Game Notes

- ▲ Oregon State plays in its second consecutive road game when the Beavers visit Stanford Saturday night at Stanford Stadium. Kickoff is slated for 8 p.m. PT.
- ▲ The game will air live on ESPN. Mark Jones (play-by-play), Robert Griffin III (analyst) and Quint Kessenich (sideline) will call the action.
- ▲ The teams are meeting for the 89th time, and 43rd in California. Stanford holds a 30-10-2 advantage on its home turf.
- ▲ The game will air live on the Beaver Sports Radio Network. For a list of affiliates, turn to page two of these notes.
- ▲ Every game this season can be heard live on the Varsity Network, a free application available via computer browsers, smartphones and tablets. After downloading the application, search for Oregon State.

Oregon State Notables

- ▲ Tre'Shaun Harrison has caught 16 passes for 251 yards and a touchdown over his past three games.
- ▲ Oregon State's defense ranks fourth in the Pac-12 Conference allowing just 358 yards per game.
- ▲ OSU has gone three consecutive games without allowing a sack, tied for the longest streak by an Oregon State team since 1996-97.
- ▲ The Beavers are second in the Pac-12 in opponent red zone conversion percentage at 68.4. Only USC is better at 60 percent.

Last Meeting

- ▲ Oregon State snapped an 11-game win streak by the Cardinal with a 35-14 win in Corvallis last season.
- ▲ Oregon State led 14-0 after the first half and 28-7 entering the fourth quarter.
- ▲ Chance Nolan passed for 257 yards and ran for a 4-yard score. He also completed a 67-yard TD pass to Trevon Bradford.
- ▲ Jaydon Grant and Rejzohn Wright each intercepted passes and Omar Speights totaled a team-best nine tackles.

Against Stanford

▲ Stanford holds the all-time series advantage, 59-26-3.

▲ Jonathan Smith's program-record 97-yard pass to Chad Johnson occurred against Stanford on Oct. 14, 2000. He also found T.J. Houshmandzadeh for 76 yards in that game.

▲ Smith holds the Oregon State single-game record for passing yards versus the Cardinal with 405 in 1999. The effort also marked his second-most, behind 469 at Washington in 1998.

▲ Steve Brown's 22 tackles against Stanford in 1972 remain the program's standard. That record was equaled by Andre Harris in 1988 versus Colorado.

▲ Oregon State is making its first visit to Stanford since 2018 and is looking for its first win there since a 30-7 victory in 2006.

▲ Stanford managed just 230 yards of offense in 2021, the fewest allowed by the Beaver defense in a conference game since limiting the Cardinal to 222 during the 2017 season.

▲ OSU held Stanford to 15 first downs in last season's win, tied for the fewest in a conference game under Smith as the team's head coach.

▲ The Beavers' defense has held Stanford to an average of 361.8 yards per game over the last five meetings.

Harrison From 2021 To 2022

▲ Tre'Shaun Harrison has nearly surpassed his 2021 numbers through the first five games of 2022. The wide receiver has caught 24 passes for 337 yards and two touchdowns as the Beavers enter Saturday's matchup at Stanford.

▲ His 2021 numbers: 29 catches for 401 yards and three touchdowns.

▲ Harrison, as mentioned on page one, has 16 receptions for 251 yards over his last three games. That's an average of 15.7 yards per catch.

▲ The Seattle native has 99 receptions for 1,235 yards at the

FBS level, with 62 receptions for 880 yards coming in 20 games as a Beaver. He played in 24 games for Florida State before coming to Corvallis.

Speights To 254

- ▲ Omar Speights has totaled 15 tackles over the past two games, which includes a season-best eight against USC on Sept. 24.
- ▲ Speights now has 254 career tackles in 37 games.
- ▲ His 254 tackles are 28 shy of tying Jonathan Jackson (282 from 1996-99) for 10th-most in a career at Oregon State.
- ▲ To tie Jackson, Speights would need to average four tackles per regular-season game. He has totaled five or more tackles in 27 of his 37 career games played.

Kipper To 37

- ▲ Brandon Kipper started his 37th career game - all consecutively - for the Beavers against Utah. Kipper is aiming to become the 22nd player in school history to start 40 or more games as a Beaver.
- ▲ Only six players, meanwhile, have started 40 or more consecutively.

