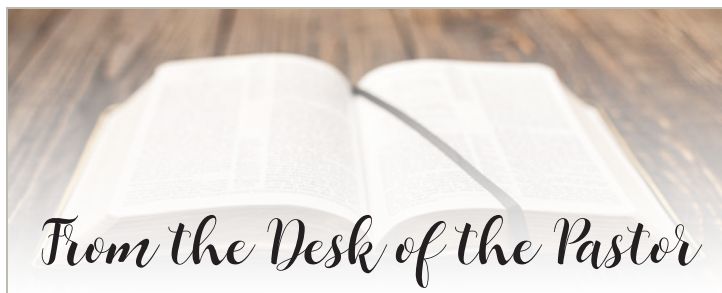

From the Desk of the Pastor

The summer is winding down (with the official start of autumn on Tuesday), and our parish ministries are now back in full swing. My summer has been busy since I came back from our Provincial Chapter in Rhode Island, but next Sunday, I'll be flying to Europe for a pilgrimage in the footsteps of St. Paul with Patrick and Nancy Madrid. Father Paul Keller and I will be serving as co-chaplains, so it's a Pauline pilgrimage with the two Father Pauls!

While the pilgrimage doesn't begin until October 3rd, I'm heading to Europe early for a very special reason: to visit my cousins in Croatia! I've been blessed to stay in contact with them over the years, but the last time I saw them was nearly 20 years ago. It will be very special to visit my ancestral homeland and my extended family, now as a priest. This will be my summer vacation (even if it is officially in the fall!) before beginning the pilgrimage.

The newly refurbished altar rail knee pads have been back in place for a couple months, and they are a welcome relief after the temporary knee pads! They also look beautiful and will preserve this work of art for many more years to come. I want to acknowledge the Women's Club, who were the first donors of the knee pads in the 1990's. Today, they are contributing to the repairs of the knee pads, and I want to thank them for their generosity to the parish. The Women's Club meets on the second Tuesday of the month at 10:00 a.m. in Aquinas Hall, followed by the 11:45 a.m. Mass, and all women of the parish are welcome and encouraged to join. They also have their next bake sale coming up, which you don't want to miss!

I would also like to thank the Knights of Columbus Council #11207 for donating our new wooden processional crucifix, which you have seen used at Mass over the last couple of weekends. It is a beautiful wood-carved crucifix from Italy, mounted on a processional pole, and was purchased from Generations Religious Gifts and Church Supply. It is also much lighter than the previously used crucifix, which will be easier for our altar boys to carry. The new processional crucifix enhances the beauty of our parish liturgies, but also comes at a time of necessity, with the re-arrangement of the ambo (pulpit) and sedilia (priest's chair). With the crucifer now sitting on the south side of the sanctuary with the priest, it became necessary to attach a wall latch for the procession crucifix, where it will rest during Mass (and where it can be easily picked up during the Gospel Procession). However, the previous wooden crucifix did not fit the latch, so now was the right time to acquire this beautiful crucifix. Thank you, Knights, for your kindness and generosity! I invite all men of the parish over age 18 to consider joining the Knights of Columbus, the

largest Catholic fraternal organization in the world. They meet on the first Tuesday of the month with the Rosary at 6:30 p.m., and their meeting at 7:00 p.m. in the Kolbe classroom.

As the current liturgical year starts to wind down and we look toward Advent, I wanted to inform the parish about an important change we'll be making in our music department. For the last several years, we have used the *Lumen Christi Missal* (a.k.a., "the red missals") in our pews, which have been complete with the Sunday lectionary, as well as the proper antiphons for every Sunday, which we have been singing regularly throughout this year. This was first published by liturgical musician Adam Bartlett, and has been a great asset for the music of our parish (along with the accompanying *Lumen Christi Hymnal*). The *Lumen Christi Missal* is no longer printed, as Mr. Bartlett adapted the hardcover missal format to a paperback missalette, called *Source and Summit*, which is the successor to the *Lumen Christi Missal*.

The *Source and Summit* missalette incorporates a similar format as the *Lumen Christi Missal*, but is published anew each year. This will make it easier to find the Sunday readings in the missalette (since you can find the specific date, rather than trying to figure out which Sunday in the liturgical year is being celebrated). Moreover, *Source and Summit* provides a greater amount of hymns than what is currently available in the *Lumen Christi Hymnal*, which can be used at the offertory and recessional. The devotional prayers found in the *Lumen Christi Missal* are also found in the back of *Source and Summit*. Bishop Fernandes has encouraged parishes to implement *Source and Summit*, and many are starting to do so, which is an improvement for their parish music ministries. This will not change our music at St. Patrick's, since *Source and Summit* continues what has already been in *Lumen Christi* – it simply comes in a new publication.

