From the Desk of the Pastor

On this weekend, we give thanks to God for the blessing of our country, and for the 250th birthday of our nation on July 4th. Please continue to pray for our country, for our leaders, for peace and safety, and for the conversion of hearts. I hope that you've had time to celebrate with your families over this weekend. Even we Dominicans have been celebrating: The friars at St. Gertrude's in Cincinnati always host a Fourth of July cookout for the Dominican communities in Ohio and Kentucky. It's a great tradition to celebrate our nation's birth, while also reconnecting with friars in the area, and to meet with our novices. Pray for the novices as eight of them prepare for their simple profession of vows on August 15th. We are also grateful that 15 men will be entering the novitiate next month, receiving the holy habit of St. Dominic on August 8th.

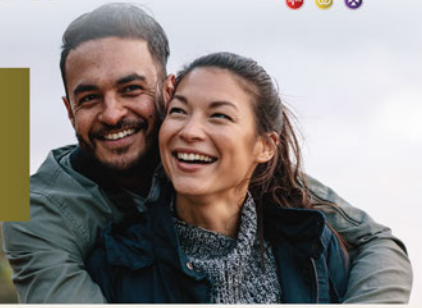

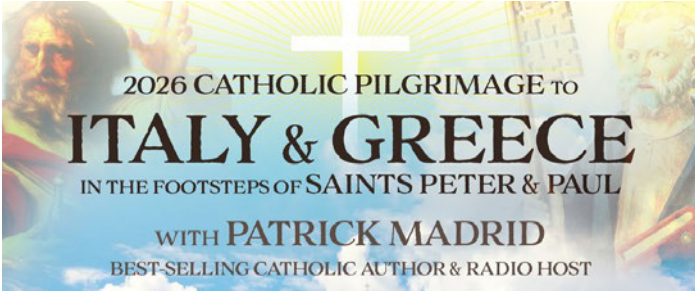