Under Jonathan Smith

- ▲ Oregon State is 15-5 when leading at halftime. The Beavers are also 14-2 when taking a lead into the fourth quarter.
- ▲ The Beavers are 12-11 when controlling time of possession.
- ▲ Oregon State is 13-13 at home.
- ▲ The Beavers have scored 30 or more points in 23 of his 49 games, going 16-7.
- ▲ Oregon State is 12-7 when outgaining its opponent.

First To Four

- ▲ Oregon State is playing its fourth game of the season away from Reser Stadium on Saturday. The Beavers will be the first Pac-12 team to play four games away from its home stadium this season.
- ▲ Only one other team, Colorado, has played three games away from its home stadium, but has a bye this week.
- ▲ Oregon State last played four of its last six regular-season games at home during the 2014 season.

First-Half Numbers

- ▲ Oregon State has been getting out on the right foot in the first half of games this season. The Beavers have outscored opponents, 92-51, in the first half.
- ▲ OSU is averaging nearly 80 yards better than opponents - 229.6 to 150.8.
- ▲ The Beavers have passed for five touchdowns in the first half, and have allowed just one. OSU has given up just three rushing scores while totaling seven of its own.
- ▲ Opponents are also just 4-for-8 in the red zone in the first half, compared to a 10-for-10 mark for the Beavers.

▲ OSU is also 5-for-6 on fourth-down conversions.

THE O-line

- ▲ For the second consecutive season, the Beavers have gone three straight games without allowing a sack. The 2021 Beavers achieved the feat Nov. 13, 20 and 27 against Stanford, Arizona State and Oregon, respectively.
- ▲ The three-game stretch is the longest for the Beavers since the 1996-97 seasons when OSU went four straight versus Washington, Northern Illinois, Oregon and North Texas.
- ▲ Since the start of the 2021 season - a stretch of 18 games - the Beavers have allowed just 16 sacks. That's tied with Utah for the fewest in the Pac-12 over that stretch. It's also tied for the third-fewest in the nation. Stanford, Saturday's opponent, has allowed the most in the Pac-12 at 47.
- ▲ OSU has allowed 18 tackles for loss this season, third-fewest in the Pac-12.

Sappington 3-For-3

- ▲ Atticus Sappington attempted his first career field goal in the second quarter against Utah, connecting from 26 yards out.
- ▲ He proceeded to kick another 26-yarder in the second quarter, then a 31-yard field goal in the third quarter.
- ▲ He became the first OSU kicker since Jordan Choukair to kick three field goals in the same game. Choukair tallied three against Washington on Nov. 17, 2018.

On Fourth

- ▲ Oregon State has converted on 67 fourth-down conversions under head coach Jonathan Smith since 2018, the most in the Pac-12. Washington has the second-most at 59.
- ▲ OSU has converted on 60.4 percent of its 111 attempts over that stretch.

Ground Game

- ▲ Oregon State leads the Pac-12 and is tied for 14th nationally with 14 rushing touchdowns this season.
- ▲ Since 2021, a stretch of 18 games, OSU has scored 47 touchdowns on the ground, good for eighth nationally. That is third in the Pac-12 and two shy of the conference's leader, Utah.
- ▲ Oregon State has averaged 5.2 yards per carry over those 18 games, and at 203.1 yards per game, is 25th nationally and fourth in the Pac-12.

On Gould

- ▲ Anthony Gould has 17 receptions over the first five games of 2022, surpassing his career high of 13 last season.
- ▲ The wideout has 307 receiving yards, and is averaging 18.1 per reception. That ranks fourth in the Pac-12.

- ▲ Gould is averaging 88.2 all-purpose yards per game as he's also run for 11 yards on two carries and returned five punts for 123 yards.
- ▲ Gould is the first Beaver to record 100 or more punt return yards in a single season since Jordan Poyer tallied 141 in 2011.

Passes Defended

- ▲ Oregon State has been credited with 26 passes defended this season, which is just shy of No. 1 USC (29) for second in the Pac-12. The Beavers have six interceptions and 20 pass breakups.
- ▲ That mark is also tied for 20th nationally.
- ▲ Rejzohn Wright is second in the Pac-12 individually with five defended. Jaydon Grant is tied for fourth with four.
- ▲ OSU was among the Pac-12's leaders with 64 a year ago.