Replacing the hardcover missals (many of which are worn) with paperback missalettes each year will incur some new costs; however, this was going to happen at some point anyway. A revised version of the Lectionary is being prepared for the United States, with a projected start date of Advent 2028. Our parish knew that we would have to replace the *Lumen Christi Missals* in due time, and this year gave us an opportunity to secure a good price with *Source and Summit*, and prepare for the next generation of this liturgical publication, at least on an experimental basis. We'll see what options are available when we need to make a permanent change in a couple years. If you love the music of our parish, and are looking to support our music ministry, I encourage you to make a special offering to help defray the cost of these new missalettes, which will be used on the First Sunday of Advent, November 29th. With the upcoming month of November, in which we remember the dead, perhaps you would consider making a donation in memory of a loved one? I offer my sincere thanks to Kathleen Tully, our Director of Music, for her guidance and assistance, as we implement this new missalette in the coming months.

Preparing for the Unthinkable!

St. Patrick Church, in partnership with the Columbus Division of Police, will host an important training session on Civilian Response to Active Shooter Events (**C.R.A.S.E.**) – Safety & Security Training.

Date: Tuesday, October 13, 2026

Time: 6:30 – 9:00 PM

Location: St. Patrick Church, 280 N. Grant Ave., Columbus, Ohio 43215

This training focuses on strategies to respond and survive a violent event, emphasizing the nationally recognized **Avoid, Deny and Defend** principles. Participants will learn how to:

- Recognize warning signs of potential violence.
- Respond if violent or aggressive individuals enter the facilities.
- Prepare for, avoid and safely react to an active aggressor situation.

Training will be led by Officers Chad Knode and Rick Hannah of the Columbus Division of Police. Together, they bring nearly 60 years of exemplary service and serve as Subject Matter Experts (**SME**). Attendees will have the opportunity to ask direct questions and engage with the experts.

Even if you have attended **C.R.A.S.E.** training in the past, significant updates have been made and attendance is strongly encouraged.

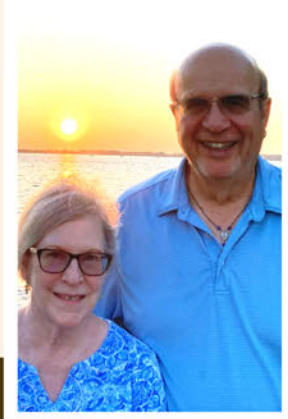

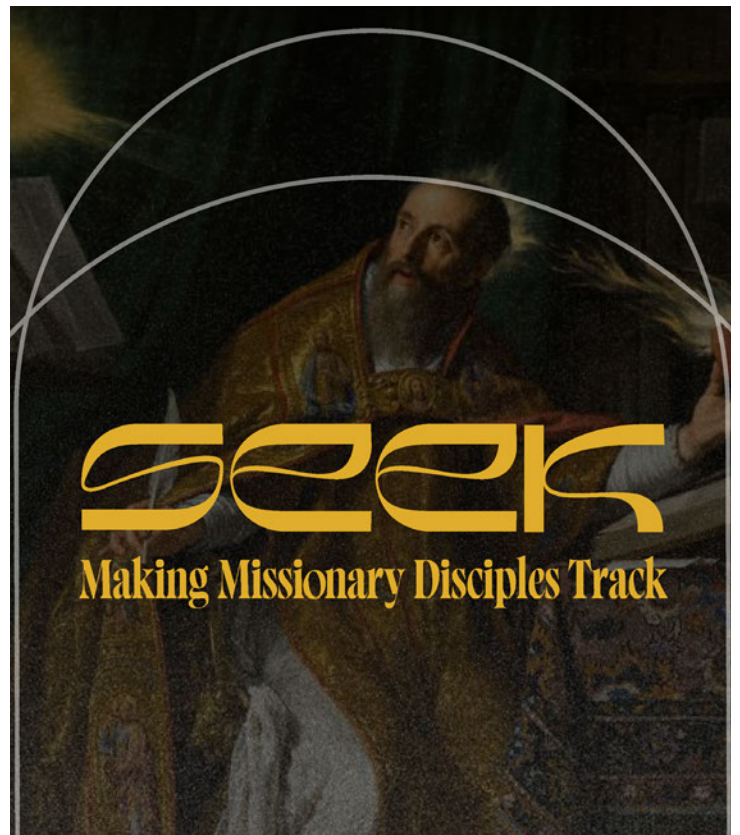
