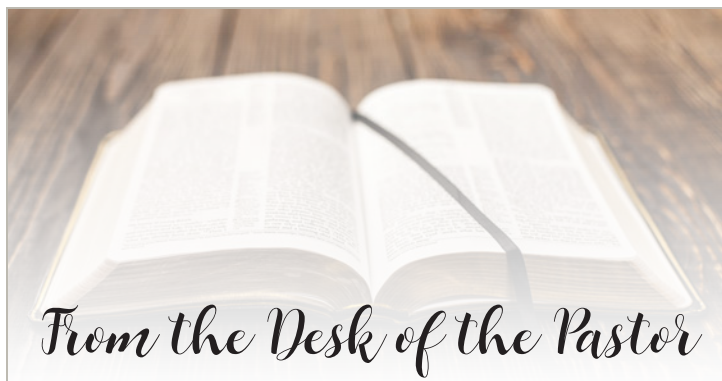

This weekend, we are blessed to welcome Fr. Gideon Muchira, O.P., from the East African Vicariate. Father Gideon arrived in the United States last month for the recent Provincial Chapter, and he is now making visits to various parishes to speak about the work of the Dominican friars in East Africa. Our second collection today will be supporting the Vicariate, and the friars thank you in advance for your generosity!



The recent Provincial Chapter of the Dominican Province of St. Joseph is over, but I have some news to share about a couple of friars who served at St. Patrick's in the past. During the Provincial Chapter, our former parochial vicar, Fr. Frassati Davis, O.P., received a very special honor. He was elected to represent the Dominican Province of St. Joseph at the next General Chapter of the Dominican Order in the summer of 2028 in Bogotá, Colombia, where friars from all over the world will gather for elections and discussion of legislation which govern the entire Order. He will accompany our Prior Provincial, Fr. Allen Moran, and one other delegate, and they will be electors for the next Master of the Order during the General Chapter. This is a rare honor for any friar, since the Master of the Order is elected once every nine years! I am so happy for Fr. Frassati, and this is indeed a well-deserved honor for him. I know that he will represent our Province well. Father Frassati has been doing incredible work as Pastor at St. Dominic Parish in Youngstown, ministering to a largely Spanish-speaking community.

Our former pastor, Fr. Michael Mary Dosch, O.P., has received a new assignment: he will be moving to St. Dominic Priory in Washington, D.C. At St. Dominic's, Fr. Michael Mary will be the Master of Students for the transitional deacons who live there. In this role, Fr. Michael Mary will be preparing these deacons in their last year of formation before ordination to the priesthood. His pastoral experience and skills from his years at St. Patrick's will be an invaluable asset for our many young friars before they get ordained to the priesthood and begin active ministry. In this role, Fr. Michael Mary will be preparing the next wave of newly ordained priests, and some of them will likely come through St. Patrick's for their first assignments in the coming years. For the next three classes of transitional deacons, they already had Fr. Michael Mary as their novice master in Cincinnati!

I teased Fr. Michael Mary that these brothers will be getting a "double dose of Dosch!" Please pray for Fr. Michael Mary as he begins this new and important assignment in Washington.

July is the month of the Precious Blood, and we are pleased to announce a new piece of artwork for the month: a painting of "The Crucifixion" by Fra Angelico, surrounded by a hand-carved frame with the Pelican and Chalice, which are traditional images depicting the Precious Blood of Christ. This new piece of artwork is a gift of the Lay Fraternities of St. Dominic, and was made by Doug Ritzenthaler, with help from his brother-in-law Matthew Kramer. As we keep the statue of Our Lady of Fatima in the sanctuary during the month of May and an image of the Sacred Heart of Jesus in the sanctuary during the month of June, we will now have a fitting and beautiful piece of artwork in the sanctuary for the month July in honor of the Precious Blood. May this new piece of art draw us closer to the Lord Jesus, whose blood was shed for our salvation.