Speaking Of Starts

- ▲ Jack Velling became the seventh Beaver to make his first career start for Oregon State this season against USC.
- ▲ Thirty-eight different Beavers have started at least once during their FBS careers.
- ▲ Brandon Kipper, mentioned prior, leads the way with 37 starts. Jaydon Grant (33) Isaac Hodgins (31) and Omar Speights (30) are other Beavers over the 30-start mark.
- ▲ Oregon State's defensive backs have combined for 115 starts, while its offensive line is at 106.

TOP Battle

- ▲ Oregon State is 12-11 under head coach Jonathan Smith when controlling the time of possession. OSU is 7-19 when an opponent controls it.
- ▲ OSU has controlled it just eight times in 22 road games under Smith, going 3-5.

The Schedule

- ▲ Oregon State's seven remaining opponents have combined to go 17-17 this season.
- ▲ The Beavers' four remaining home opponents are 11-9. OSU's four road opponents are 6-8.
- ▲ Oregon State's first five opponents this season - Boise State, Fresno State, Montana State, USC and Utah - have started 17-7.

2022 OREGON STATE FOOTBALL

▲ Per ESPN, the Beavers' previous five opponents rank 19th nationally in strength of schedule.

Pac-12 Awards

▲ The first two games of the season saw the Beavers pick up a handful of conference weekly honors.

▲ Jaydon Grant (Defensive) and Brandon Kipper (Offensive Lineman) were recognized after the win over Boise State. Kitan Oladapo then earned Defensive Player of the Week honors after the win over Fresno State.

▲ Grant and Oladapo gave the Beavers back-to-back Defensive Player of the Week honors since Stephen Paea and Greg Laybourn in 2008.

On This Date

▲ The Beavers last played on Oct. 8 in 2016, a 47-44 overtime victory over California at Reser Stadium. The win was one just four all-time overtime games at Reser Stadium since 1996.

▲ Oregon State is 7-7-1 in 15 previous dates on Oct. 8.

A New Look

▲ Reser Stadium, the Beavers' home, has a unique look to it during the 2022 season.

▲ The west side of the stadium was imploded in January. Work is currently undergoing on the renovation, which is slated to be ready for the 2023 season.

▲ No fans will sit on the west side during the 2022 season, with media members utilizing temporary accommodations behind the visiting team bench.

All-Pac-12 Returners

▲ Ten Oregon State players who were recognized by the Pac-12 Conference in 2021 have returned for the 2022 season.

▲ Jack Colletto (All-Purpose) was named second team in 2021. Alex Austin, Jaydon Grant, Joshua Gray, Everett Hayes, Brandon Kipper, Chance Nolan, Kitan Oladapo, Omar Speights and Rejzohn Wright were all named honorable mention.

▲ Speights was selected as a preseason All-Pac-12 First Teamer this year.

▲ Gray, Kipper, Austin, Grant, Wright, Colletto and Luke Loecher are preseason second-team selections. Hayes and Jake Levengood were named preseason honorable mention.

Grads

▲ A total of 20 Oregon State players have earned their degrees prior to the 2022 season.

▲ They are: Cody Anderson (kinesiology), Heneli Bloomfield (sociology), Sebastian Briski (biology), Kyrei Fisher-Morris (speech communication), Tristan Gebbia (sociology), Jaydon Grant (digital communication),

Josh Green (sociology), Ben Gulbranson (public health), Tre'Shaun Harrison (human development and family sciences), Isaac Hodgins (speech communication), Jesiah Irish (public health), Brandon Kipper (psychology), Tyjon Lindsey (sociology), Luke Loecher (civil engineering), James Rawls (sociology), Simon Sandberg (kinesiology), Kanoa Shannon (business administration), Riley Sharp (marketing) and Rejzohn Wright (sociology).

▲ Oregon State is one of 23 teams nationally with at least 20 graduates on its roster.

The HC

▲ Oregon State head coach Jonathan Smith is in his fifth year leading the program.

▲ Smith quarterbacked the Beavers to the 2001 Fiesta Bowl (2000 season), and was a two-time team captain for Oregon State. The Beavers went 28-18 from 1998-2001, and the QB helped OSU to the 1999 Oahu Bowl in addition to the 2001 Fiesta Bowl.

Smith's Staff

▲ Oregon State added one assistant coach in the offseason. Cornerbacks coach Anthony Perkins joined the program from Colorado State.

