want to invite everyone to consider making the most solemn act of devotion and worship to God: come to Mass on Independence Day! We'll have our regular 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Saturday Masses, but we will also have a special 10:00 a.m. Mass. Come and give thanks to God for our country and for the blessings of freedom which come from Him!

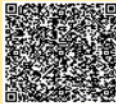