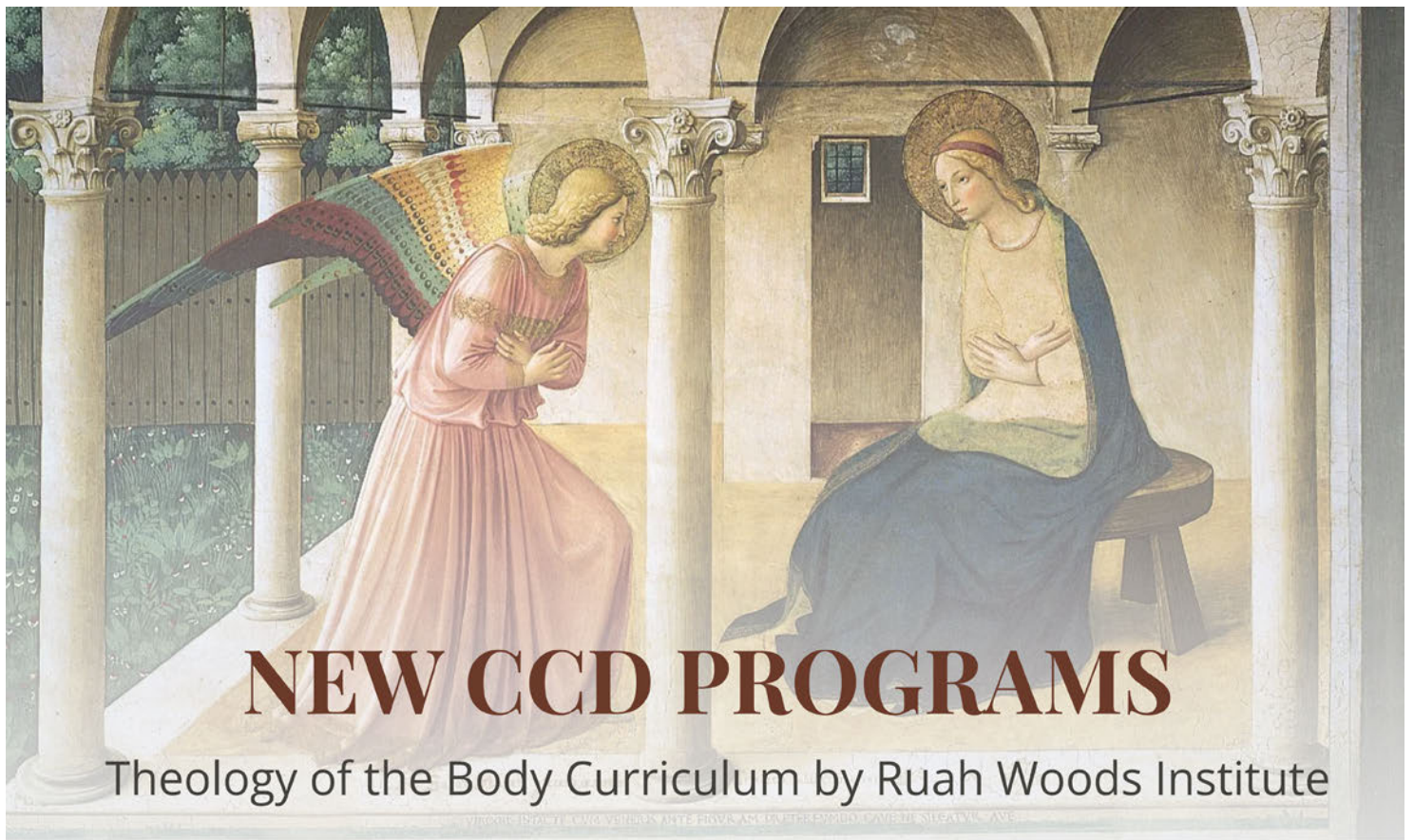

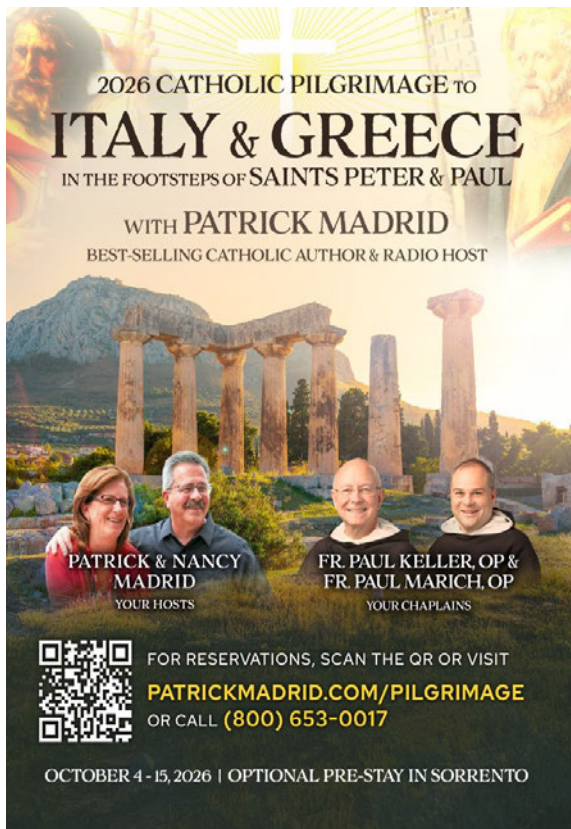