▲ Seven of Oregon State's assistant coaches have been on staff during Smith's entire tenure. Blue Adams (2019) and AJ Steward (2021) have also joined since Smith's first season in 2018.

▲ Jim Michalczyk (offensive line) is in his second stint at OSU after serving on Dennis Erickson's staff from 1999-2001. Trent Bray (defensive coordinator) was on Mike Riley's staff from 2012-14.

Bray's First Full Year

▲ Speaking of Trent Bray, the Oregon State alum is in his first full season as the team's defensive coordinator.

▲ He took over the interim DC role heading into the 10th game of the 2021 season. He had the interim tag removed prior to the Beavers' appearance in the Jimmy Kimmel Los Angeles Bowl.

▲ Oregon State's defense allowed an average of 406 yards and 27.6 points per game in 2021 prior to his tenure as DC. In the nine games since he was appointed, the Beavers have allowed just 362.4 yards and 24.5 points per game.

Captains, Our Captains

▲ Oregon State head coach Jonathan Smith announced the team's 2022 captains at the end of the preseason camp.

▲ Captains are split evenly on each side of the ball. Offensive captains are offensive linemen Brandon Kipper and Jake Levengood and quarterback Tristan Gebbia. Defensive captains include linebackers Kyrei Fisher-Morris and Omar Speights and defensive back Jaydon Grant.

New Videoboard

▲ A new videoboard was installed in time for the 2022 opener.

▲ The new, larger LED video display is in the stadium's south end zone, replacing the existing smaller videoboard and static ad panels with a fully digital display footprint nearly three times larger than the former display.

▲ The new videoboard measures approximately 150 feet wide by 45 feet high and features 10-millimeter pixel spacing (resolution), for a total of more than 6.3 million individual pixels. This will deliver brilliant image clarity and contrast to viewers through-

out the stadium.

▲ In addition to the new south end zone videoboard, ANC is installed more than 1,750 square feet of LED displays throughout the stadium. New LED fascia videoboards were installed along the north side of the stadium, measuring approximately 174 feet wide by 3 feet high, also in 10-millimeter pixel spacing (resolution).

▲ Ahead of the 2023 season, an additional LED fascia videoboard (417ft wide x 3ft high, 10mm pixel spacing) will be installed along the west side of the stadium, with additional LED displays (2.5mm pixel spacing) installed in the North and South Clubs.

Beavers In The NFL

▲ As of Sept. 18, 20 Beavers are on NFL rosters.

▲ Teagan Quitariano was drafted in the sixth round in 2022, and is currently a member of the Houston Texans, joining former Beaver Steven Nelson.

▲ An Oregon State player has been an on NFL Super Bowl roster for nine consecutive seasons. Most recently, Johnny Hekker won the Super Bowl's 2022 version as a member of the Los Angeles Rams. He is now with the Carolina Panthers.

Nineteen Looking For 20

▲ Players have rushed for 1,000 or more yards a total of 19 times during Jim Michalczyk's tenure as an offensive line coach at Montana State (1992-98), Oregon State (1999-2001, 2018-21), California (2002-08, 2011-12), the Oakland Raiders (2009-10) and Arizona (2013-17).

▲ B.J. Baylor became the 19th when he hit the 1,000-yard mark in the win over Stanford last season.

Hass To The Hall Of Fame

▲ Former Oregon State wide receiver Mike Hass has been named to the 64th class of the National Football Hall of Fame.

▲ Hass will become the fifth Oregon State player or coach to go into the Hall of Fame.

▲ Hass joins former standout players Terry Baker (1960-62) and Bill Enyart (1966-68) as well as head coaches Dennis Erickson (1999-2001) and Tommy Prothro (1955-64) in the Hall of Fame.

▲ Hass, a Beaverton, Ore., native, was the winner of the 2005 Biletnikoff Award, which is given annually to the nation's top receiver. He set a then-Oregon State record with 1,532 receiving yards that season, which broke his previous mark of 1,379 set the prior year.

▲ Hass was named a First-Team All-American over two different seasons. He was named an ESPN.com First-Team All-American in 2004 and 2005. He was also selected first team by the Associated Press and Walter Camp Football Foundation in 2005. In addition, Hass was named a third-teamer by the AP in 2004.

▲ Hass will be recognized during the Beavers' Homecoming game against Washington State on Oct. 15.

Completing Reser Stadium

▲ An anonymous donor made a historic \$50 million lead gift to transform Oregon State University's Reser Stadium into a national best-in-class football facility with

year-round programs and facilities for all OSU students, faculty and staff.

▲ The project, which will fully renovate the stadium's west side, received approval by the OSU Board of Trustees Finance and Administration Committee on Jan. 28, 2021. The west side of the stadium was imploded nearly a year later in January 2022.

▲ The project involves the complete demolition and rebuilding of the west side of Reser Stadium and the construction of year-round university facilities, including a new state-of-the-art interactive welcome center for new students considering attending OSU; new health center facilities for Corvallis campus students; health care facilities for OSU faculty and staff; and additional meeting space for university students, faculty and staff.

▲ When finished, Reser Stadium will feature a 360-degree stadium concourse and include expanded concessions and restroom facilities, enhanced sightlines, accessibility improvements and other fan amenities comparable to the east side of Reser, which was renovated prior to the 2005 season.

▲ The home of the Beavers has had over \$200 million in fiscal improvements completed since the 2005 season.

▲ Oregon State is 167-165-4 (.503) at Reser, which was known as Parker Stadium until June 14, 1999.

▲ The stadium was re-named on that date after a personal seven-figure gift by Al and Pat Reser of Beaverton, Ore.

▲ The Valley Football Center, which houses the coaching staff's offices and the team's locker room, underwent an enhancement that was completed in the summer of 2020. It included new graphics to celebrate the accomplishments of Beaver football alumni and a stronger presence highlighting bowl victories.

HEAD COACH

Fifth season at Oregon State

- Jonathan Smith is in his fifth season as Oregon State's head coach, having been officially introduced on November 29, 2017.
- Smith guided the Beavers to a 7-6 record in 2021, their first winning season since 2013. Oregon State advanced to the Jimmy Kimmel Los Angeles Bowl, also the team's first since the 2013 season.
- Oregon State saw Avery Roberts, Nathan Eldridge and B.J. Baylor earn All-America honors in 2021, the team's most since 2012. Overall, five Beavers have been named All-Americans during Smith's tenure, which also includes running back Jermar Jefferson and Hamilcar Rashed Jr.
- OSU has tallied 40 All-Pac-12 selections the past three seasons. Eighteen of those 40 came during the 2021 season, the Beavers most since 2008. Those 18 surpassed 15 Beavers who were selected after the 2020 season.
- The Beavers' 2021 offense set the program's single-season record with 6.4 yards per play. OSU totaled 5,581 yards total, the fourth-most in a 13-game season. Oregon State also averaged 31.2 points per game, among the best in the Pac-12. OSU has averaged 30 or more points per game in two of his first four seasons at the helm of the program.
- OSU's student-athletes have been named to the Pac-12's Academic Honor Roll 123 times in his first four seasons as head coach. That total is second-best in the Pac-12 over that stretch. Timmy Hernandez became OSU's first Academic All-American since 1999 in 2018, after Smith's first season as head coach.
- Prior to returning to Oregon State, Smith served as the offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach for the Washington Huskies, a program that he helped build into a conference and national championship contender. During his tenure he coached Husky record-setting quarterback and 2016 Pac-12 Player of the Year Jake Browning, and helped the Huskies to the 2016 College Football Playoff and the 2017 Fiesta Bowl.
- Has played and coached in 11 bowl games. Coaches in the 2017 Fiesta Bowl after playing in the game as a collegiate quarterback in 2000, earning the victory over Notre Dame.
- Was a four-year letterwinner at Oregon State. He was the Fiesta Bowl Offensive Most Valuable Player, earned Pac-10 Conference Offensive Player of the Week multiple times and was a two-time member of the league's Honorable Mention team.
- Smith left the Oregon State program as the program's all-time leader in passing yardage at 9,680. He also passed for 55 touchdowns during his collegiate career. He still holds the OSU record for longest touchdown pass at 97 yards to Chad Johnson in 2000.
- He and his wife, Candice, have three children, Robert (13 years old), Bella (11) and Charles (7).

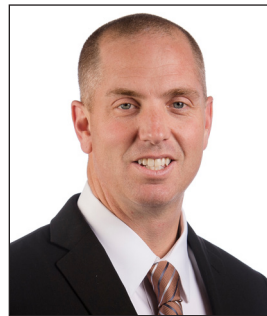
